\$119.2 million includes GPR base budget reductions (\$96), Wisconsin Public Radio/TV (\$8), AOP/Lawton (\$3), certain administrative positions (\$5), Law School (\$4), university relations(\$2), and the School for Workers, Havens Center, and Wisconsin Humanities Council (\$1).

\$139.6 million includes the \$119 in cuts plus GPR/fee reductions to AOP/Lawton (\$2), Growth Agenda initiatives (\$8), certain administrative positions (\$2), retention of high-demand faculty(\$4), application fees (\$2), student technology fees (\$2), and the biomedical alliance and islet transplantation program (\$1).

(a) The \$11.6 million would have covered only a portion of the total estimated costs of veterans tuition remissions for 2007-09, estimated by LFB to be more than **\$51 million** at UW System institutions and at WTCS institutions.

★The Assembly budget provides just 20% of the GPR funding needed to fund today's academic programs and meet current obligations (\$30.1 million of the \$151.4 million needed)

★The Assembly budget provides just 34% of the GPR funding needed to meet current obligations and support new Growth Agenda initiatives (\$62.3 million of \$181.1 million)
