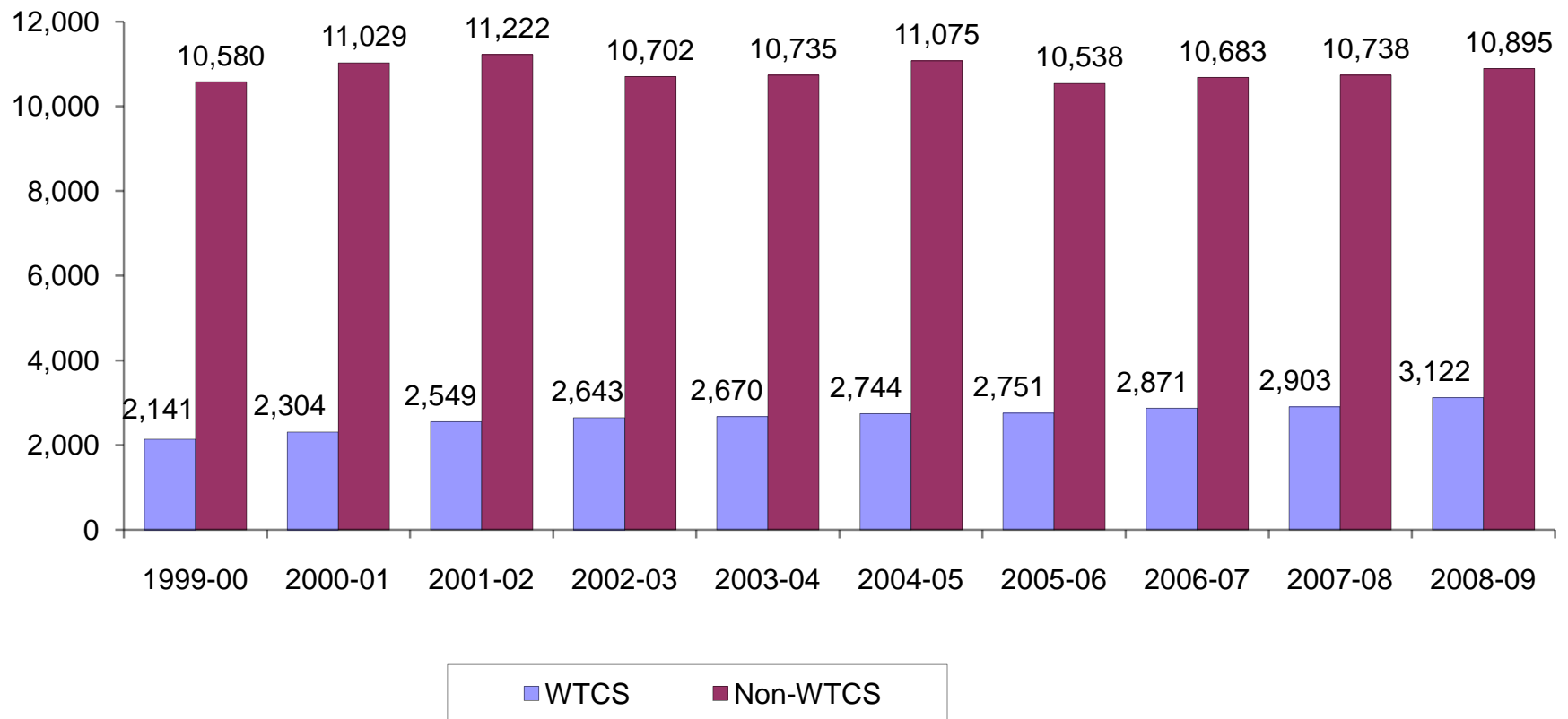

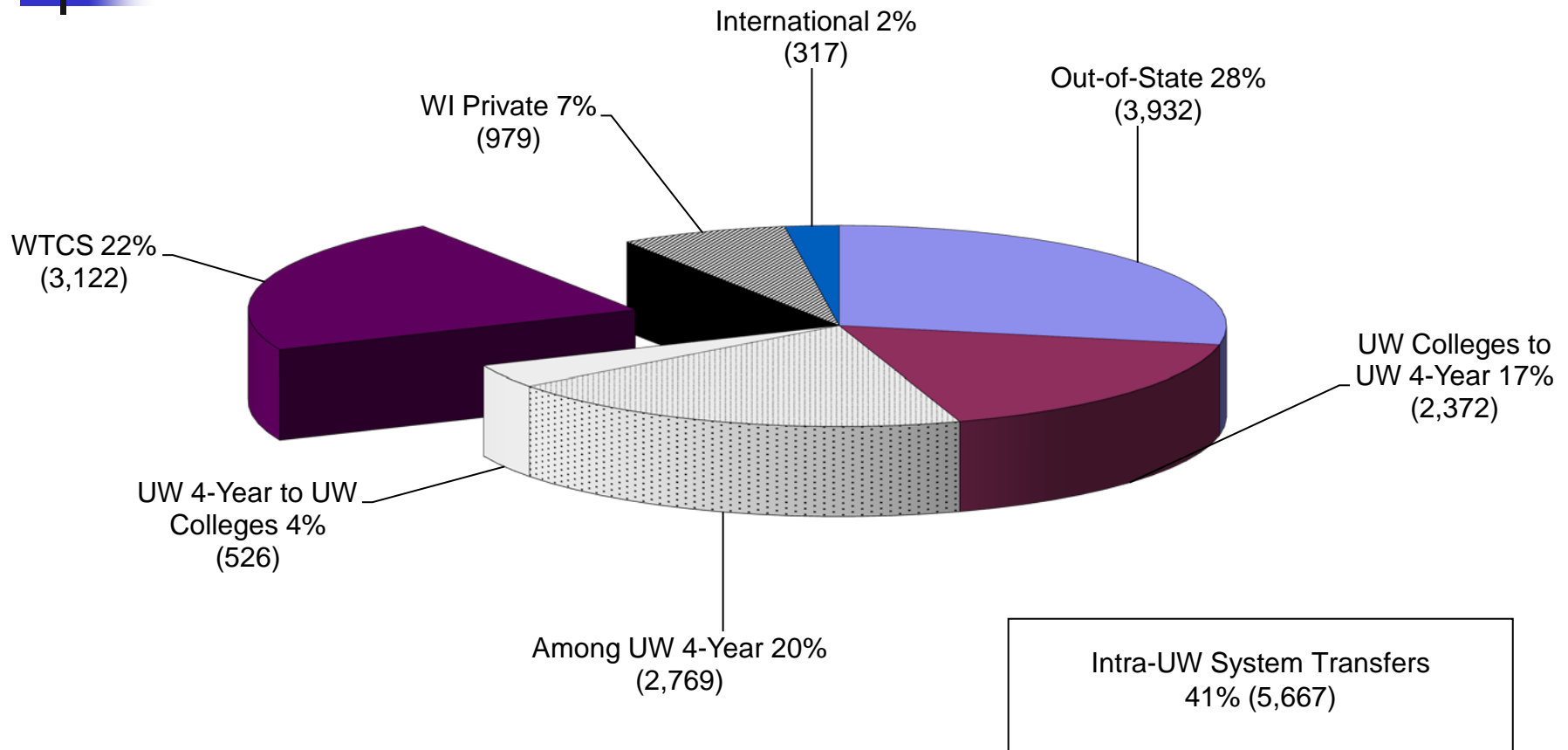

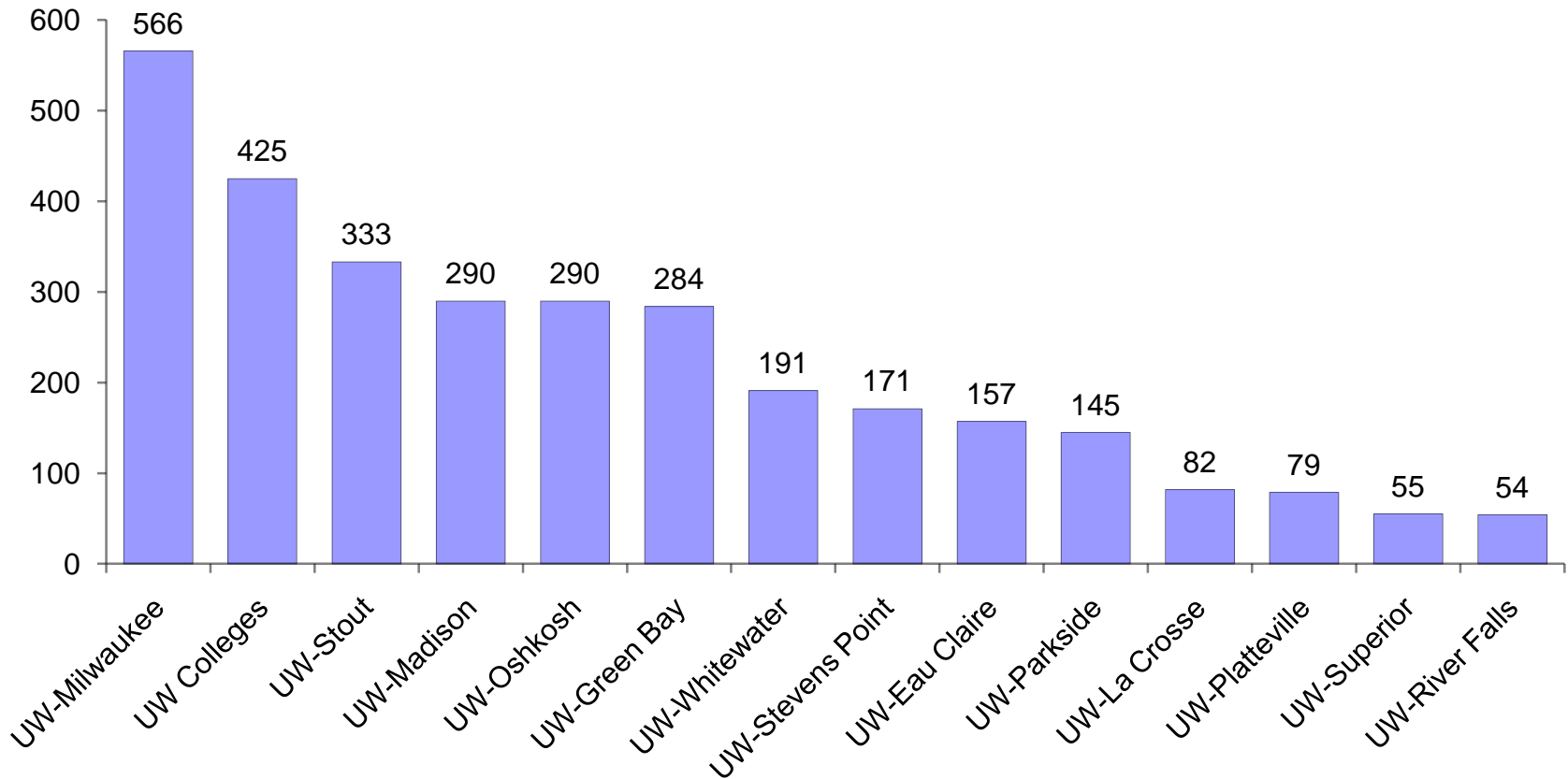

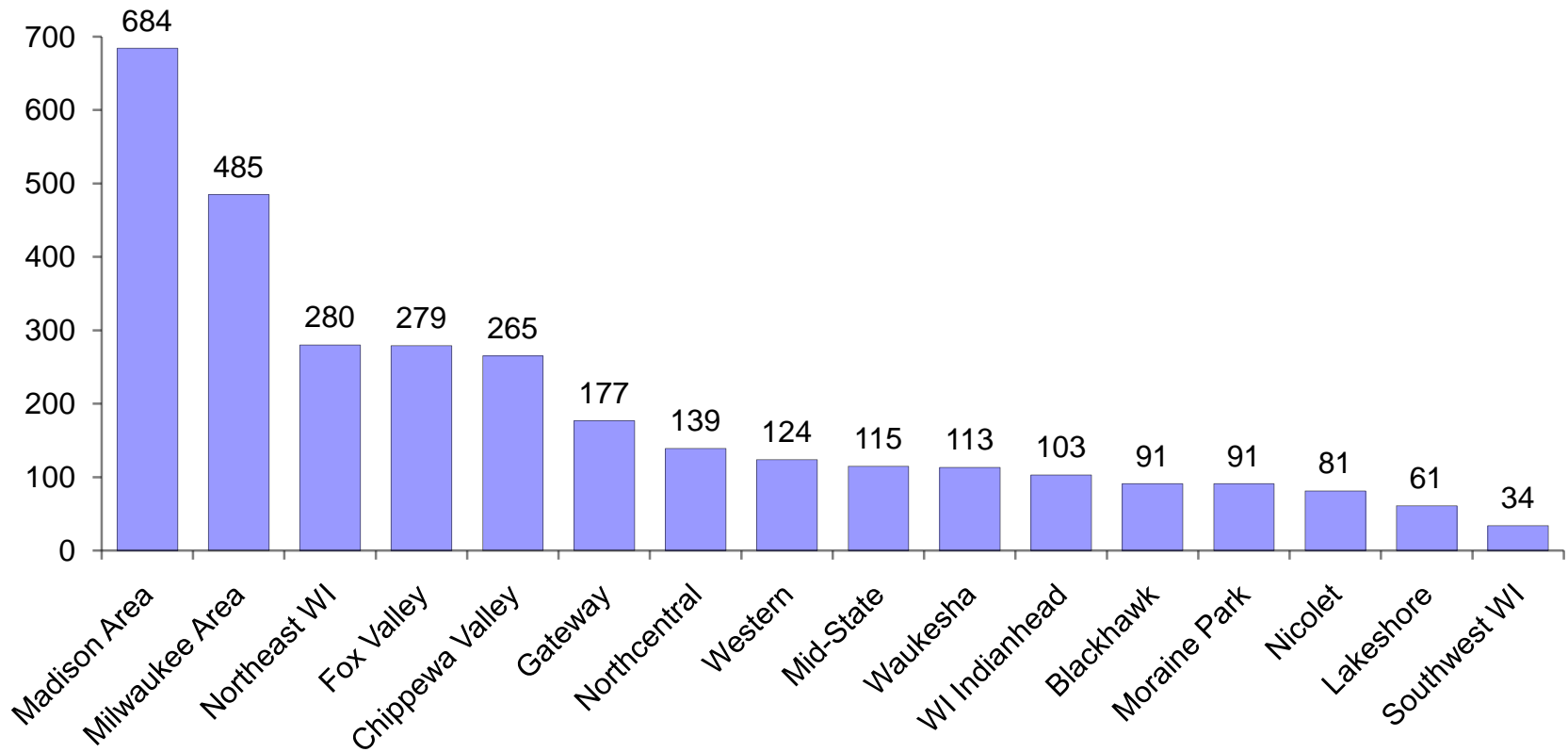
New Transfer Students to UW System by Source : 2008-09



