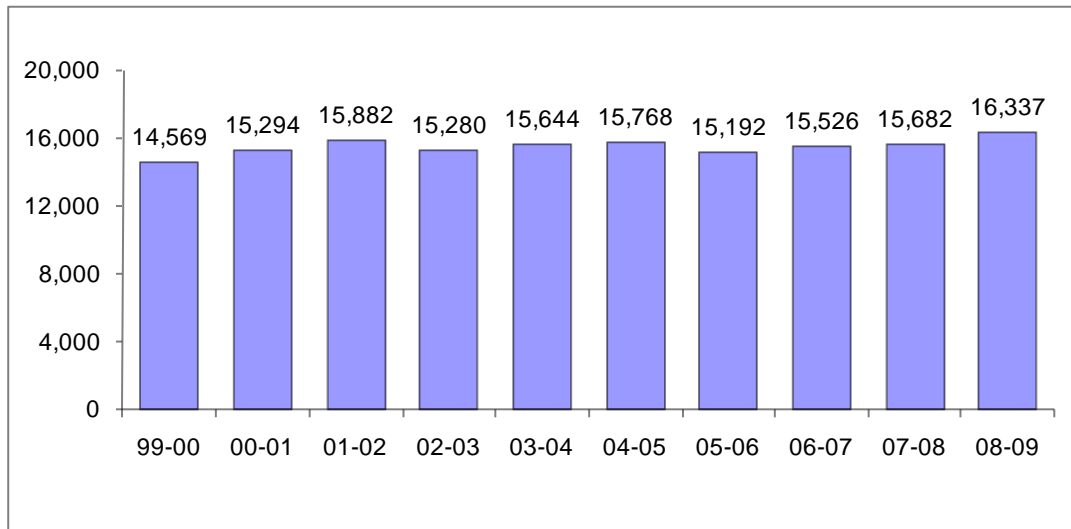

**UW System Undergraduate Transfer Student Enrollment
1999-00 to 2008-09**



Highlights

Undergraduate Transfer Student Enrollment in 2008-09

- 16,337 students transferred into or within the UW System in 2008-09.
- Of these transfer students, 14,017 (86%) were new transfer students and 2,320 (14%) were re-entry transfer students.
- UW-Milwaukee received the most new transfer students (2,392), followed by UW-Madison (1,675), UW Colleges (1,441), and UW-Oshkosh (1,377).
- 41% of new transfer students were from within the UW System, 28% from out-of-state institutions, 22% from Wisconsin Technical Colleges, 7% from Wisconsin private institutions, and the remainder (2%) from international institutions.

Undergraduate New Transfer Student Demographics in Fall 2008

- 24% of new transfer students entered as freshmen, 39% as sophomores, and 36% as upperclassmen.
- 83% of new transfer students were full-time students.
- 55% of new transfer students were between the ages of 20 and 24.
- 53% of new transfer students were female.
- 10% of new transfer students were students of color.

Undergraduate New Transfer Student Outcomes

- The first year GPA of fall 2008 new transfer students was 3.0.
- The overall second year retention rate for both full-time and part-time fall 2007 new transfer students was 73%.
- The overall six-year graduation rate for both full-time and part-time fall 2002 new transfer students was 60%.

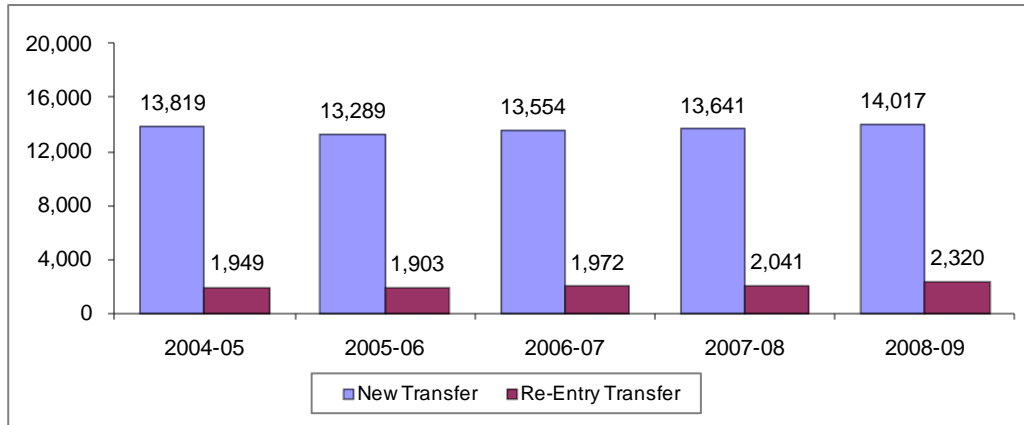

UNDERGRADUATE TRANSFER STUDENT ENROLLMENT

During the 2008-09 academic year, 16,337 students transferred credits from another institution of higher education into or within the UW System. Of these transfer students, 14,017 (86%) were new transfer students and 2,320 (14%) were re-entry transfer students. New transfer students are students who have not previously enrolled at the institution to which they transferred. Re-entry transfer students are students re-enrolling at a UW institution with transfer credits. New and re-entry transfer student enrollment in 2008-09 was the highest over the last five years (Figure 1).

