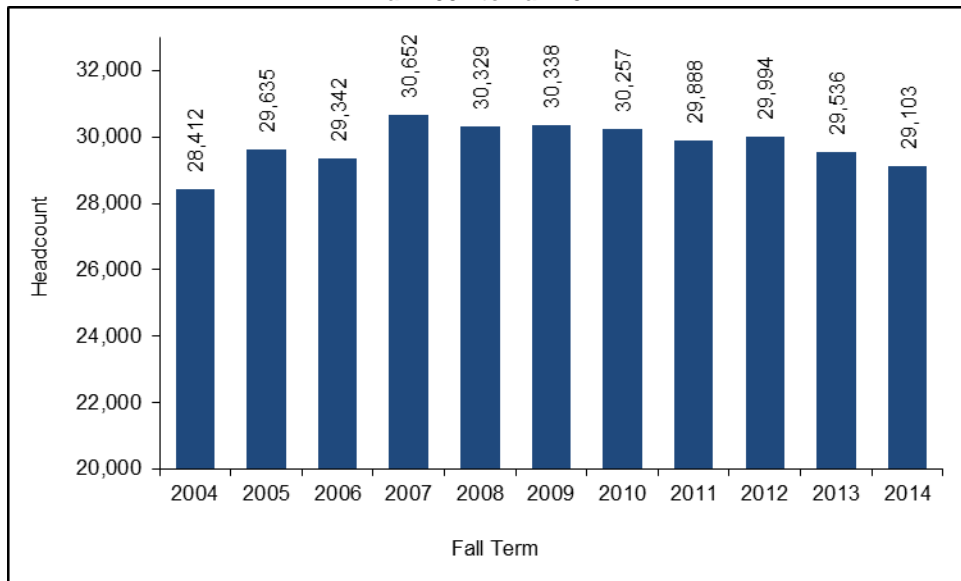

The New Freshman Class: Fall 2014

**UW System New Freshman Headcount Enrollment
Fall 2004 to Fall 2014**



Highlights

APPLICATION AND ADMISSION

In fall 2014, 67,596 individuals applied to UW institutions as new freshmen. Among these individuals, 58,879 applicants submitted the required documents and fee to complete an application and 46,730 were admitted to at least one UW institution. A total of 29,103 new freshmen enrolled in the UW System in fall 2014.

The total number of new freshman applicants for fall 2014 has increased 24.3 percent (13,206) from fall 2004. The systemwide admission rate declined 8.8 percentage points from ten years ago while the number of admitted students increased 4.3 percent (1,927). The systemwide yield rate decreased 1.1 percentage points while the fall 2014 new freshmen enrollment increased 2.4 percent (691) from fall 2004. See Appendix A for details.

Resident Status

The number of Wisconsin resident new freshman applicants decreased over the last few years while the number of non-resident applicants increased (Table 1). In fall 2014, 31,178 Wisconsin resident new freshman applicants completed an application, down from 35,830 in fall 2009. The number of non-resident applicants who completed an application was 20,652, twice the number in fall 2004. As a result, the proportion of non-resident applicants increased while the proportion of Wisconsin resident applicants decreased. The admission rates and yield rates for Wisconsin resident new freshman applicants stayed stable over the last decade and were the highest among all applicant groups. In fall 2014, Wisconsin resident new freshman applicants had an admission rate of 94.0 percent and a yield rate of 76.1 percent. Non-resident new freshman applicants had the lowest admission rates among all applicant groups in fall 2009 and fall 2014 due to the large increase in the number of applicants. Non-resident applicants also had the lowest yield rates among all groups of applicants. Gender

Female applicants comprised 51.9 percent (35,068) of the new freshman applicants in fall 2014, while 48.1 percent (32,528) were male applicants (Table 2). The proportion of male applicants has increased over time, although the majority of applicants are still female. In 2004, 2009, and 2014, female applicants maintained a higher admission rate while admitted males maintained a higher yield rate. The admission rates for both males and females in fall 2014 declined from ten and five years ago. See Appendix C for applications, admissions, and enrollment by gender and UW institution.

Underrepresented Minority (URM) Status

The proportion of underrepresented minority (URM) applicants increased from 9.0 percent to 15.9 percent and the proportion of non-URM applicants decreased from 87.9 percent to 74.0 percent from ten years ago (Table 3). The number of international applicants has more than quadrupled since 2004. The admission rate for URM applicants has decreased from ten and five years ago. Compared with non-URM applicants, URM applicants had lower admission rates but similar yield rates in the three years presented below. ENROLLMENT

Headcount

In fall 2014, 29,103 new freshmen enrolled in the UW System (Table 4). This is a decrease of 1,235 students (4.1%) from fall 2009 but an increase of 691 (2.4%) from ten years ago. The fall 2014 enrollment was down 433 students (1.5%) from fall 2013 and was down 1,549 students (5.1%) from fall 2007, when the all-time high number of new freshmen was recorded (30,652).

