Administrative Management

Each measure in the Administrative Management dashboard is described below. A link is provided to the underlying data for each measure. For some measures, only the most recent year of data is linked because of the large volume of data. Click on Technical Notes for definitions of terms and other detail about the data.

Administrative spending

Spending on administration is identified using the "institutional support" classification developed by the National Association of College and University Business Officers (NACUBO). Institutional support includes systemwide management and long-range planning, fiscal operations, administrative computing, space management, personnel management, and related administrative functions. Administrative expenditures are provided as a percent of overall operating expenditures by fiscal year and UW institution.

Credits to degree

Average credits attempted by Bachelor's degree recipients are provided by academic year of graduation, UW institution and whether the credits attempted include any UW institution or the same UW institution. Credits to degree at "Any UW" includes UW credits attempted at any UW institution by students starting as new freshmen at any UW institution, including UW Colleges. "Same UW" is based on new freshmen who started at and graduated from the same UW institution.

Affordability

Published tuition and fees are provided as a percent of median state family income by academic year and UW institution. Tuition and fees are for resident (in-state) new freshmen attending full-time for one year (two semesters).