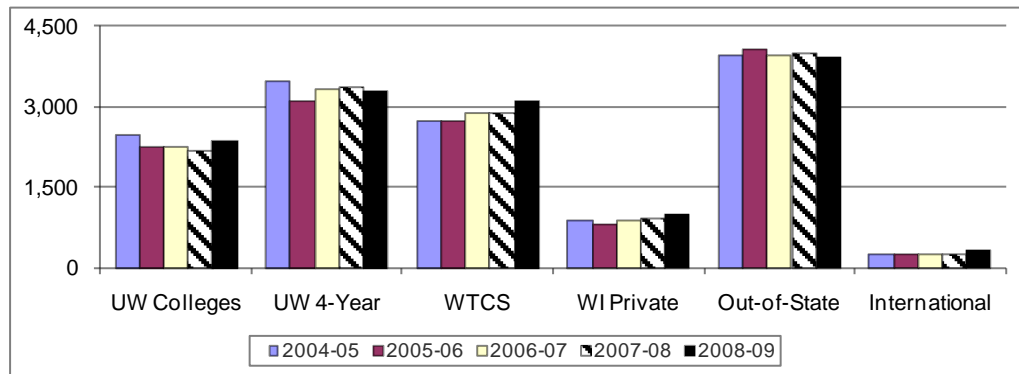
Students transfer within the UW System or from the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS), Wisconsin private colleges and universities, out-of-state colleges and universities, and international colleges and universities. Appendices A and B show the details on new and re-entry transfer students by sending institution (the last college or university from which the student transferred) and receiving institution (the UW institution to which they transferred) from 2004-05 to 2008-09, respectively. Appendices C and D show the details on new and re-entry transfer students by sending institution and receiving institution in 2008-09.

The majority (86%) of transfer students were new transfer students. The remainder of this report focuses on new transfer students only. Figure 2 shows the number of new transfer students to the UW System by type of sending institution from 2004-05 to 2008-09. Compared to 2004-05, the increase in new transfer students in 2008-09 was due to the increase in transfer students from Wisconsin Technical Colleges (378), Wisconsin private institutions (86), and international institutions (63).

Compared to 2004-05, the increase in new transfer students in 2008-09 reflects the increase in new transfer student applications as the admission rate and enrollment rate for new transfer students in the two years remained nearly unchanged (Figure 3). Of the 21,520 new transfer student completed applications in 2004-05, 19,038 were admitted by UW institutions (an 88% admission rate). Of those admitted in 2004-05, 13,819 enrolled in UW institutions (a 73% enrollment rate). In contrast, there were 22,264 new transfer student completed applications and 19,467 (87%) were admitted in 2008-09. Of those admitted, 14,017 (72%) enrolled in 2008-09.

2004-05 to 2008-09

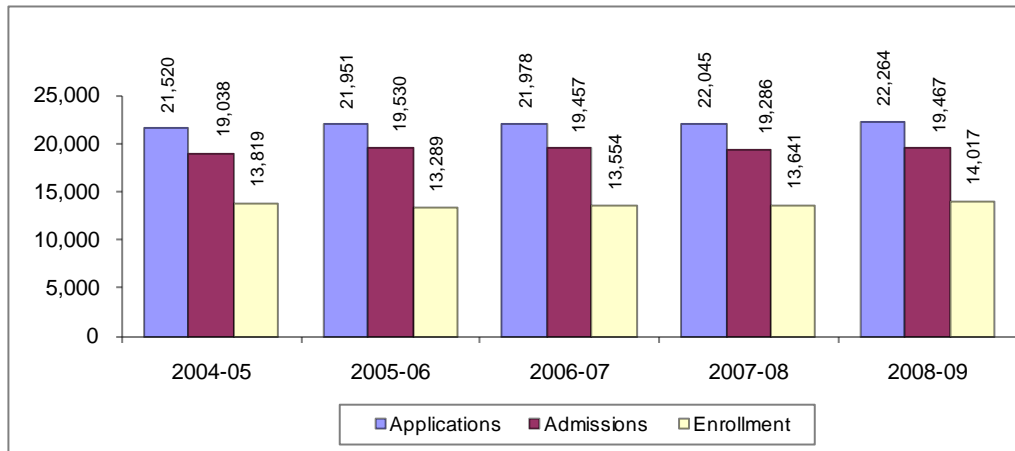


Figure 4 shows the number of new transfer students to the UW System by the UW receiving institution in 2008-09. UW-Milwaukee received the most new transfer students (2,392), followed by UW-Madison (1,675), UW Colleges (1,441), and UW-Oshkosh (1,377).

2008-09

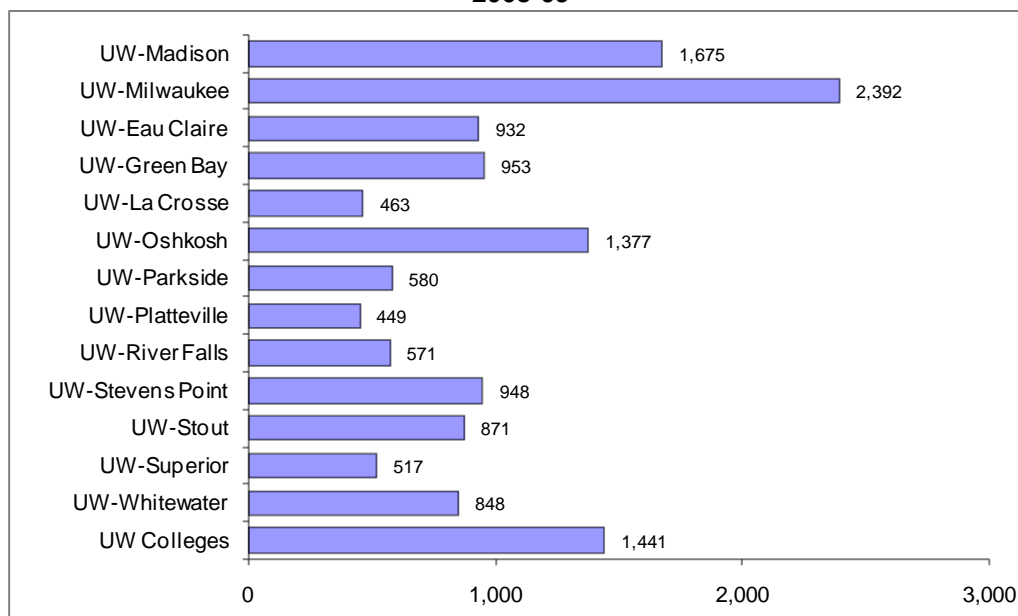
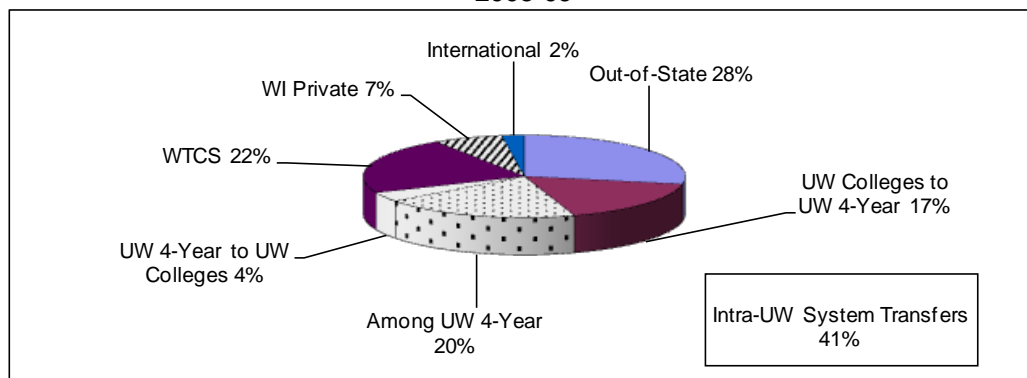


