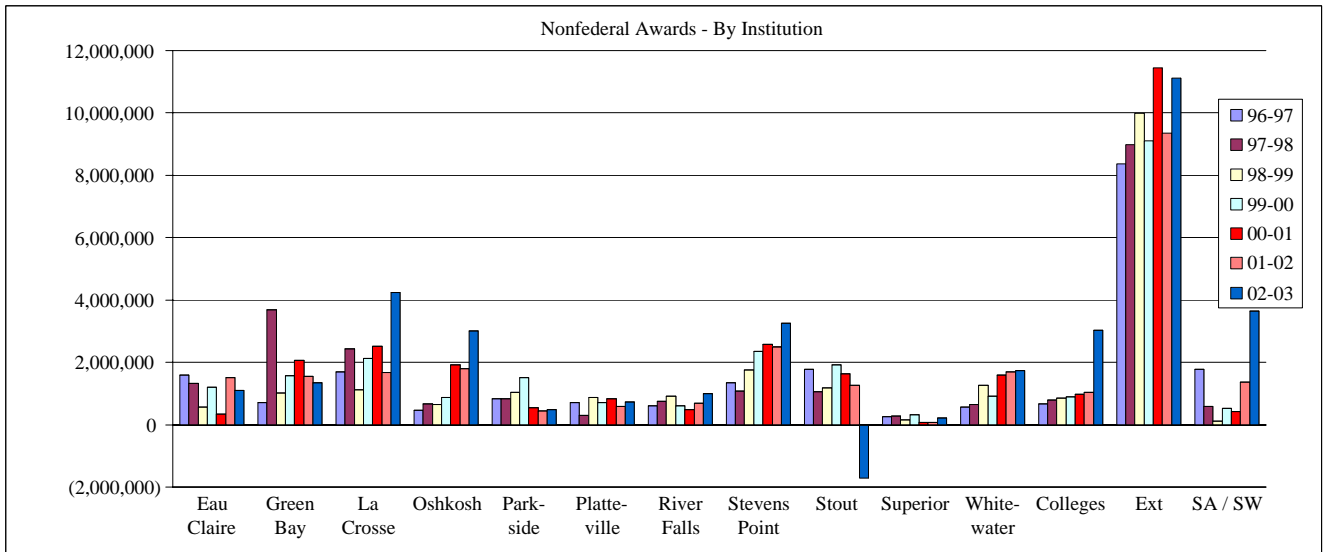
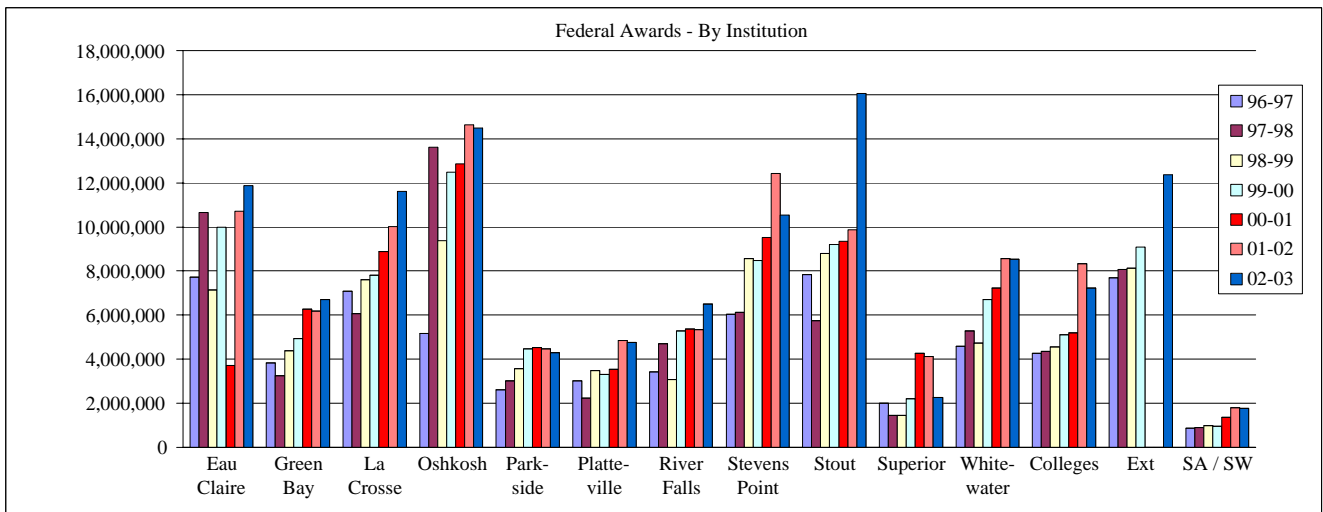
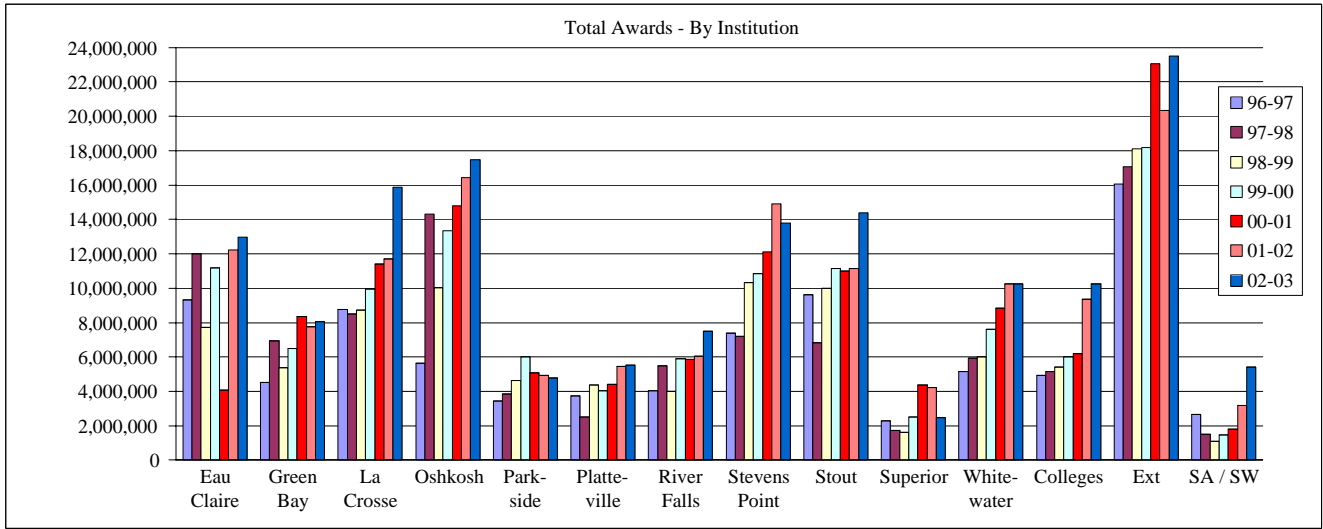
- Over 160,000 students enrolled in the fall semester
- Fall 2002 access rate was 31.7%
- Over one-fifth (35,000) of UW System students are 25 years of age and older; 19% of official enrollment (30,000) are nontraditional students
- Last year, 941 courses were offered via distance education
- Last year, UW System campuses conferred 29,153 degrees
- Women earn over 57% of degrees
- 61.6% of the 1996 student cohort graduated in six years
- Over 90,000 students receive some form of financial aid.
- Over 81% of financial aid is from federal sources.
- The Pell Grant program provided \$66.5 million to 28,180 students in 2002-03
- 30% of financial aid recipients receive a Pell grant. The average grant is \$2,358.
- The average loan debt for a Wisconsin resident receiving a bachelors degree is approximately \$16,500.