New WTCS Transfer Students to UW System by Receiving Institution: 2008-09



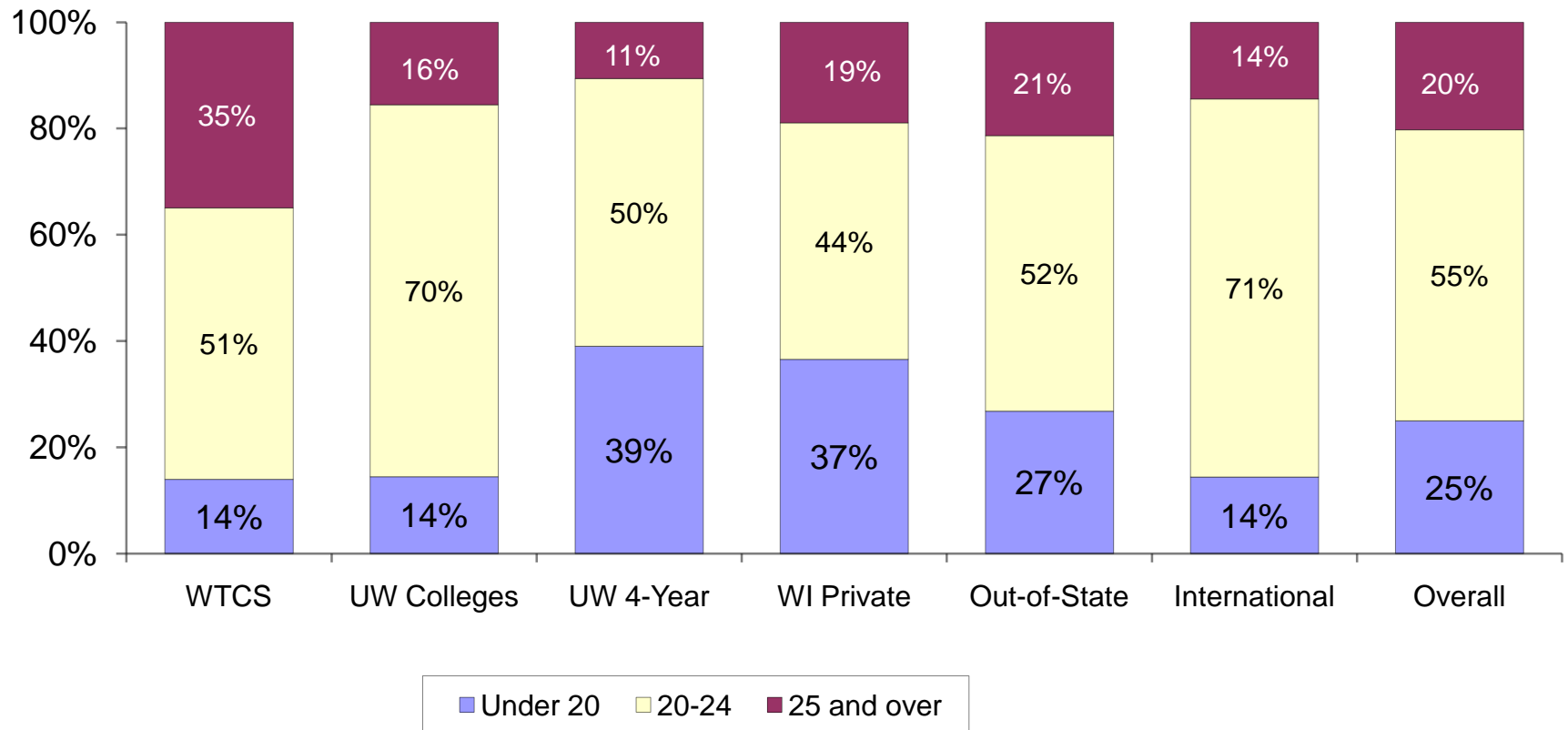
New WTCS Transfer Students to UW System by Sending Institution: 2008-09