Figure 5 illustrates the proportion of new transfer students into or within the UW System in 2008-09 by type of sending institution. Intra-UW System transfers (41%) were the largest source of new transfer students for UW institutions, including transfers among UW 4-Year institutions, from UW Colleges to UW 4-Year institutions, and from UW 4-Year institutions to UW Colleges. The second largest share of new transfers into the UW System, 28 percent, came from out-of-state institutions. New transfer students from Wisconsin Technical Colleges constituted 22 percent of the total new transfer population. Seven percent (7%) of students transferred from Wisconsin private institutions, while a small percentage (2%) of students transferred from international institutions.

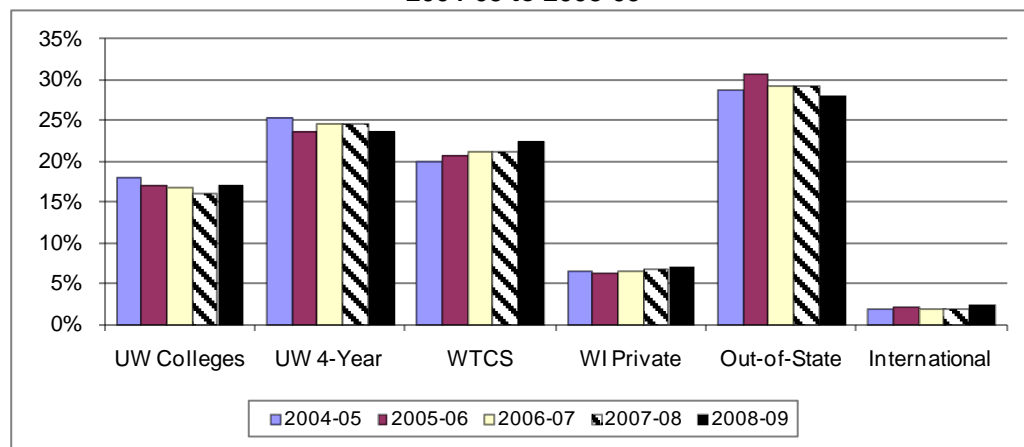
More than half of the students transferring from out-of-state institutions were Wisconsin residents (55% in 2008-09 or 2,165). Of these Wisconsin residents, 31 percent transferred from colleges or universities in Minnesota, 11 percent transferred from colleges or universities in Illinois, 8 percent transferred from colleges or universities in Michigan. Originating out-of-state institutions sending the most Wisconsin resident transfer students to the UW System in 2008-09 were the University of Minnesota-Twin Cities (153), Winona State University (93), and St Cloud State University (47). Of the 317 new transfer students from international institutions in 2008-09, 63 (20%) were Wisconsin residents.

From 2004-05 to 2008-09, the percentage of new transfer students to the UW System from Wisconsin Technical Colleges and Wisconsin private institutions increased slightly, while the percentage of new transfers from UW Colleges and UW 4-Year institutions decreased slightly. New transfer students from international institutions remained at 2 percent and those from out-of-state institutions fluctuated (Figure 6).

2004-05 to 2008-09



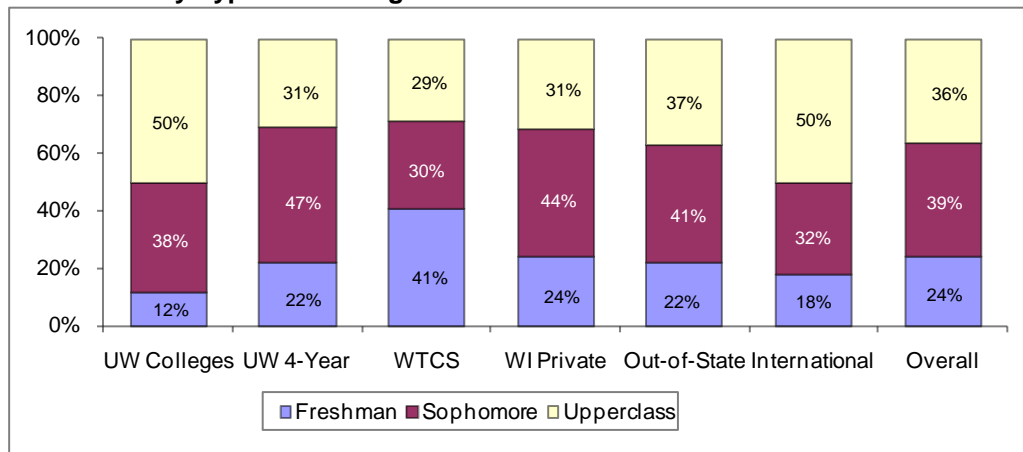
UNDERGRADUATE NEW TRANSFER STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS

Two-thirds of new transfer students begin in the fall term while the remaining third begin in other terms. This section focuses on new transfer students who entered in the fall semester of academic year 2008-09 and the characteristics of these students during the semester that they transferred.

