<b>SPECIFICATIONS:</b>	A two-digit numeric value between 01 and 36 inclusive, or space-filled.

<b>DEFAULTS:</b>	If Entrance status, Current (DE 2240) is not equal to 'N', or Student Classification (DE 2210) is not equal to 'A', 'B', 'C', or 'D', or ACT/SAT Test Indicator (DE 2145) is not equal to 'C', 'D', or 'E', then this element is defaulted to spaces.	
<b>EDITS:</b>	<i>2144-21 If ACT/SAT Test Indicator (DE 2145) = 'C', 'D', or 'E', then this element must contain a two-digit value that is greater than or equal to 01 and less than or equal to 36, or be space-filled.</i>	X