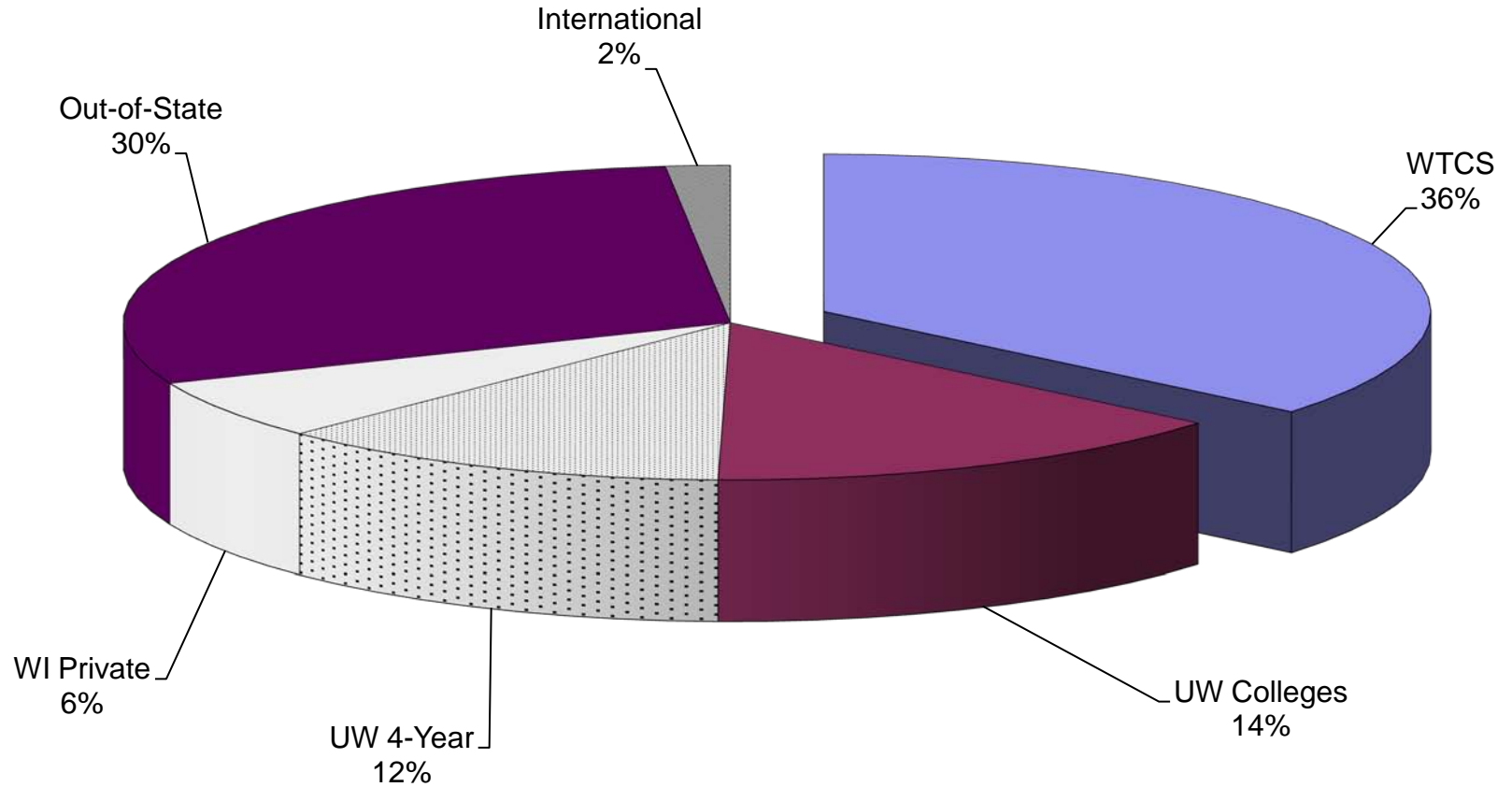

New Transfer Students to UW System by Age Group: Fall 2008

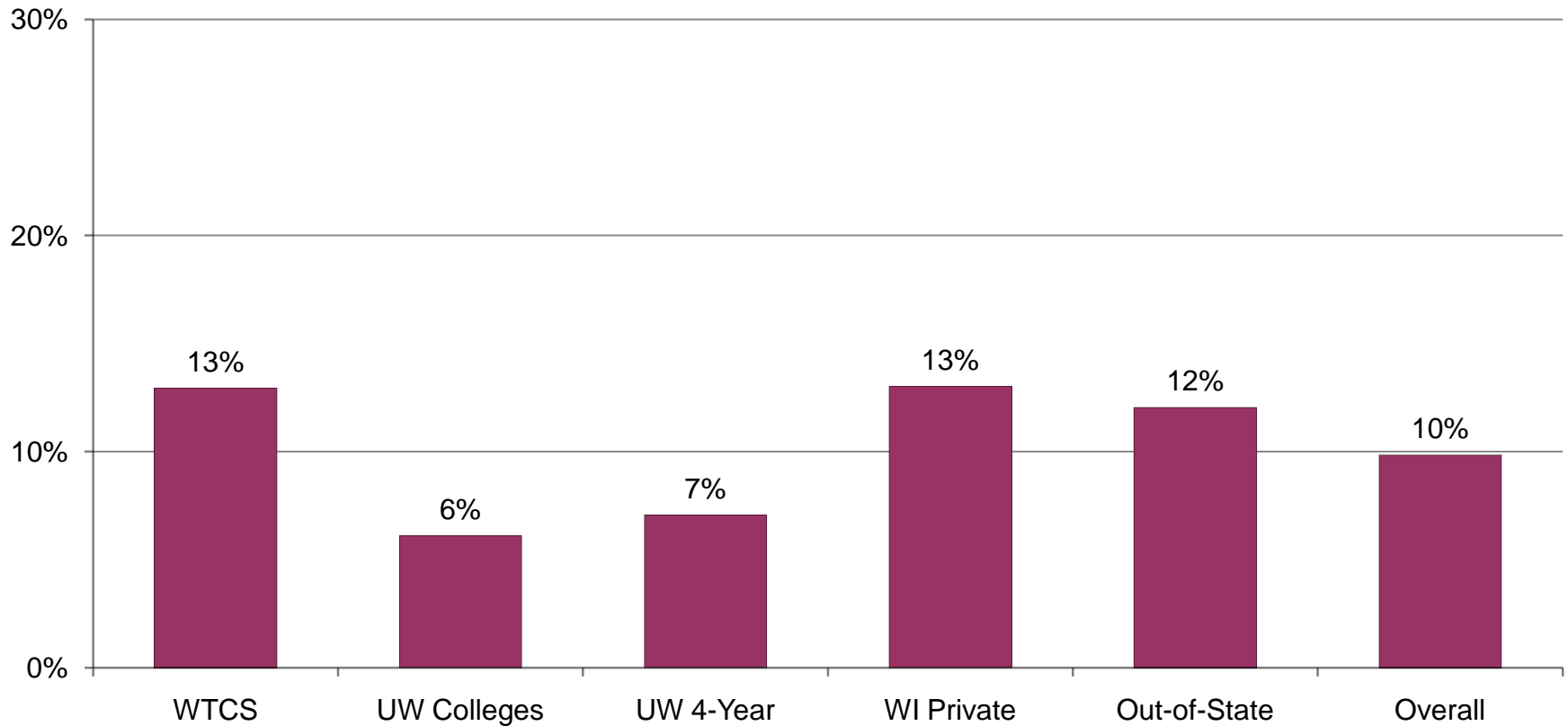


WTCS is a Major Source of Non-Traditional Students Transferring to UW System: Fall 2008