Figure 7 shows the distribution of fall 2008 new transfer cohort by student classification. Student classification is based on the total number of credits transferred from one or more transfer institutions. Overall, 24 percent of new transfer students entered at the freshman level, but this percentage varied depending on the type of sending institution. Twelve percent (12%) of new transfer students from UW Colleges entered as freshmen, compared to 41 percent from the Wisconsin Technical Colleges. Appendix E provides details on the distribution of fall 2008 new transfer cohort to the UW System by sending institution and student classification.

Appendix F shows the percentages of new transfer cohort to the UW System by type of sending institution and student classification from fall 2004 to fall 2008. The proportion of new transfer students entering the UW System as freshmen from Wisconsin Technical Colleges has gradually decreased, from 55 percent in fall 2004 to 41 percent in fall 2008; while this proportion for other types of sending institution, with the exception of UW Colleges and out-of-state institutions, has increased.

The majority of new transfers (83%) were full-time students, with a credit load of 12 or more credits (Figure 8). The proportion ranged from 70 percent for students transferring from Wisconsin Technical Colleges to 95 percent for students transferring from international institutions. Appendix G provides details on fall 2008 new transfer students by sending institution and full-time/part-time status.

by Type of Sending Institution and Full-Time/Part-Time Status

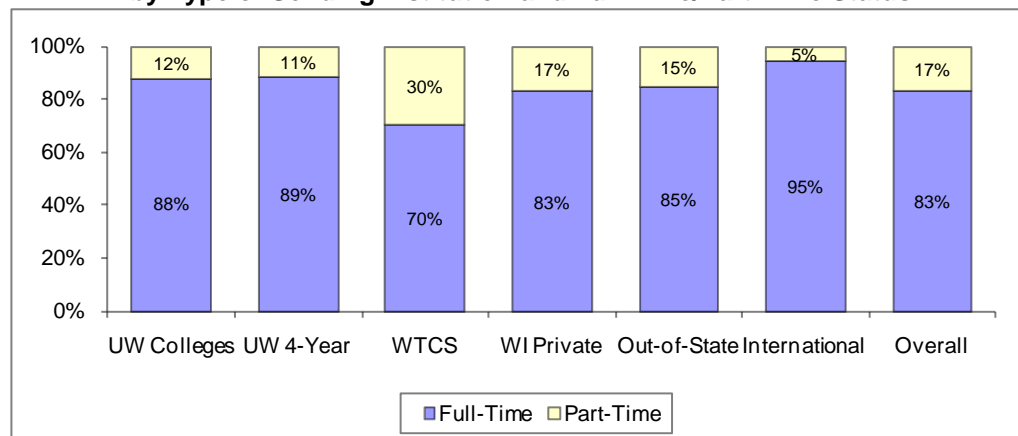
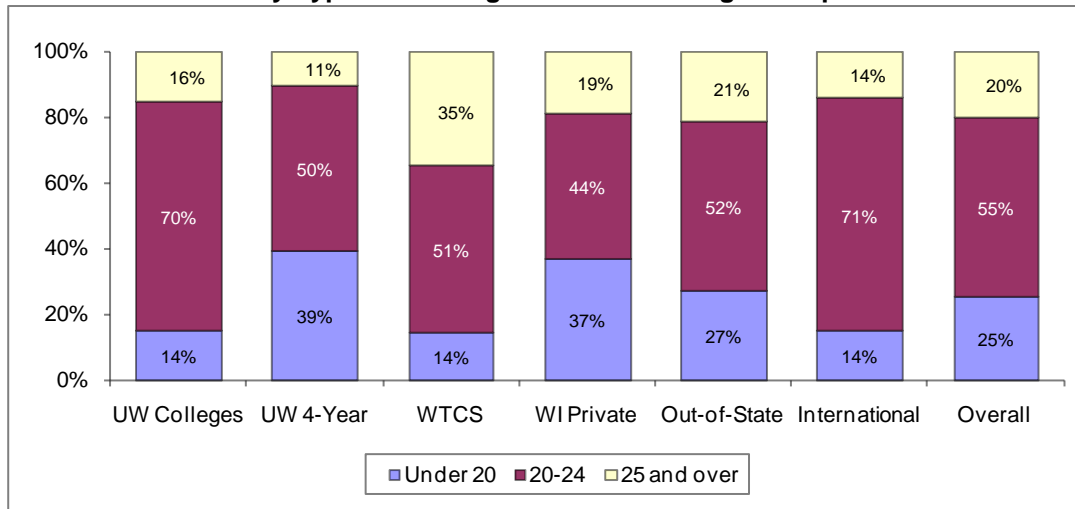