- Student loan default rate for the UW system was 2.7% in 2002-03, well below the national average of 5.4%

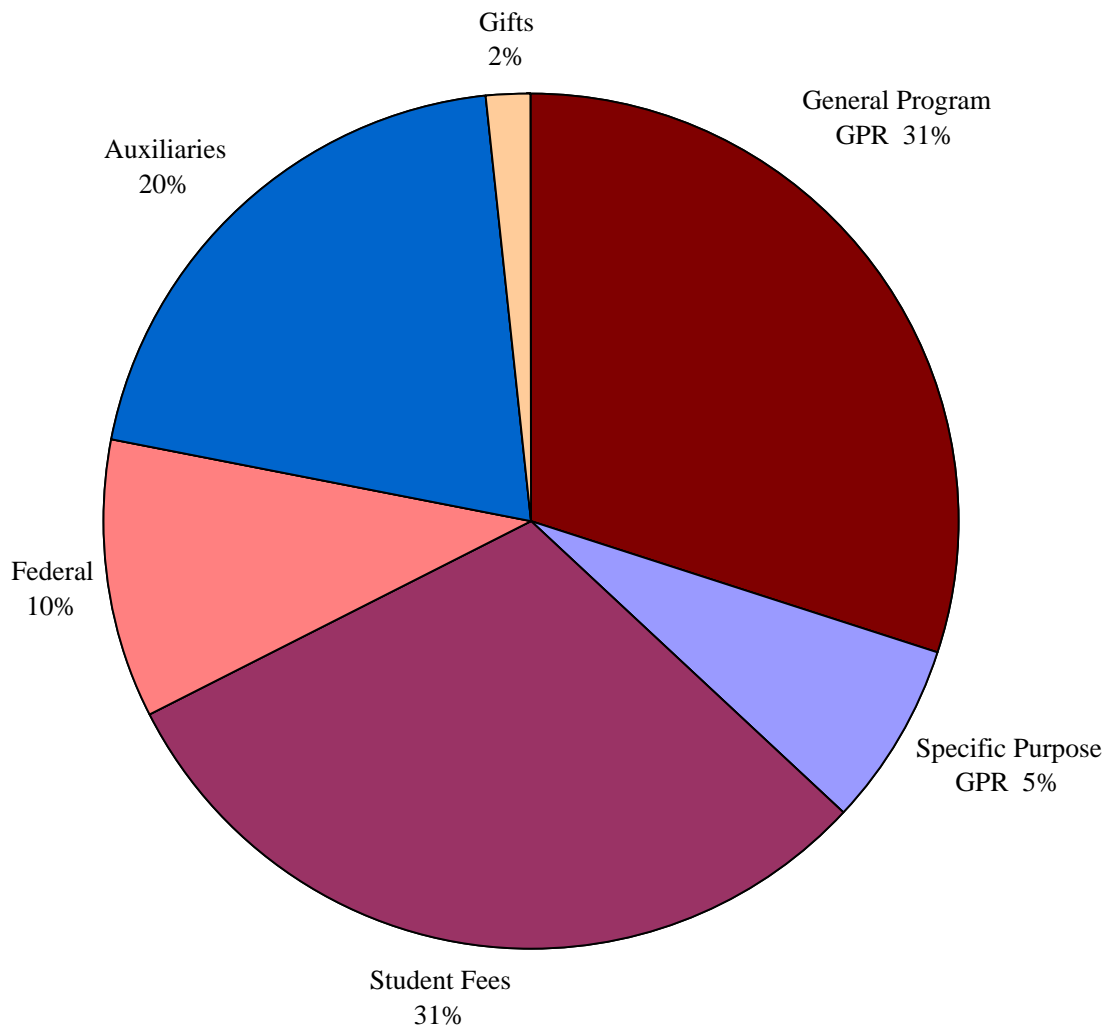