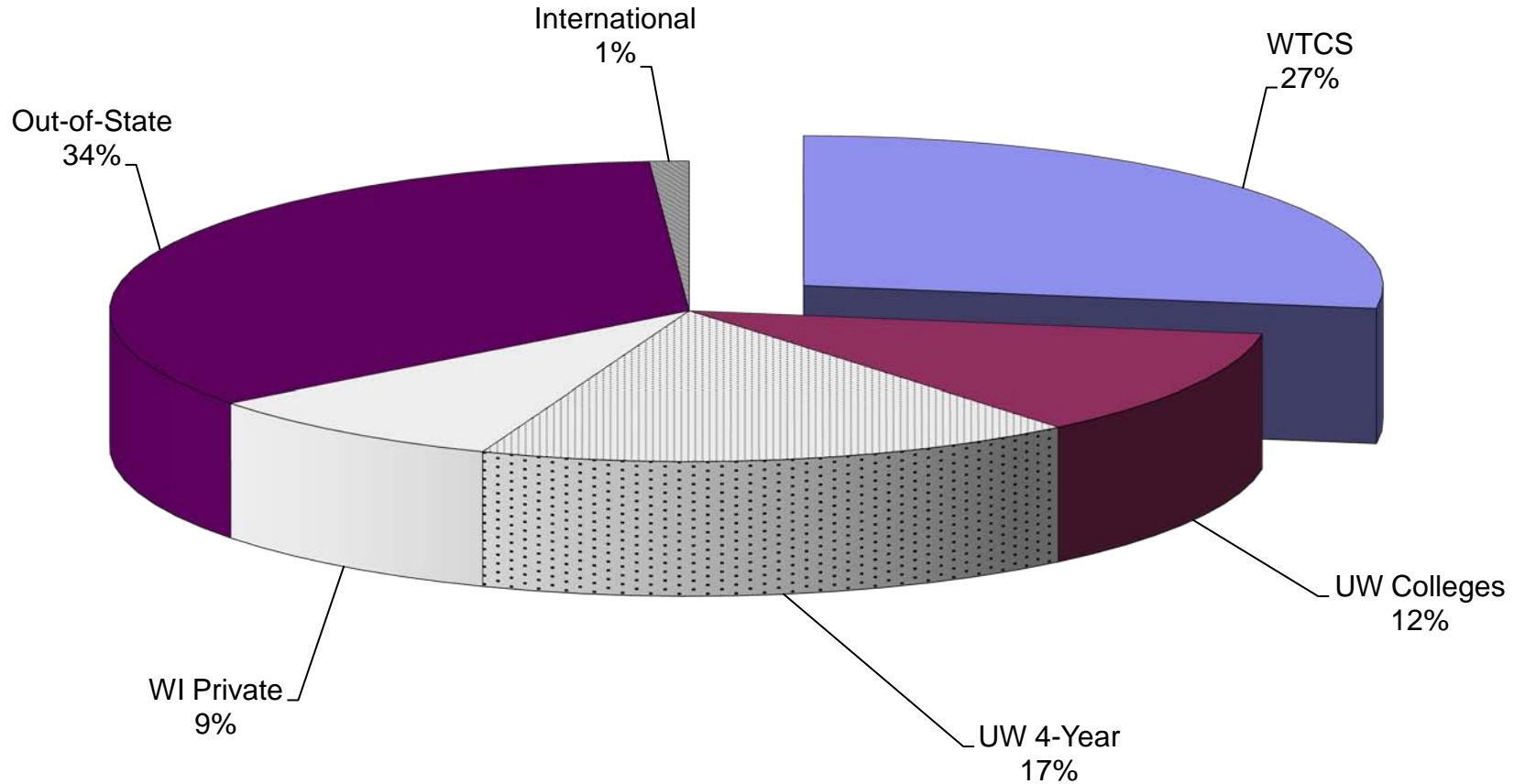


Percentage of new transfers age 25 or older by source

New Transfer Students to UW System by Race/Ethnicity: Fall 2008

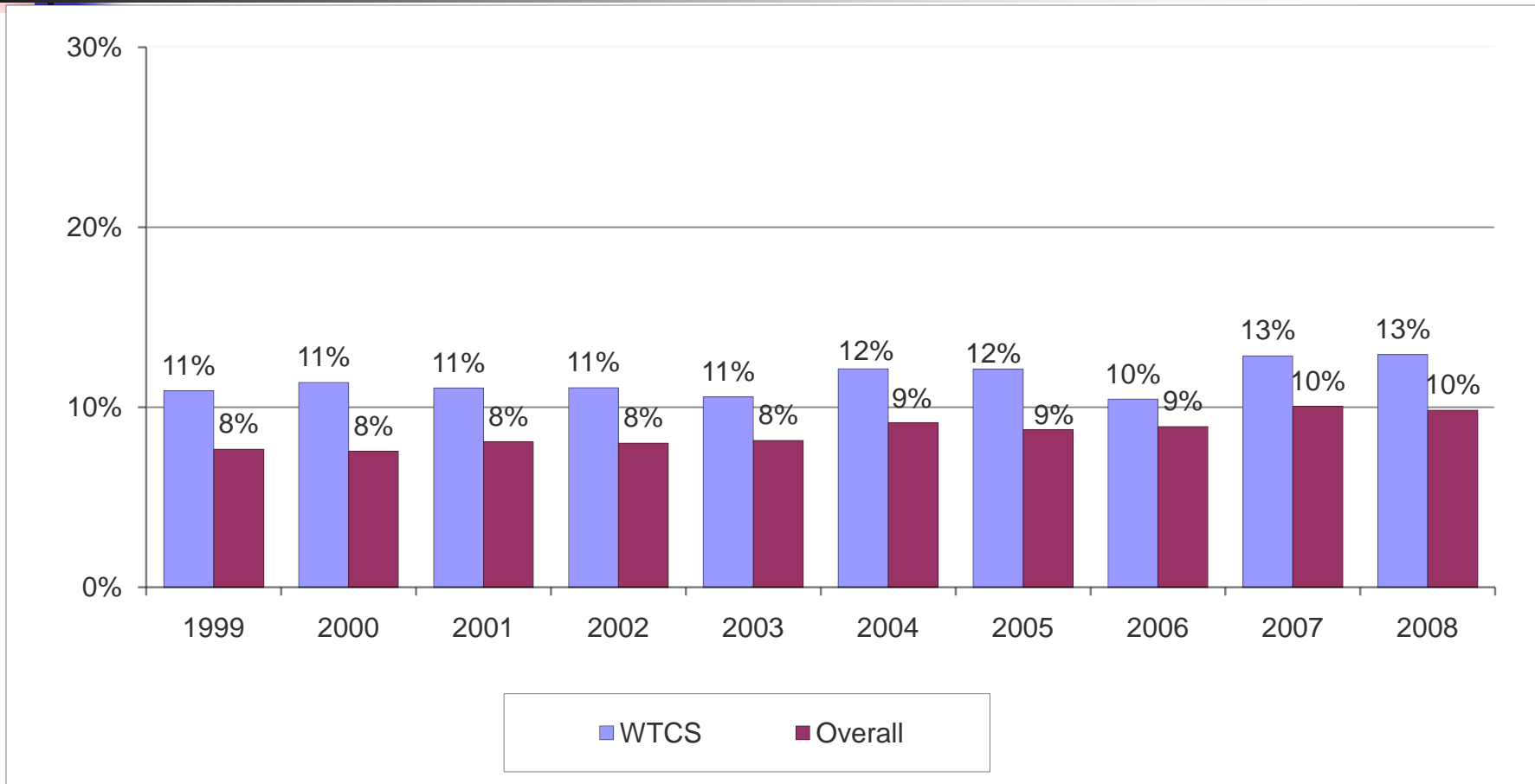


WTCS is a Major Source of Students of