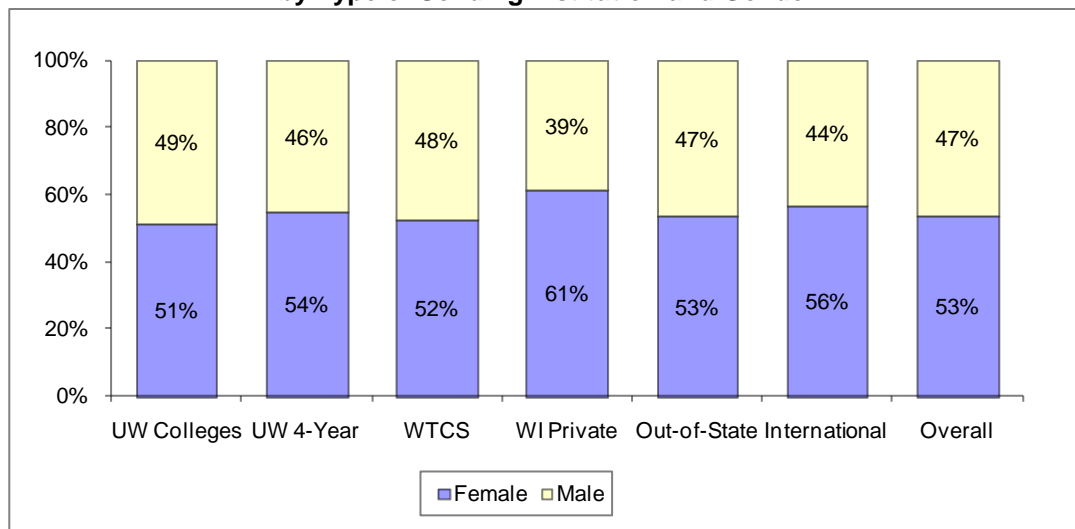
Figure 9 shows the age distribution of fall 2008 new transfer cohort. The majority (55%) of new transfer students were between ages 20 and 24. This percentage ranged from 44 percent for students transferring from Wisconsin private institutions to 71 percent for students transferring from international institutions. Thirty-five percent (35%) of new transfer students from Wisconsin Technical Colleges were 25 years old and over, the highest percentage of non-traditional students, compared to 11 percent from UW 4-Year institutions.

Overall, 53 percent of the fall 2008 new transfer cohort were female and 47 percent were male (Figure 10). Fifty-one percent (51%) of new transfer students from UW Colleges were female, compared to 61 percent from Wisconsin private institutions.

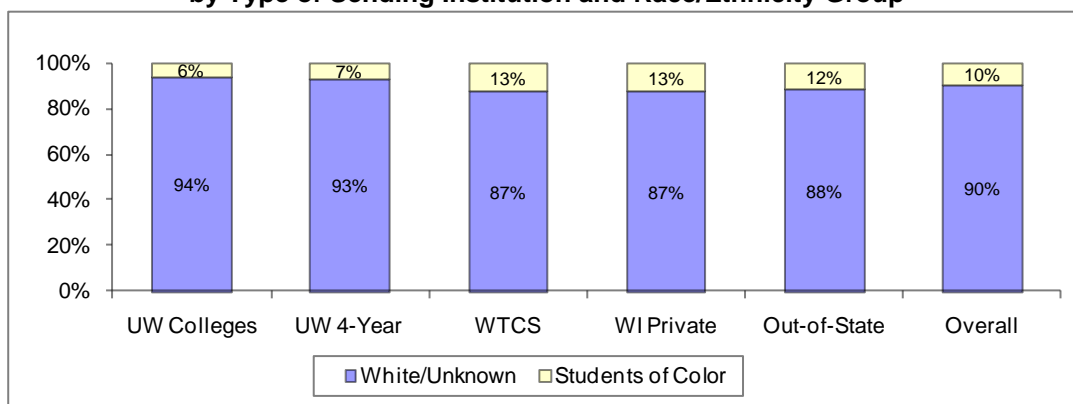

In the fall 2008 new transfer cohort, 10 percent of the students were students of color (Figure 11). Thirteen percent (13%) of new transfer students from Wisconsin Technical Colleges and Wisconsin private institutions were students of color, compared to 6 percent from UW Colleges. Of the 907 new transfer students of color in fall 2008, 255 (28%) were African American and 190 (21%) were Hispanic/Latino. Refer to Appendix H for details on the distribution of fall 2008 new transfer cohort to the UW System by sending institution and race/ethnicity.

With the addition of two new race/ethnicity categories - "two or more race/ethnicity" and "Hawaiian/Pacific Islander" in fall 2008, caution should be taken when comparing with the previous years' numbers for student of color, in particular for a specific race/ethnicity category. The decrease in new transfer students for a specific minority race/ethnicity category in fall 2008 may have been affected by the addition of the two new categories. For example, of the 135 "two or more race/ethnicity" students, 31 reported African American as one race/ethnicity, 56 Hispanic/Latino, and 50 American Indian. See Appendix I for details.

