The modifications in this update pertain to the CDR submissions for the 2009-10 academic year, which includes the summer of calendar year 2009. Modifications to the CDR documentation are primarily noted in the right margin. These are marked by '+' for additions, '-' for deletions, and 'x' or a date for changes. Following is a summarization of the changes.

VOLUME I

The CDR Liaisons list has been revised to reflect changes. Please review the CDR submission dates, pages III.A.3-6. Let us know if you foresee any problems in providing the data by the dates listed.

Curricular CDR

Section Length (DE 1130) has been updated to reflect the length of the fall and spring 2009-10 semesters in weeks. Please confirm that this information is accurate.

Student CDR

We will begin collecting first generation college student status on the CDR using the First Generation College Student Indicator (DE 2065).

The definition for Veteran's Status (DE 2060) has been updated.

Edit 2220-21 (Resident Status) has been modified to include Indiana as a valid state for students participating in the Midwest Student Exchange Program.

Edit 2210-21 (Classification) has been updated to ensure that students participating in the "Return to Wisconsin" program are undergraduates.

Pages in the Data Submission Formats section (Vol. I, III.C) have been modified to reflect current data updating processes.

VOLUME II - Responses due by July 10, 2009

CDR Curricular Area Code Table (Table I.C) - Please review your institution's CAC/UDDS crosswalk table with your Budget Office to ensure that the UDDS codes reflect the proper budgeted departments and incorporate any changes that may have been made as part of the annual budget process. The CAC codes should be reviewed with the Registrar to ensure that all institutional departments (student credit carrying departments) are properly represented.

Degree Table and Major Tables (Tables III and IV) - Please review these tables on our website with your Academic Affairs office to ensure that all valid and operational degrees and majors (degree programs) are included.

College Code (Tables V) - New codes are added to this table on a continuing basis. Summary of changes made in the past year and the complete table are available on our website.