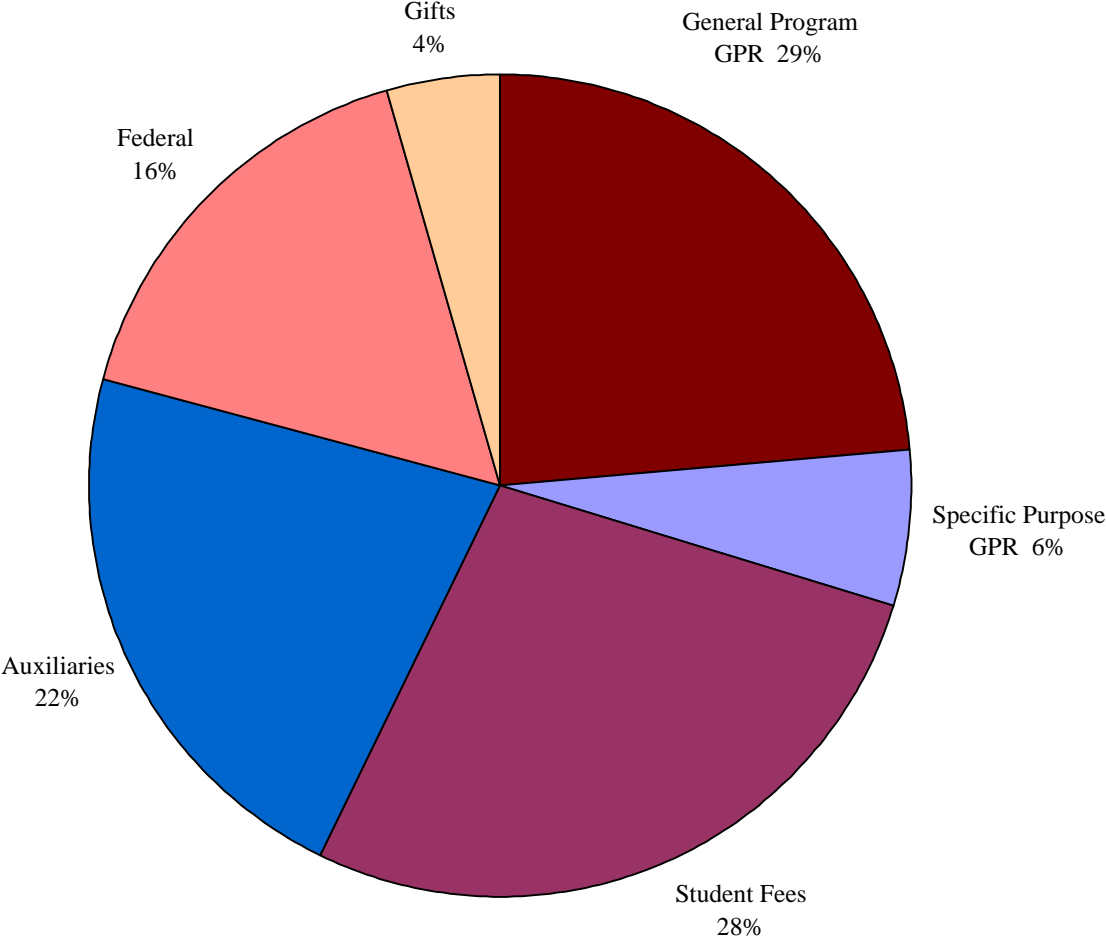

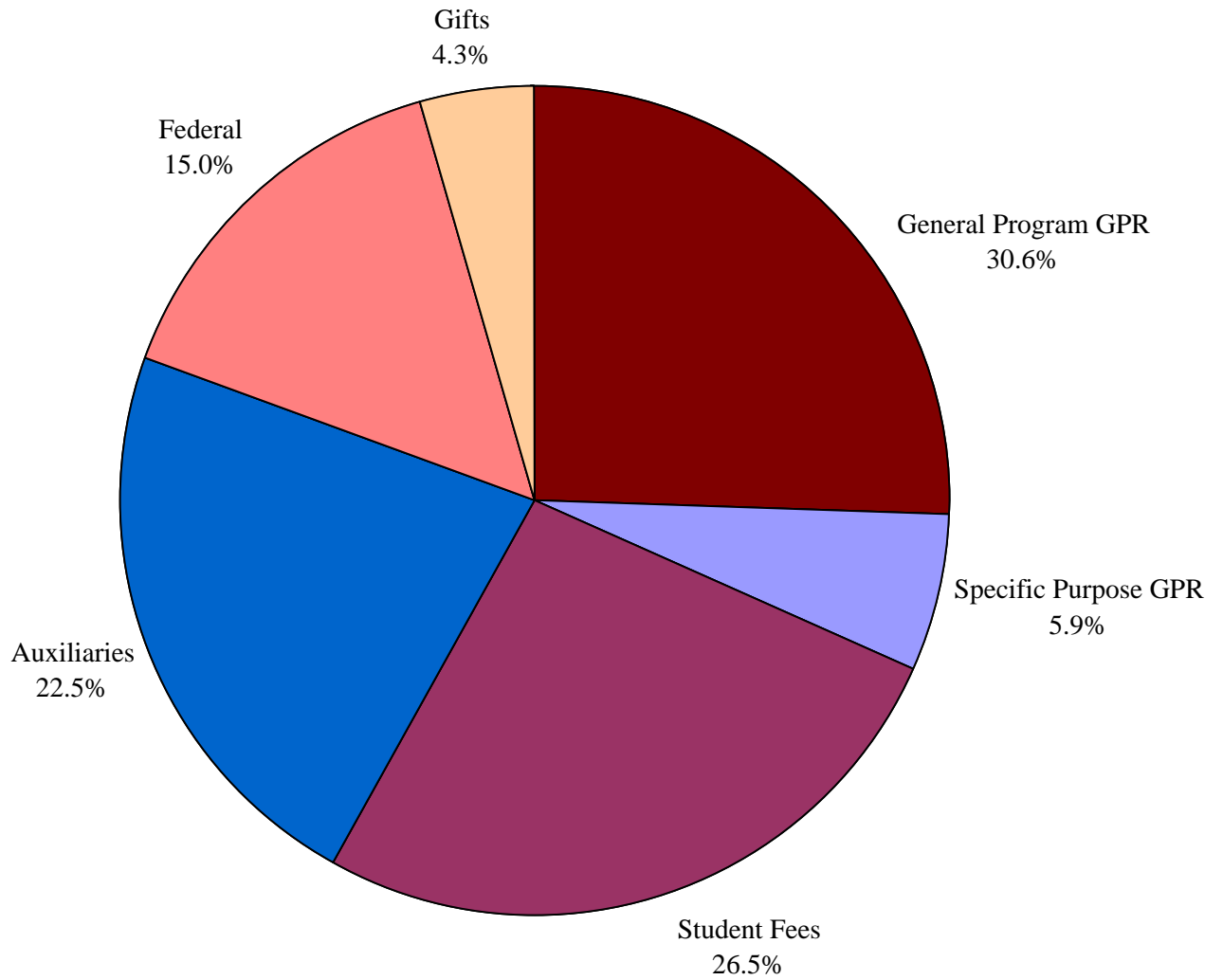