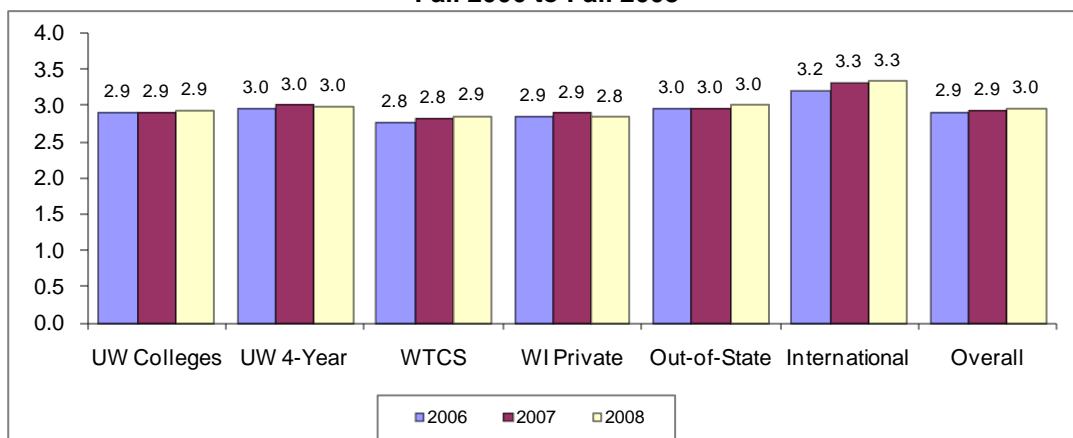

UNDERGRADUATE NEW TRANSFER STUDENT OUTCOMES

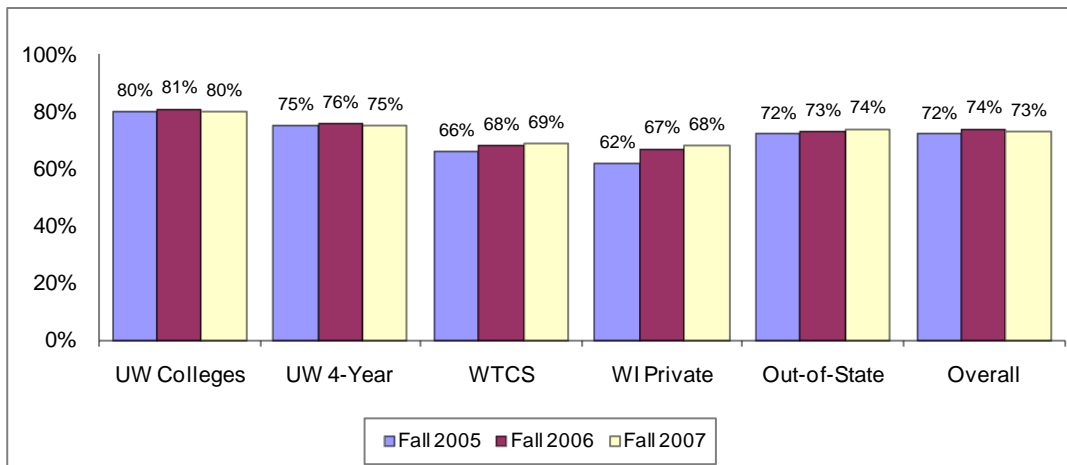
Figure 12 shows the first year grade point averages (GPA) for fall 2006, 2007, and 2008 new transfer students. This GPA reflects the courses that the new transfer students completed during their first year at the transfer institution. The average first year GPA of fall 2008 new transfer students was 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. There has been little change in the average first year GPA for the past three cohorts of fall new transfer entrants. Appendix J details the average first year GPAs of the fall 2006, 2007, and 2008 new transfer cohort to the UW System by sending institution.

Fall 2006 to Fall 2008



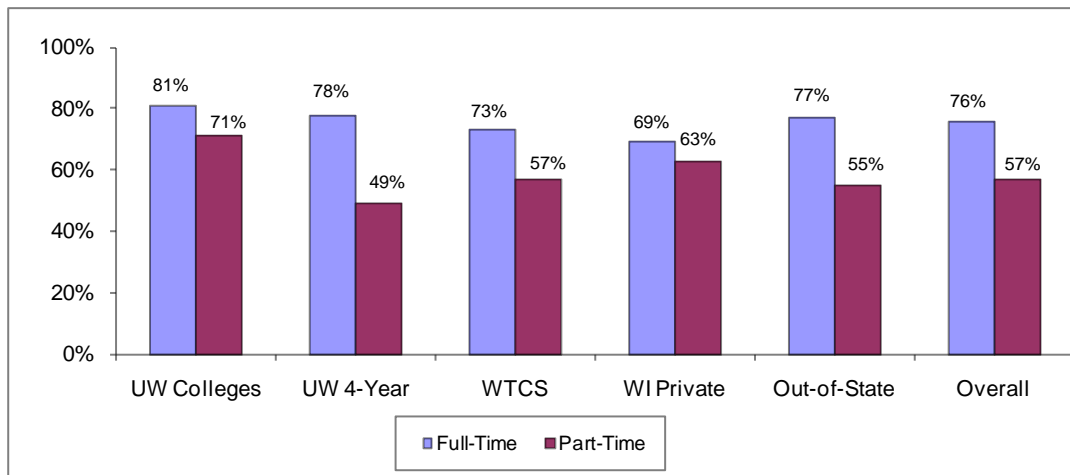
Another measure of success for new students is second year retention rate; that is, the percentage of students who successfully complete their first year and return to the same institution for a second year of study. Of the new transfer students who entered in fall 2007, 73 percent returned in fall 2008. Figure 13 shows that the first to second year retention rates for fall 2005, 2006, and 2007 new transfer students varied by type of sending institution. Fall 2007 new transfer students from UW Colleges had the highest second year retention rate (80%), while those from Wisconsin private institutions had the lowest second year retention rate (68%). Appendix K provides details on the second year retention rates for fall 2007 new transfer cohort to the UW System by sending institution and full-time/part-time status. Appendix L shows the second year retention rates for fall 2007 new transfer cohort by type of sending institution and receiving institution.

New transfers entering as full-time students persisted at a much higher rate (76%) than those entering as part-time students (57%) (Figure 14). For new transfers entering as full-time students in fall 2007, the second year retention rates ranged from 81 percent for students transferring from UW Colleges to 69 percent for students transferring from Wisconsin private institutions. In comparison, the second year retention rate for new freshmen who entered the UW System in fall 2007 as full-time students was 79 percent.

Students who transfer as freshmen are generally retained at lower rates than students who transfer as sophomores or upperclassmen (Figure 15). Overall, students who transferred at the freshman level in fall 2007 had a 62 percent second year retention rate while students who transferred as sophomores or upperclassmen had a 77 percent retention rate. However, these rates varied by type of sending institution. For example, the second year retention rates ranged from 71 percent for freshman transfers from UW Colleges to 53 percent for freshman transfers from Wisconsin private institutions.