UW-Madison, UW Colleges, and UW-Milwaukee enroll almost half of the UW System new freshmen (Table 4). In fall 2014, the new freshman proportion of total institutional headcount enrollment ranged from 11.1 percent at UW-Green Bay to 27.4 percent at UW Colleges. DEMOGRAPHICS

Resident Status

In fall 2014, 76.6 percent (22,289) of new freshmen were Wisconsin residents, 13.4 percent (3,891) were non-resident new freshmen, and the remaining 10.0 percent (2,923) were enrolled under the Minnesota or Michigan reciprocity agreements (Table 5). Non-resident students include those enrolled in special tuition programs. In fall 2014, 391 new freshmen enrolled in UW-Platteville's Tri-State Initiative, 621 new freshmen enrolled in the Midwest Student Exchange Program, and 21 new freshmen enrolled in the Return to Wisconsin program. Combined, these programs accounted for 26.5 percent of non-resident new freshmen in fall 2014.

The proportion of non-resident new freshmen continues to increase and was 13.4 percent in fall 2014. The proportion of Wisconsin resident new freshmen continues to decrease over the last ten years. The proportion of new freshmen who enrolled under the Minnesota or Michigan reciprocity agreements was stable around 10 percent in the last decade (Table 6).

Gender

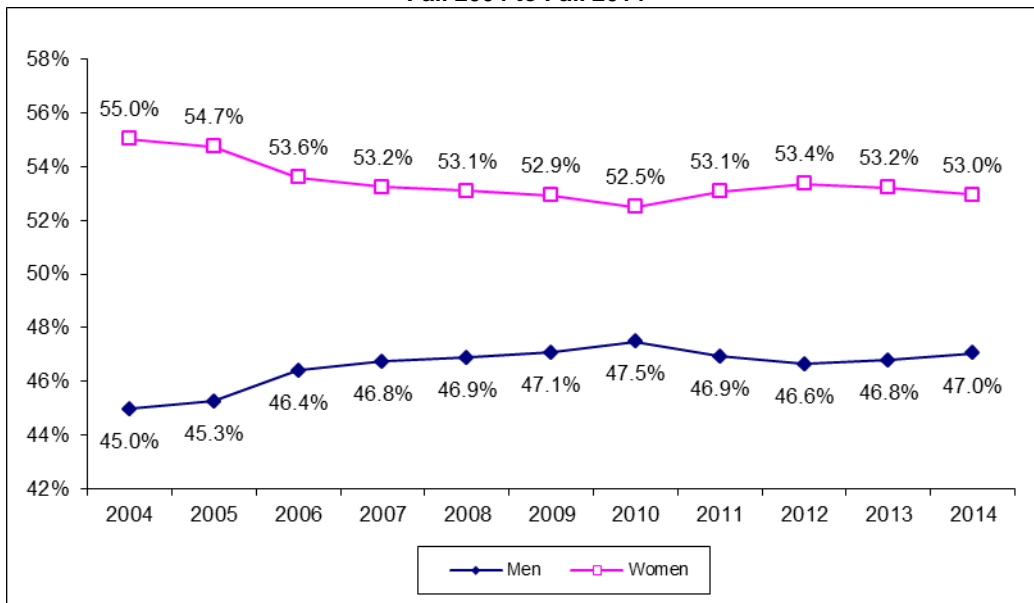
Female students comprised 53.0 percent of the new freshman class in fall 2014, while 47.0 percent were male students (Table 7). The percentage of female students ranged from 32.6 percent at UW-Platteville to 69.4 percent at UW-Green Bay.

Figure 1 shows the trend in new freshman enrollment by gender from fall 2004 to fall 2014. The gender gap between female and male students during the past ten years peaked in 2004 at 10.0 percentage points and had been declining between 2004 and 2010. The fall 2010 gender gap, 5.0 percentage points, was the smallest in the last decade. Female students have made up the majority of the UW System new freshman class since 1976.

Race and Ethnicity

In fall 2014, underrepresented minority (URM) students made up 13.5 percent (3,942) of the new freshman class, while 83.9 percent (24,424) of the incoming class were non-URM students. International students comprised 2.5 percent of fall 2014 new freshmen (Table 8). The proportion of URM new freshmen ranged from 7.3 percent at UW-Eau Claire and UW-Platteville to 29.6 percent at UW-Milwaukee.

AA (African American), HL (Hispanic/Latino(a)), AI (American Indian), SA (Southeast Asian), TMR-URM (Students identifying as two or more races, one of which is an underrepresented minority group), URM (Underrepresented Minority), HPI (Hawaiian/Pacific Islander), OA (Other Asian), TMR-Non-URM (Students identifying as two or more races, none of which is an underrepresented minority group), UNK (Students whose race/ethnicity is unknown), INTL (International Students).

The proportion of URM new freshmen continued to increase and was at a record high in fall 2014. Over the last decade, the proportion of URM new freshmen increased from 7.9 percent in fall 2004 to 13.5 percent in fall 2014. Among URM students, Hispanic/Latino(a) students were the largest group (1,663 or 5.7%), followed by African American students (979 or 3.4%).

