Hooking Up, Alcohol Use, and Sexual Assault: Understanding the Connections and Reducing Campus Problem

In order to understand the sexual assault problem on campus, one must understand the hookup culture. Research indicates that hooking up is inextricably linked to student alcohol use. This connection leads to scenarios where, by law, someone is “unable to consent” to sex due to extreme alcohol intoxication. This presentation will cover: what hooking up is, how it came to be, and why it is connected to alcohol abuse. This information will be used to inform a discussion on a case study where a woman was too drunk to consent. The program will conclude with suggestions on how to utilize knowledge of the hookup culture to better address the alcohol related sexual assault problem on campuses throughout the country.