Fall 2007

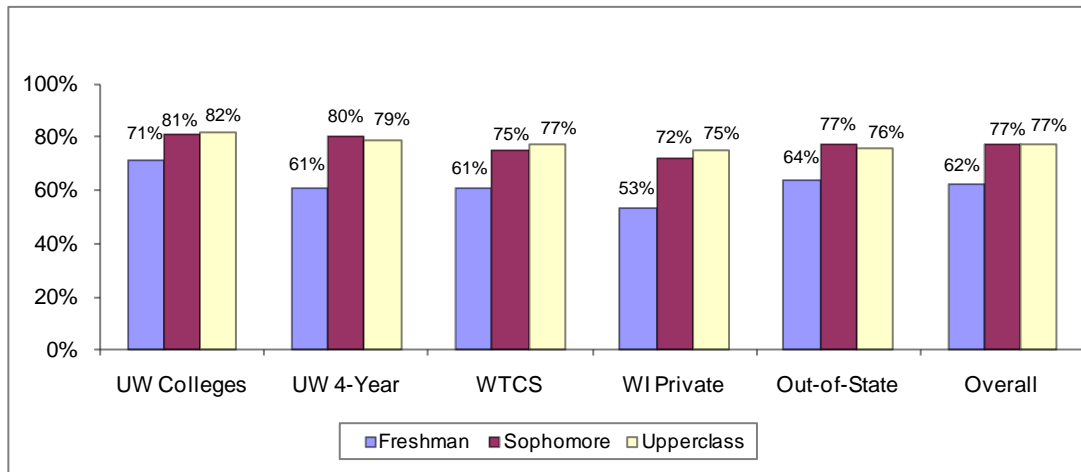
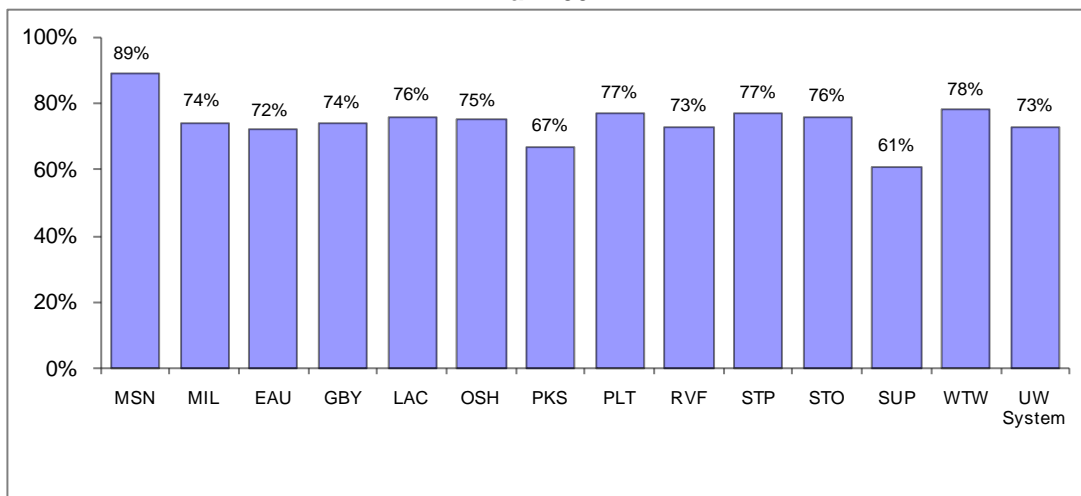


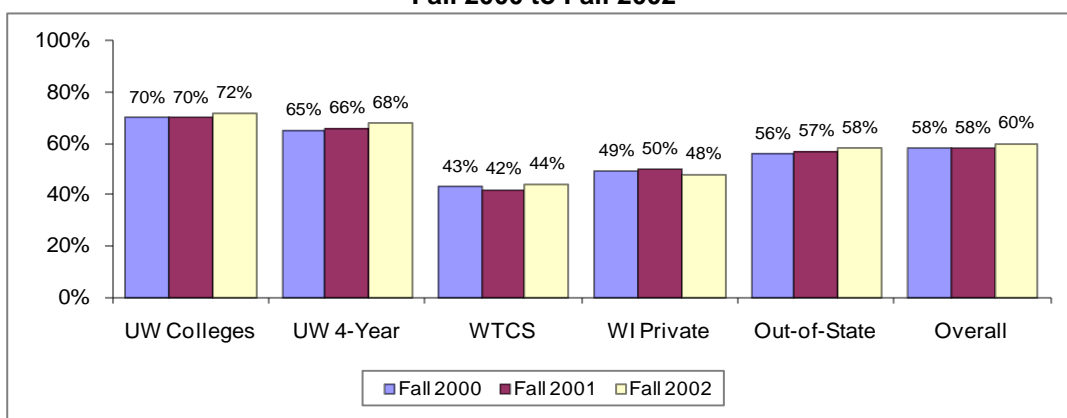
Figure 16 shows the second year retention rates of fall 2007 new transfer cohort by the UW receiving institution. Overall, the UW System second year retention rate was 73 percent. The second year retention rates varied by the UW receiving institution, ranging from 89 percent for new transfer cohort at UW-Madison to 61 percent for new transfer cohort at UW-Superior. Appendix M provides details on the second year retention rates for fall 2007 new transfer cohort by receiving institution and student classification.

Fall 2007



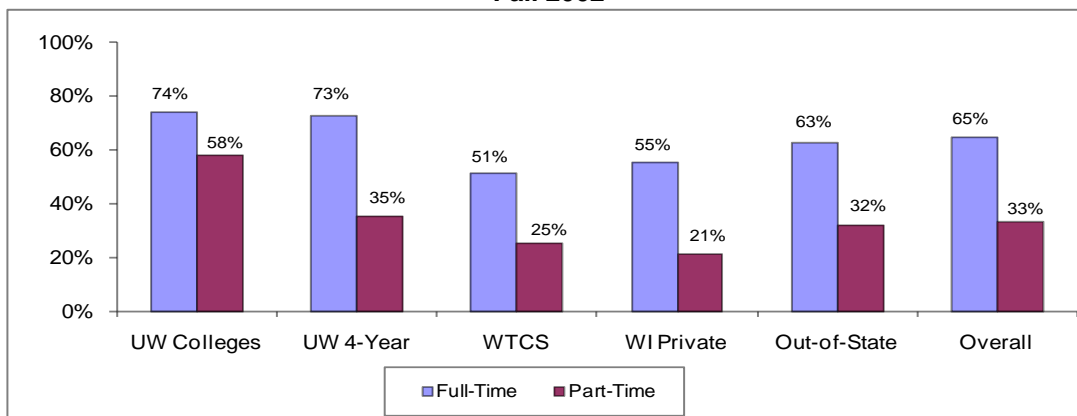
Six-year graduation rates also provide a measure of success for transfer students. Figure 17 shows six-year graduation rates at any UW institution for fall 2000, 2001, and 2002 new transfers by type of sending institution. These rates have improved over time for all types of sending institutions, with the exception of Wisconsin private institutions, where the fall 2002 new transfer cohort has a slightly lower six-year graduation rate (48%) than the fall 2000 (49%) and 2001 (50%) new transfer cohorts. Fall 2002 new transfers from UW Colleges had the highest six-year graduation rate (72%), followed by fall 2002 new transfers from UW 4-Year institutions (68%). A lower six-year graduation rate for students transferring from Wisconsin Technical Colleges may be affected by a higher proportion of non-traditional and part-time students who may take longer to graduate. Seven percent (7%) of the fall 2002 new transfers from Wisconsin Technical Colleges were still enrolled in the 7th year, while overall only 4 percent of the fall 2002 new transfers were enrolled in the 7th year. Appendix N shows six-year graduation rates for the fall 2002 new transfer cohort to the UW System by sending institution and full-time/part-time status. Appendix O shows six-year graduation rates for the fall 2002 new transfer cohort by type of sending institution and receiving institution.