Color Transferring to UW System: Fall 2008

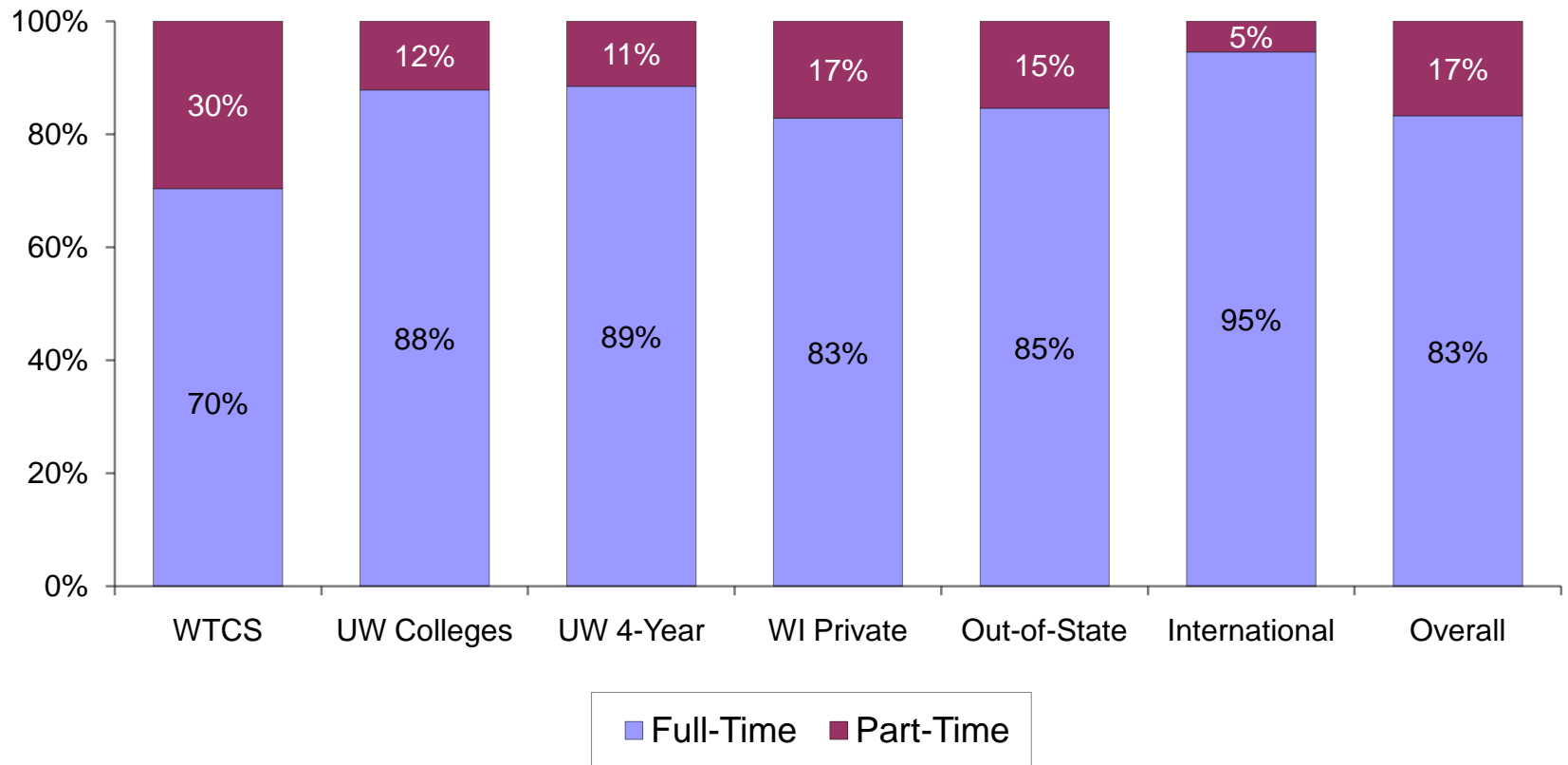


Percentage of students of color by source

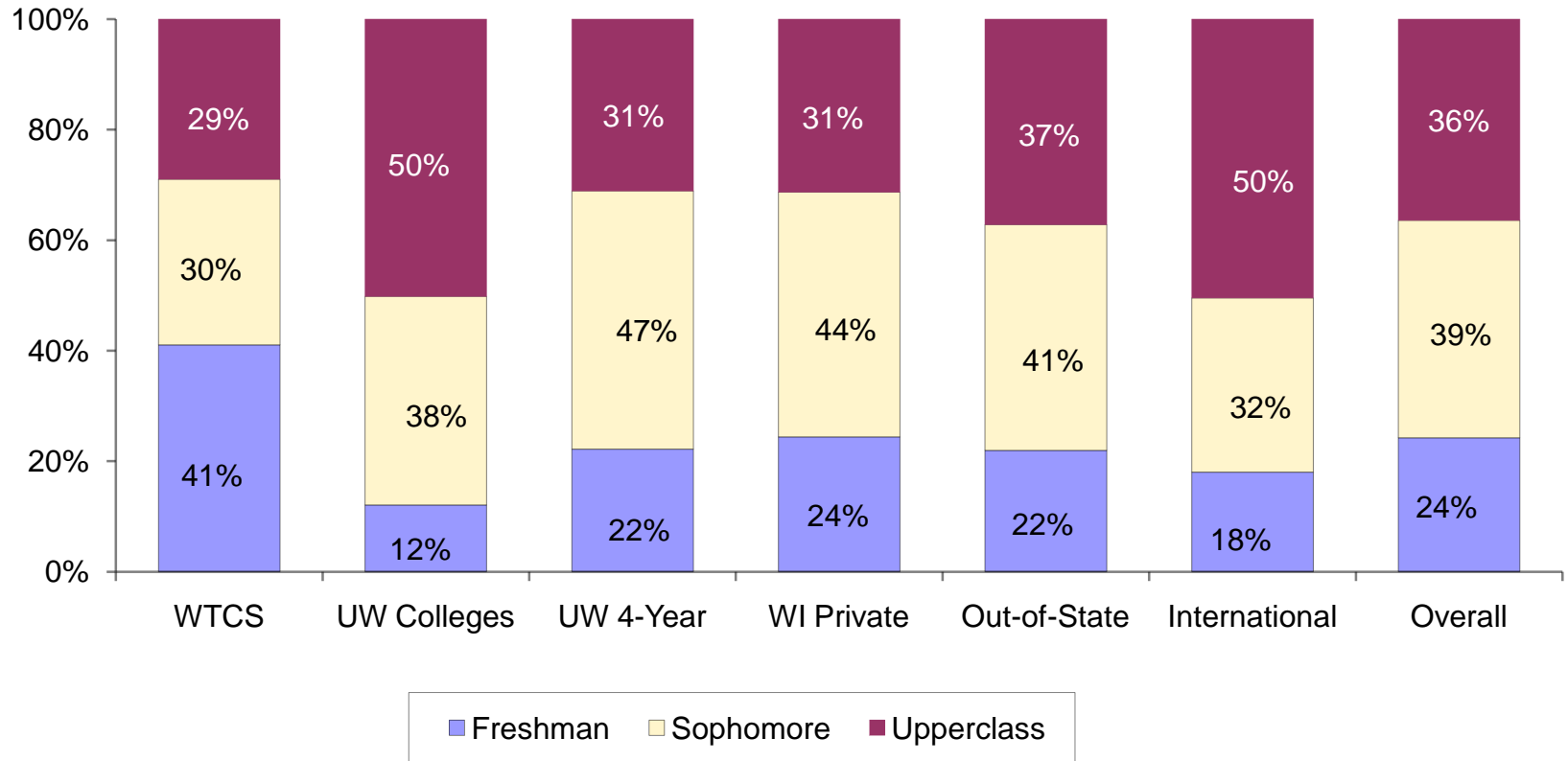
New Transfer Students to UW System by Race/Ethnicity: Fall 1999-Fall 2008



