## **Access**

Each metric in the Access dashboard is described below. A link is provided to the underlying data for each metric. For some metrics, only the most recent year of data is linked because of the large volume of data. Click on Technical Notes for definitions of terms and other detail about the data.

### **Fall total enrollments**

Enrollments are shown as actual students (headcount) and as full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollments, which capture proportional course-taking activity of full- and part-time students. Detail is provided by fall semester and UW institution.

### **Total enrollments by race/ethnicity**

The percent of headcount enrollment by race/ethnicity is shown. Detail is provided by fall semester and UW institution.

### **New freshmen by geographic origin**

Maps of Wisconsin, the United States, and the world show UW new freshmen by their home address at the time of application to the UW System. New freshmen from Wisconsin are shown by Wisconsin county. New freshmen from other U.S. states are shown by state. New freshman from the United States without a state or zip code are not included. New freshmen from other countries are shown by country. Because of the large volume of data, only the most recent year is included in the table linked below.

### **Participation of Wisconsin high school graduates**

Historically, 32% of Wisconsin High School students have enrolled in the UW System immediately after graduation. Rates are provided by year for the UW System overall. Detail on the participation rate is shown for each year: the number of Wisconsin High School Graduates and the number of Wisconsin Immediate New Freshmen for each Year.

## **Participation Rate by race/ethnicity**

Participation rates are shown by race/ethnicity and year.

## **Annual new transfer students**

New transfer students are students who have not previously enrolled at the institution to which they transferred. New transfers are shown by year and by the UW institution they transferred to and by the institution or sector they transferred from: UW Colleges, UW 4-year institutions, Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS), Wisconsin Private Institutions, out-of-state institutions, or international institutions.

## **Fall new transfer students by Race/ethnicity**

The percent of fall new transfer students by race/ethnicity is shown by year, and by the UW institution they transferred to.

## **Undergraduates receiving Pell Grants**

Pell Grants are provided to students with financial need using federal guidelines. The percent of undergraduates receiving Pell Grants is shown by year and by UW institution. Also shown is the national percentage of undergraduates receiving Pell Grants.

## **Underrepresented minorities and Pell Grant recipients by residency status**

The percent of students who are underrepresented minorities is shown by year, UW institution, graduate or undergraduate student level, and residency status (fee basis). Underrepresented minority (URM) students include those who indicated African American, American Indian, Hispanic/Latino (a), or Southeast Asian alone or in combination with other race/ethnicities. Also, the percent of undergraduates who received Pell is shown by year, UW institution, and residency status (fee basis). Pell Grants are provided to undergraduate students with financial need using federal guidelines.