Six-year graduation rates for new transfer cohort entering as full-time students were much higher than for those entering as part-time students (Figure 18). Overall, 65 percent of new transfer students entering as full-time students in fall 2002 graduated within six years, compared to 33 percent for part-time new transfer students. The six-year graduation rates varied by type of sending institution, ranging from 74 percent for new transfers from UW Colleges entering as full-time students in fall 2002 to 51 percent for new transfers from Wisconsin Technical Colleges entering as full-time students in fall 2002. In comparison, the UW System six-year graduation rate for new freshmen who entered as full-time students in fall 2002 was 65 percent.

Overall, students who transferred as sophomores or upperclassmen had higher six-year graduation rates than students who transferred as freshmen. Within the same student level, these rates varied by type of sending institution. For example, six-year graduation rates ranged from 73 percent for fall 2002 new sophomore transfers from UW 4-Year institutions to 57 percent for fall 2002 new sophomore transfers from Wisconsin Technical Colleges (Figure 19).

Fall 2002

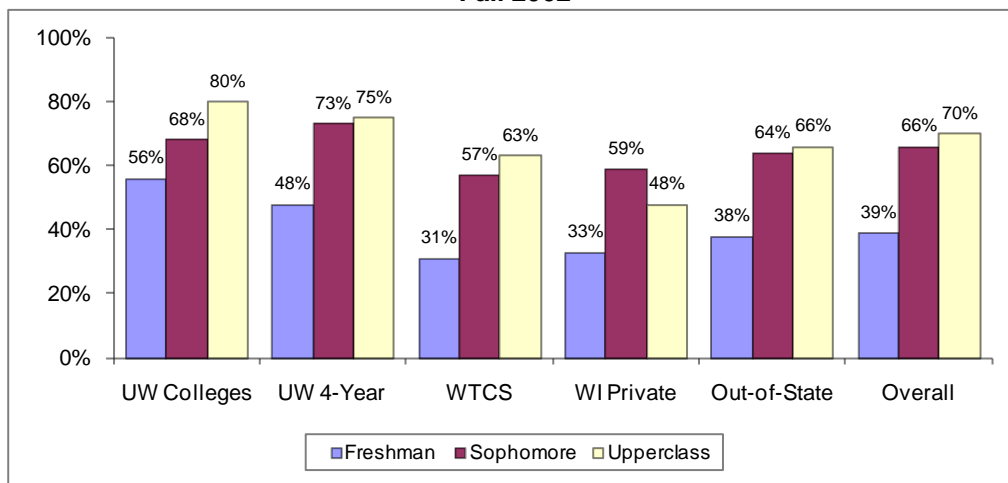
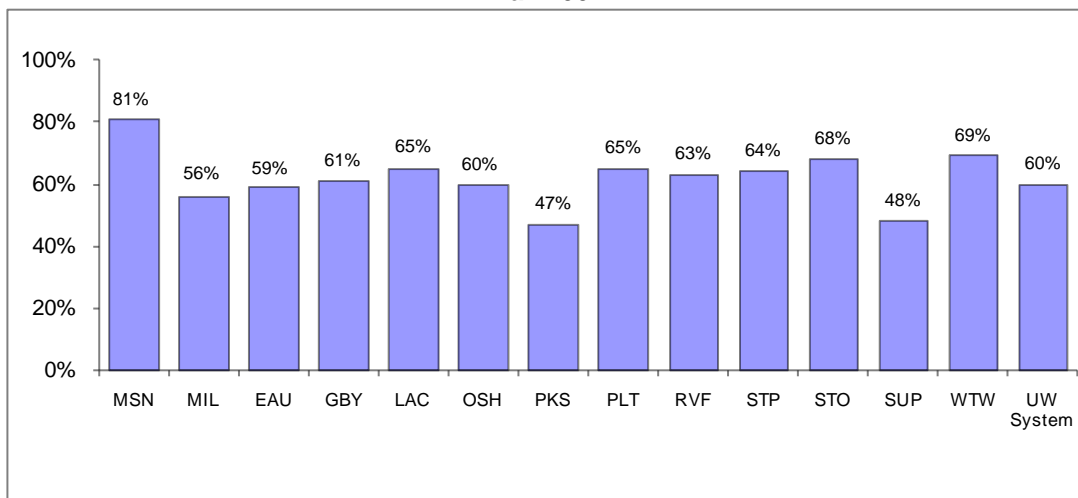


Figure 20 shows the six-year graduation rates of fall 2002 new transfer cohort by the UW receiving institution. Overall, the UW System six-year graduation rate was 60 percent. The six-year graduation rates varied by the UW receiving institution, ranging from 81 percent for the new transfer cohort at UW-Madison to 47 percent for the new transfer cohort at UW-Parkside. Appendix P shows six-year graduation rates for the fall 2002 new transfer cohort by receiving institution and student classification.