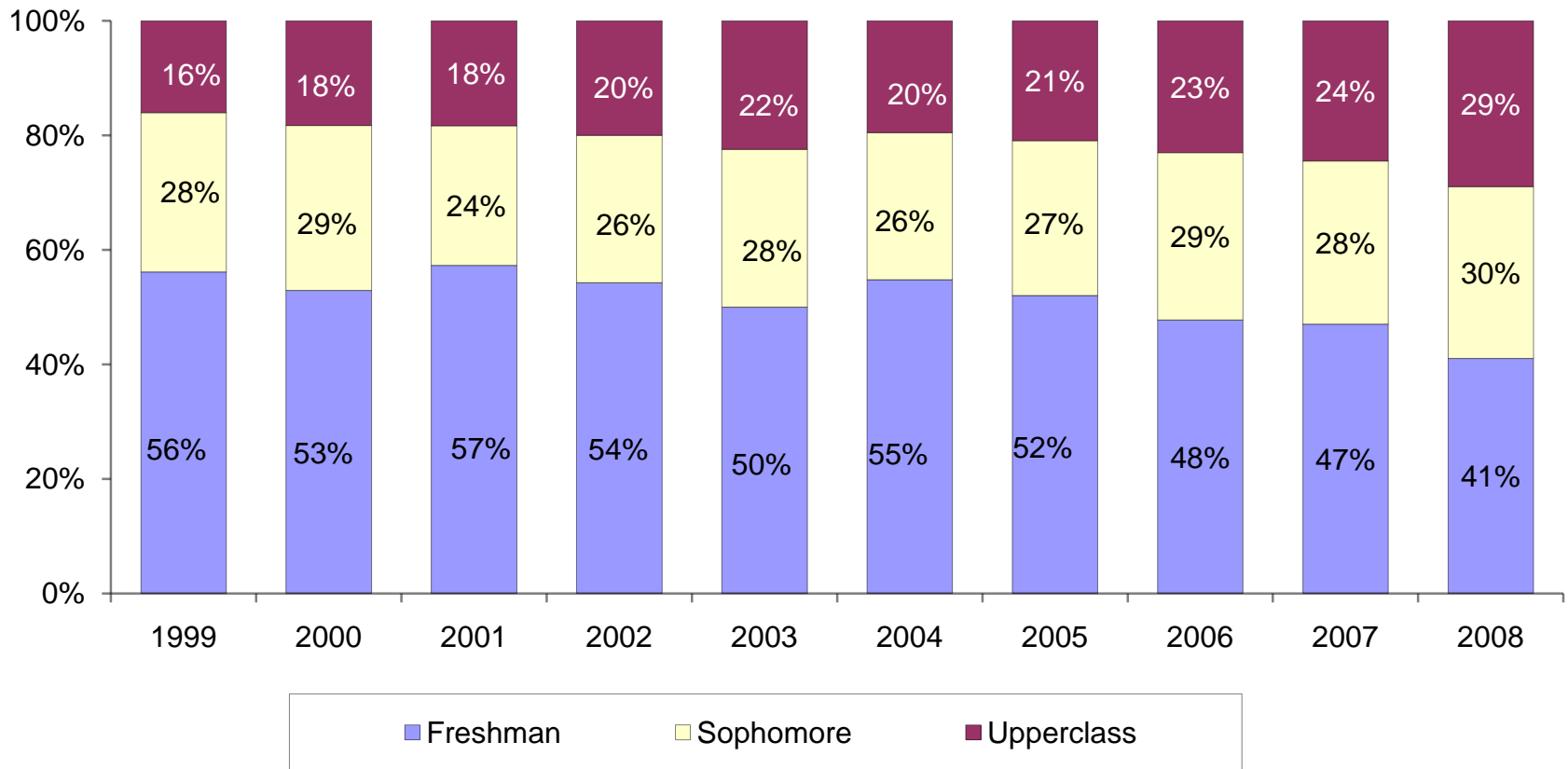
New Transfer Students to UW System by Full-Time/Part-Time Status: Fall 2008



New Transfer Students to UW System by Classification at Entrance: Fall 2008



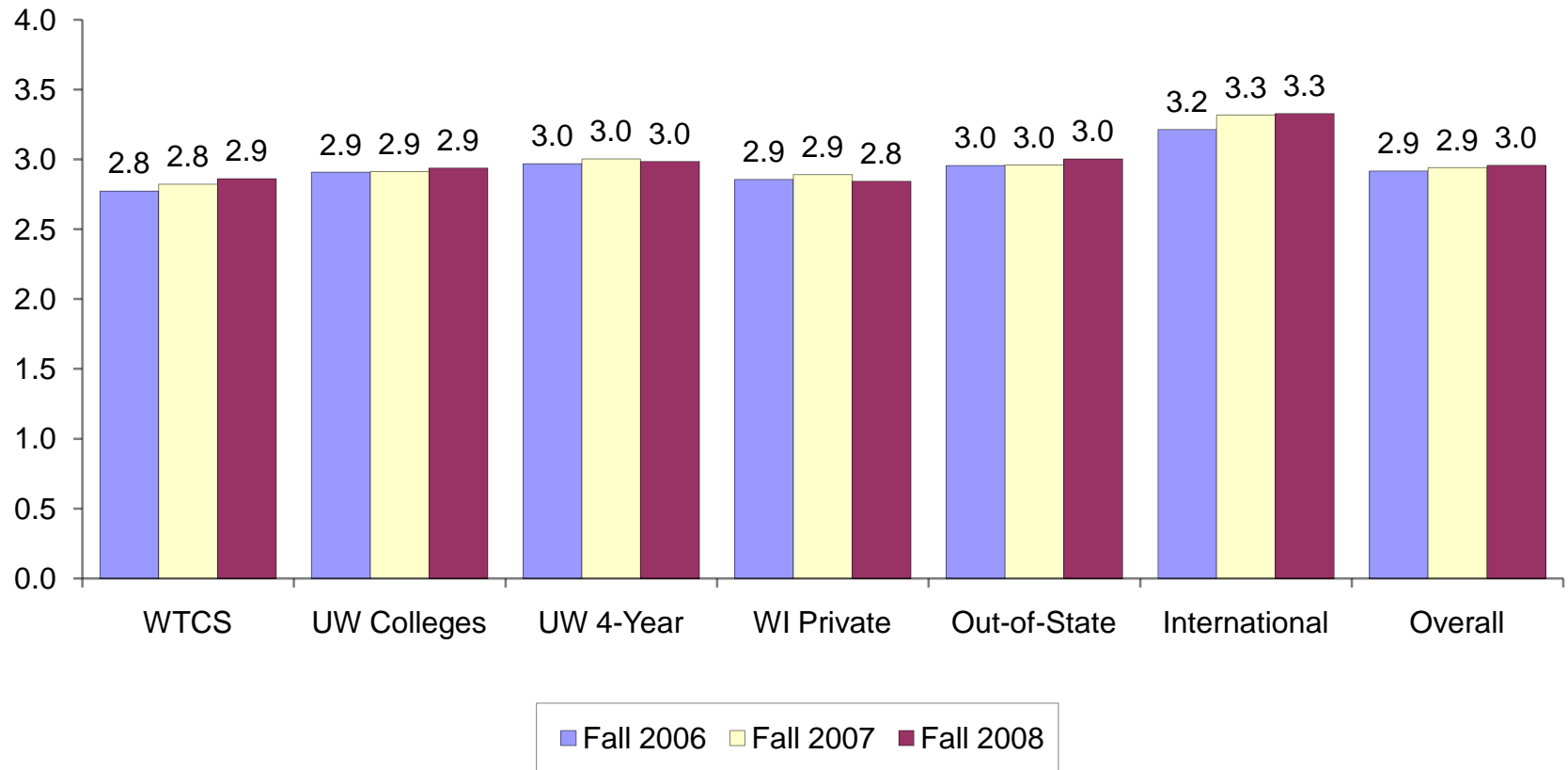
New WTCS Transfer Students to UW System by Classification at Entrance Fall 1999-Fall 2008



