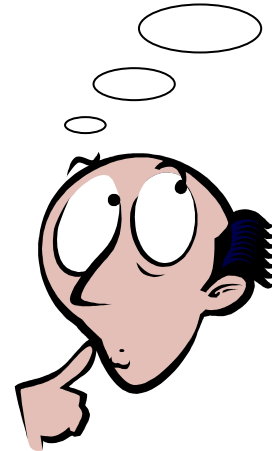

The Office of Professional and Instructional Development (OPID) invites each UW Institution to nominate one teaching fellow and one teaching scholar each academic year. A **teaching fellow** must be an untenured teacher who has between 2 and 6 years of full-time college instructing experience. Each fellow will be expected to design and complete a project during their fellowship year. A **teaching scholar** is faculty or academic staff who has over ten years of instructing experience. Scholars also design and complete a project that will conclude with a public presentation at OPID's Spring Conference.

This one hour brown bag discussion session, facilitated by Dr. Lindseth and Dr. Bonstead-Bruns, is an opportunity to hear about their experiences and have your questions about the teaching fellows and teaching scholars program answered.
