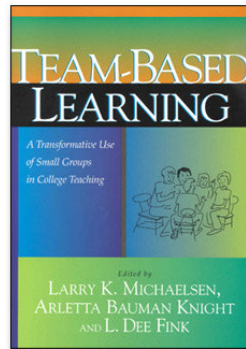

Dr. L. Dee Fink will return to UW-Eau Claire in May to facilitate two workshops. His first program, on Thursday, May 26, will be a full-day workshop on “Designing a Course to Create Significant Learning Experiences,” which is a repeat of the seminar he facilitated on campus last August. Attendees for this program will receive a complimentary copy of Dr. Fink’s book, *Creating Significant Learning Experiences*. This program will run from 8:30 a.m.—12:00 p.m. and from 1:00 p.m.—4:00 p.m. There will be morning and afternoon refreshments provided. Lunch is on your own.

Dr. Colin Shaw, an attendee of Fink’s seminar last August, attributes the successful redesign of his course to Fink’s model. “The most memorable part of the workshop for me was being introduced to the IF-AT system of scratch-off multiple choice exams,” said Shaw. “Students love it and I find it makes test taking more of a learning experience instead of just an assessment tool.”
