II. Reporting to UW System - MAAD Data Element Changes – Beginning Oct. 1, 2007 with Summer/Fall 2008 application reporting

A. Data elements Race/Ethnicity (DE 5030) and Race/Ethnicity Sub-category (DE 5035) will no longer be collected on MAAD.

B. New data elements for Race/Ethnicity (DE's 5600 – 5675)

1. Race/Ethnicity Indicators – Values: Y or N

- Hawaiian/Pacific Islander Indicator
- Cambodian Indicator
- Hmong Indicator
- Laotian Indicator
- Vietnamese Indicator

- Mexican/Mexican-American/Chicano Indicator
- Puerto Rican Indicator
- Cuban Indicator
- Other Hispanic/Latino Indicator
- White/Caucasian Indicator
- Other Race Indicator
- Unknown Indicator

III. UW System standard reporting: Students by Race/Ethnicity – Unduplicated Headcount using a “Two or More Race/Ethnicities” Category.

- For standard reporting, multiple Hispanic/Latino subcategories and Southeast Asian subcategories are “rolled up” into Hispanic/Latino and Southeast Asian alone categories. Detail is collected at UW System and available for ad hoc use.
- For standard reporting, applicants/students selecting only Other are included in the “Other alone” category. If “Other” is selected in combination with one other Race/Ethnicity, the “Other” selection would be ignored. Textual information in Other is collected at UW System and available for ad hoc use.
- For standard reporting, “Two or more race/ethnicities” would include applicants/students who choose more than one race/ethnic category.
- International students are reported in a separate category.
- If a “Students of Color” subtotal is included, it would be an aggregation of individuals within the Hispanic/Latino, African American or Black, American Indian or Alaska Native, Hawaiian or Pacific Islander, Southeast Asian, Other Asian, and Two or more races/ethnicities categories.