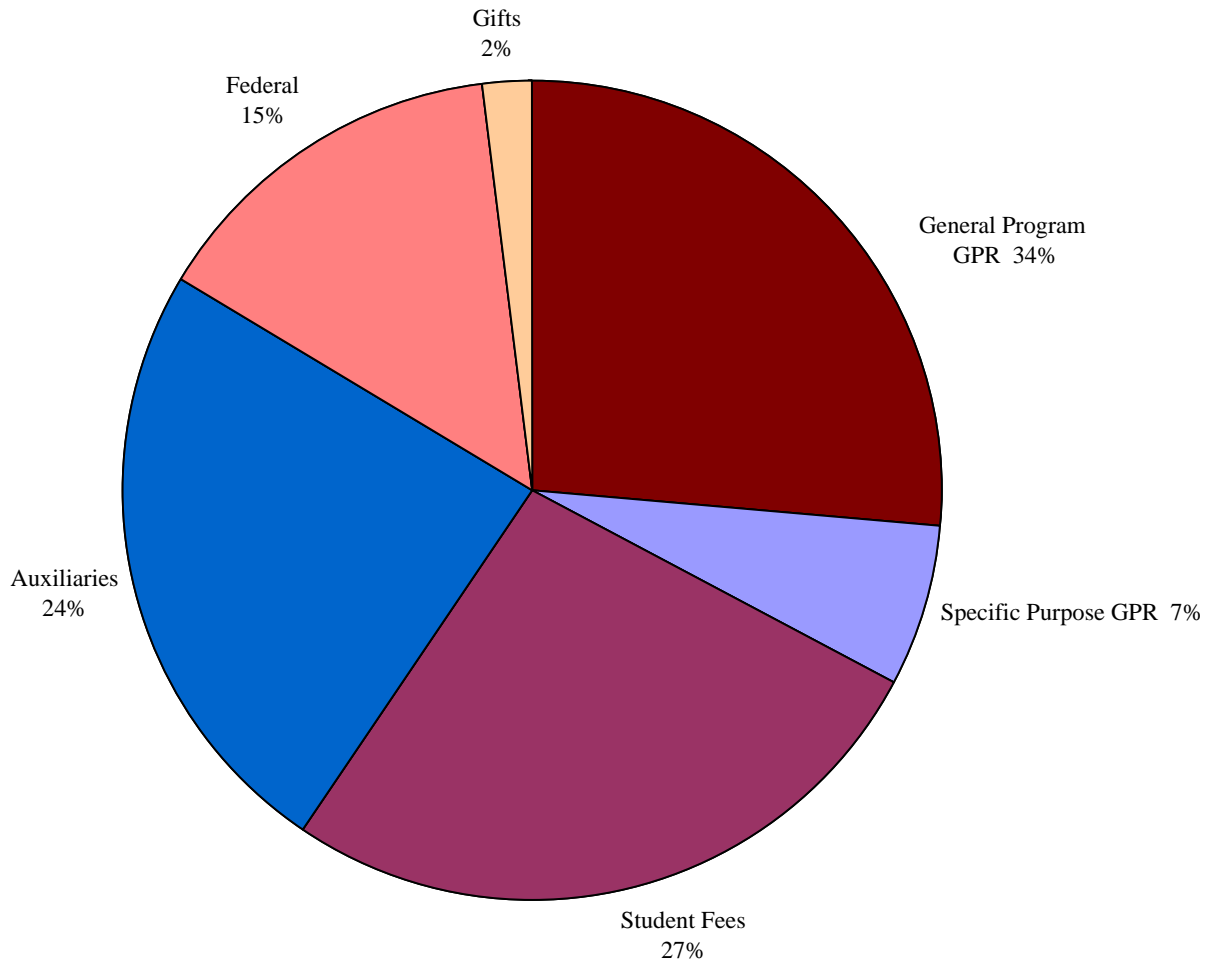

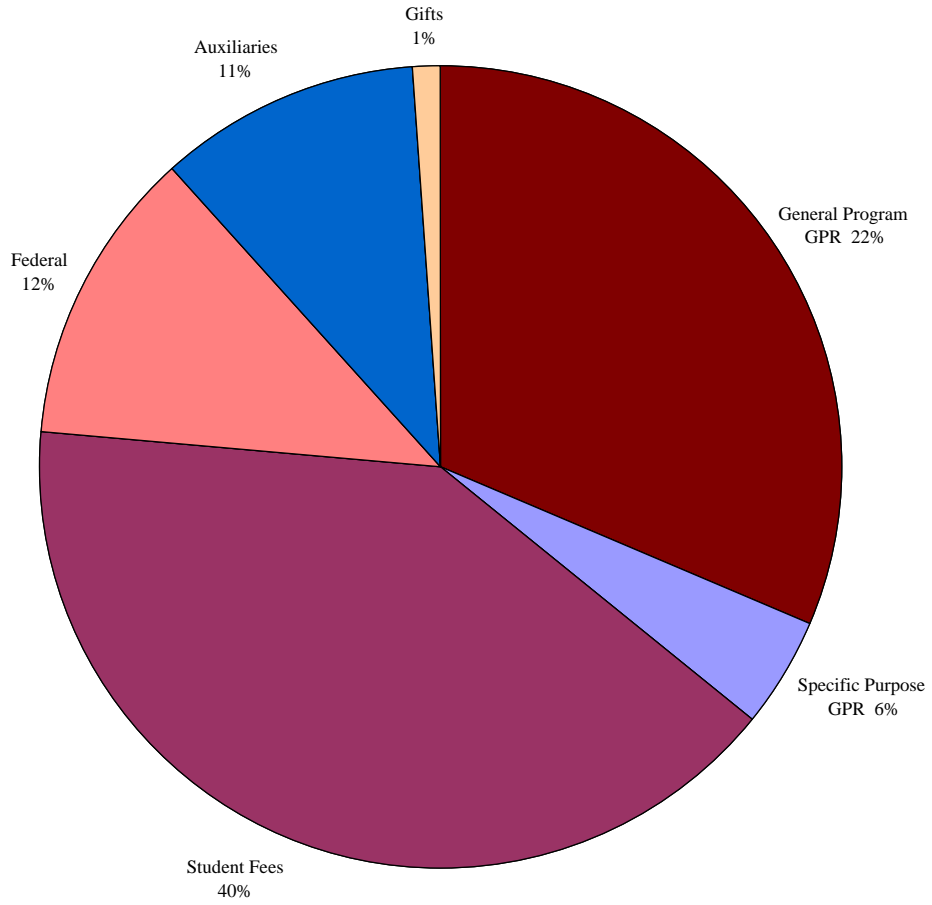
