Family Incomes of UW Resident New Freshmen

Wisconsin Family Income Quintile	1994	1996	1998	2000	2002	2004

Medium-High (\$66,000-\$92,000)	20.2%	20.3%	22.4%	23.3%	25.4%	24.5%

Wisconsin Covenant Requirements

- Demonstrate financial need by meeting income requirements
- Meet academic requirements while in high school
- Exhibit good citizenship

Income Eligibility Options

- Lowest income quintile (2004: below \$29,000)
- Lowest two income quintiles (2004: below \$47,000)
- Qualify for Federal Free Lunch Program/130% of poverty level (2005: below \$25,000*)
- Qualify for Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program/185% of poverty level (2005: below \$36,000*)

* Income based on a family of four

Academic Options

- Successfully complete college preparatory coursework while in high school
- Meet minimum high school grade point average or rank in class
- Graduate from a Wisconsin high school
- Meet UW admissions criteria

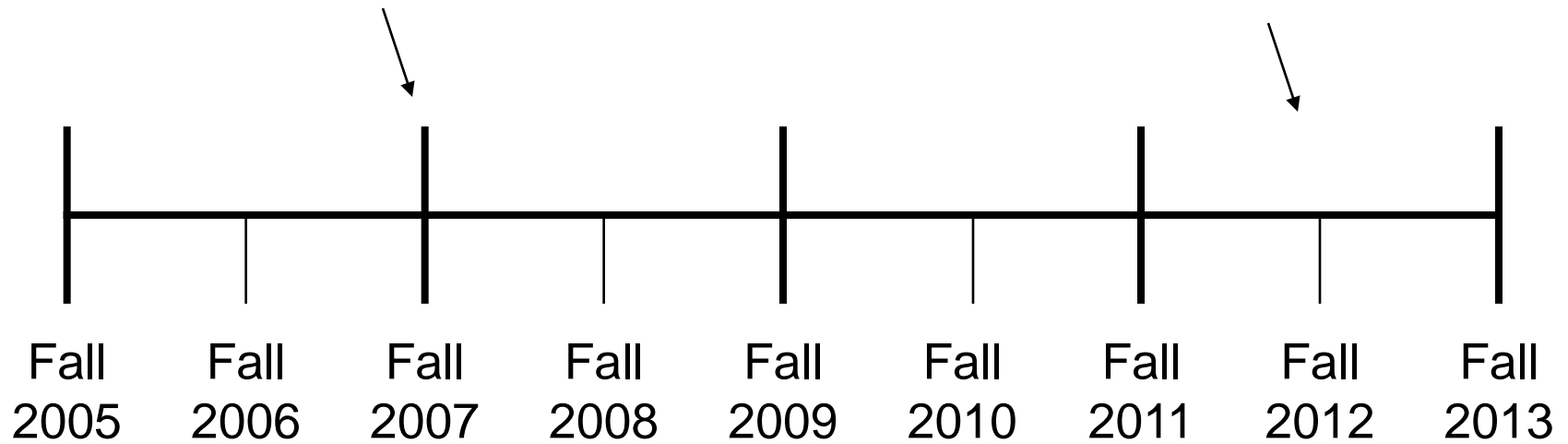
Good Citizenship Options

Lowest	74.8%	53.2%
Low-Medium	78.3%	59.7%
Medium	80.9%	64.6%
Medium-High	81.8%	68.4%
Highest	83.0%	72.3%
UW System	80.7%	62.2%

Prior to 2012-13

- Establish a short-term program until Wisconsin Covenant cohorts start enrolling in UW System
- Provide additional financial aid support targeted to the most financially needy UW students
- Ensure tuition/fees are covered