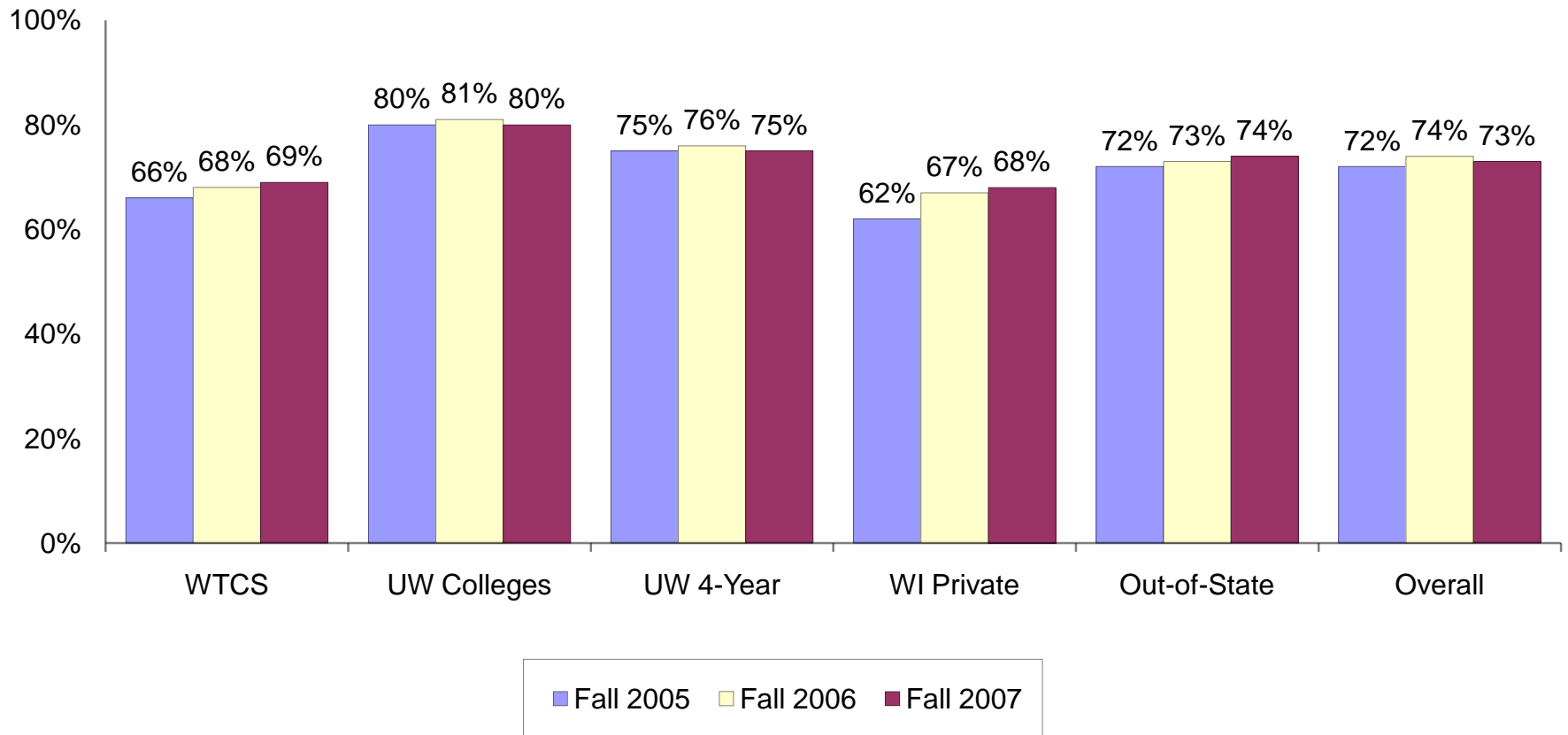

Average First Year GPA New Transfer Students to UW System

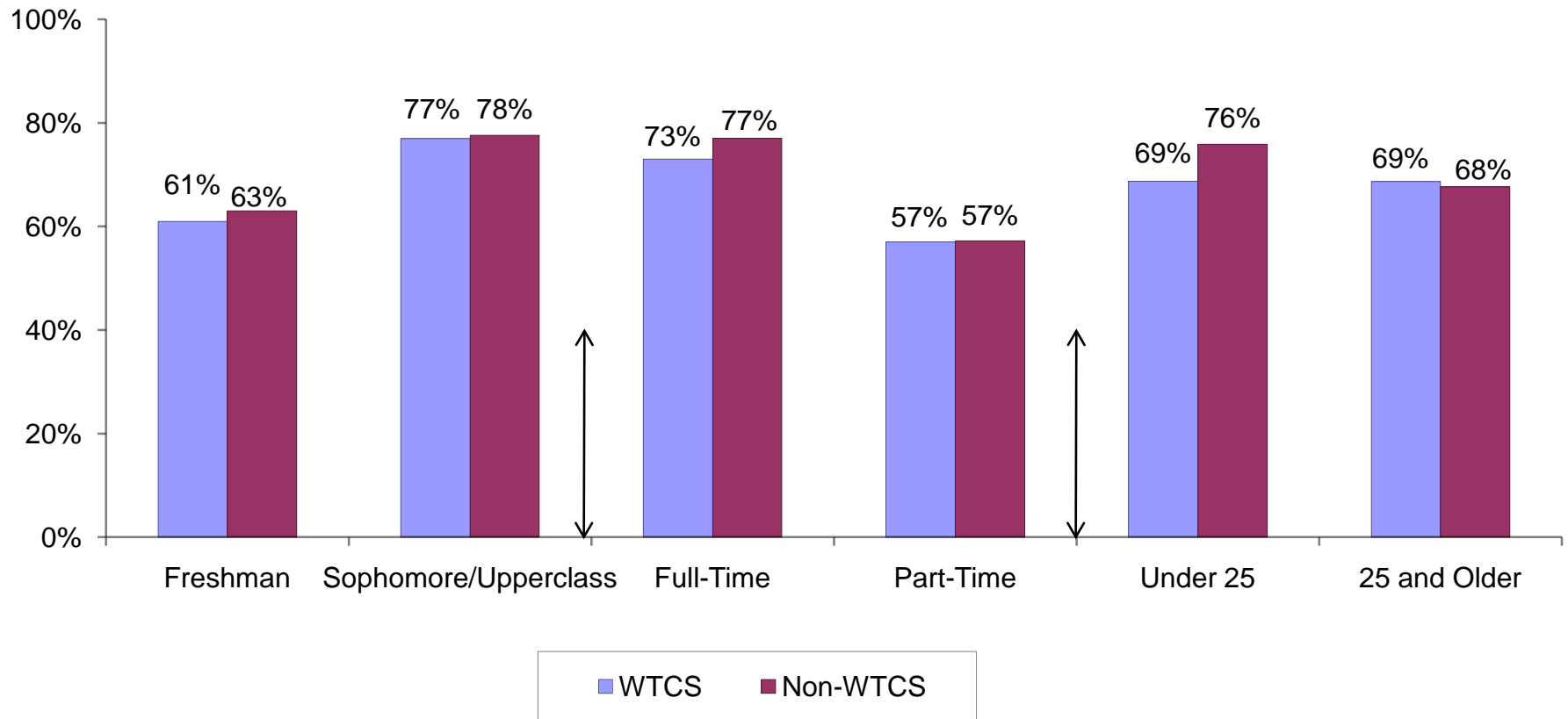


2nd Year Retention Rate New Transfer Students to UW System

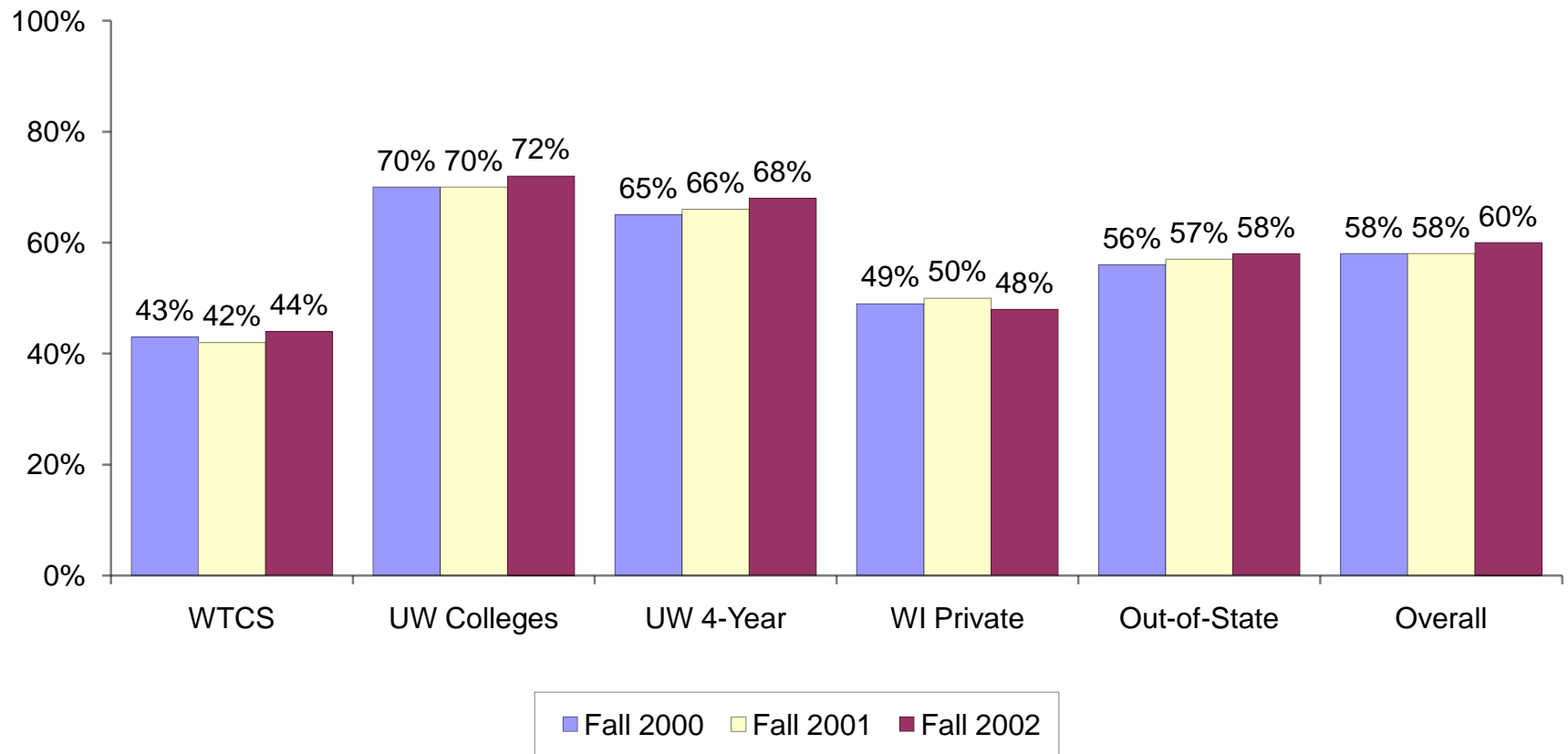


2nd Year Retention Rate

Fall 2007 New Transfer Cohort to UW System by Classification & Full-Time Status & Age

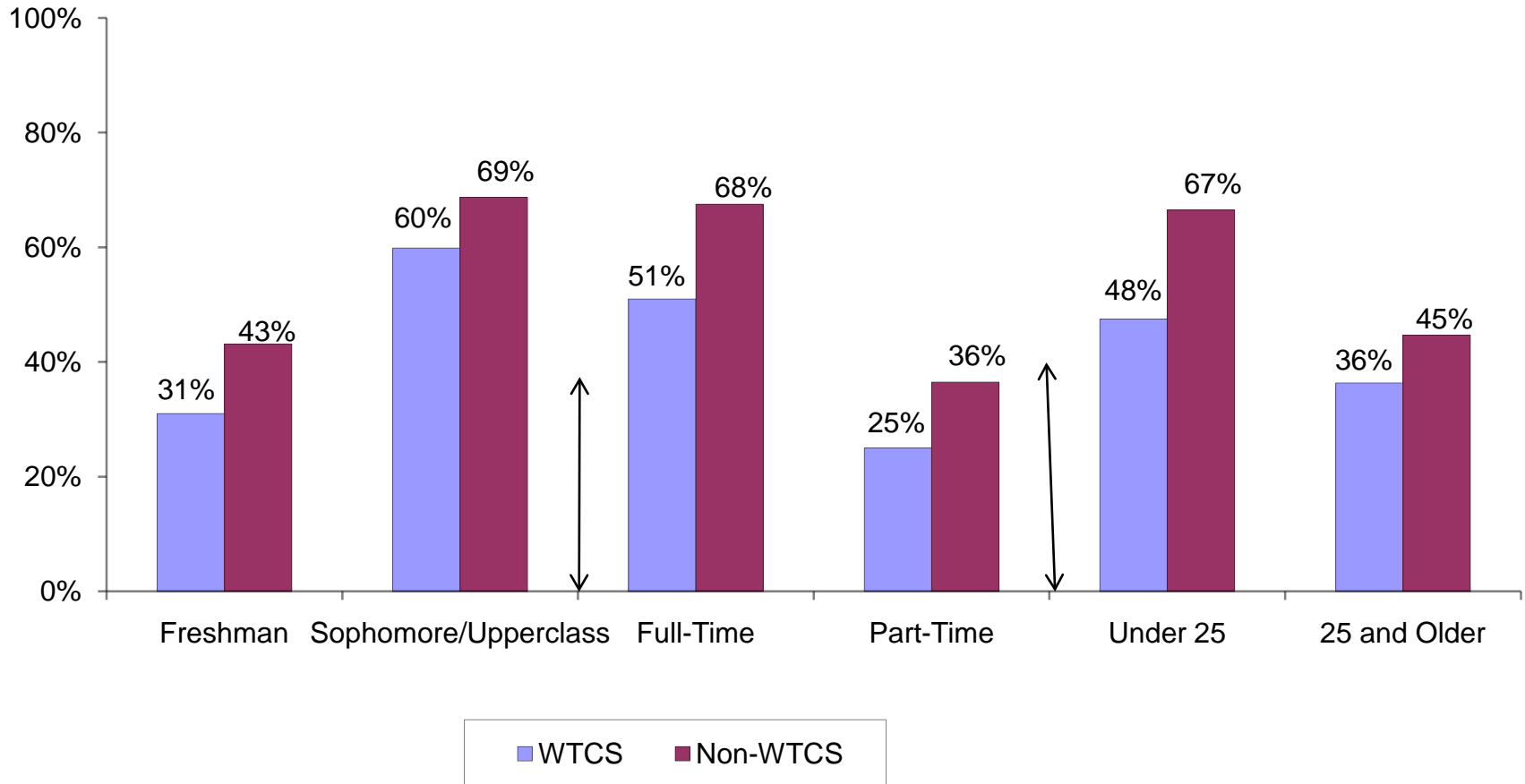


Six-Year Graduation Rate New Transfer Students to UW System

Summary

- More than 14,000 new students transferred into and within UW System institutions in 2008-09.
- More than 3,100 of these students transferred from the WTCS.
- The percentage of new transfer students from the WTCS has increased from 17% in 1999-00 to 22% in 2008-09.
- WTCS transfer students are older and are more likely to enroll part-time and at the freshman level.
- The percentage of WTCS students transferring to UW System at the sophomore or upperclass level has increased, from 44% in fall 1999 to 59% in fall 2008, a significant improvement.
- WTCS transfer students have about the same 1st year GPA's as other transfer students and slightly lower 2nd year retention rates but are less likely to graduate within 6 years after they transfer.