Beginning in fall 2008, new freshmen were able to specify more than one race/ethnicity. Also, Hawaiian/Pacific Islander was added as a separate race/ethnicity category; prior to 2008, these students were included in the Other Asian group.

First Generation College Students

Students are identified as first generation college students if neither parent earned a four-year college/university degree. In fall 2014, 39.8 percent (11,586) of new freshmen were first generation college students (Table 10). UW Colleges (2,319), UW-Milwaukee (1,649), and UW-Madison (1,052) enrolled the largest number of first generation new freshmen. UW Colleges had the highest proportion of first generation college students (59.6%) in its new freshman class, followed by UW-Parkside (54.0%), and UW-Green Bay (53.4%). UW-Madison had the lowest proportion of first generation new freshmen (16.8%).

The UW System began to collect first generation information for new students who enrolled in fall 2009. Over the last six years, the proportion of new freshmen who were first generation college students was highest at 43.5 percent in 2010 and lowest at 39.8 percent in 2014 (Table 11). In fall 2014, first generation new freshmen comprised 44.3 percent of all Wisconsin resident new freshmen. The proportion was 23.3 percent for non-residents and 27.3 percent for Minnesota or Michigan reciprocity students.

Wisconsin Covenant Scholars

The Wisconsin Covenant was created to inspire young people to plan early for a successful high school career that will lead to higher education. In fall 2014, 4,555 resident new freshmen in the UW System were Wisconsin Covenant scholars, representing 20.4 percent of total resident new freshmen (Table 12). UW-Madison enrolled the largest number of Covenant scholars (1,770), followed by UW-La Crosse (415) and UW- Eau Claire (390). UW-Madison had the biggest proportion of Wisconsin Covenant scholars in its resident new freshmen (47.2%), followed by UW-Eau Claire (27.4%) and UW-La Crosse (25.7%).

The first cohort of Wisconsin Covenant scholars enrolled in the UW System in fall 2011. In the last four years, the proportion of Wisconsin Covenant scholars in resident new freshmen ranged from 15.2 percent in fall 2012 to 20.4 percent in fall 2014 (Table 13).

Age

UW System new freshmen age 19 and under made up the majority of new freshmen at 95.8 percent. The percentage of new freshmen age 20 and over was 4.2 percent for the UW System as a whole and ranged from 0.4 percent at UW-La Crosse to 13.0 percent at UW Colleges (Table 14).

Full-Time Status

The vast majority of UW new freshmen in fall 2014 (96.8%) were full-time students with a credit load of 12 or more credits (Table 16). UW Colleges had the highest proportion of part-time new freshmen (16.6%), followed by UW-Parkside (8.4%). UW-La Crosse had the lowest proportion of part-time new freshmen (0.1%).

The percentage of UW System full-time new freshmen remained steady over the past ten years (Table 17). The proportion of full-time new freshmen in fall 2009, 97.2 percent, was the highest in the past ten years, while the lowest proportion of this group for the past ten years was 96.5 percent in 2011.

EDUCATIONAL PREPARATION

ACT Scores

Table 18 shows the average ACT composite scores of new freshmen by UW institution from fall 2004 to fall 2014. The average ACT composite score of fall 2014 new freshmen ranged from 28.5 at UW-Madison to 20.5 at UW Colleges. Of the 1,939 (6.7%) UW System new freshmen who did not provide an ACT score, 871 (3.0%) instead provided SAT scores. 510 (1.8%) students provided both ACT and SAT scores.

The UW System new freshman average ACT composite score of 23.7 is 2.7 test points higher than the national average of 21.0. Since 2004 the average ACT composite score of UW System new freshmen has ranged from 2.0 to 2.7 test points above the national average. In fall 2014, 67.6 percent of UW System new freshmen scored above the national average.

High School Rank

In fall 2014, 42.9 percent of UW System new freshmen graduated from high school in the top 25 percent of their high school class (Table 19). About three fourths (76.1%) of new freshmen graduated in the top half of their high school class. See Appendix F for new freshman average high school percentile rank by UW institution from fall 1976 to fall 2014.

The percentage of UW System new freshmen graduating in the top 25 percent of their high school class was the lowest in fall 2014 over the last decade (Table 20). For UW institutions that collect high school rank, the proportion of new freshmen for whom a high school rank was not provided increased from 11.0 percent in fall 2004 to 30.2 percent in fall 2014; this proportion ranged from 18.6 percent at UW-Parkside to 46.8 percent at UW-Madison in fall 2014.

Class Standing

Many new freshmen enter a UW institution with Advanced Placement credits, with credits earned through the institution's placement testing process, or with college credits they earned while in high school. Some new freshmen have sufficient credits from these sources to qualify for sophomore or higher class standing. In fall 2014, the majority of UW System new freshmen (93.7%) enrolled with a class standing of freshman, while 6.3 percent entered with a sophomore or higher class standing (Table 21). UW-Madison had the largest proportion of new freshmen who entered with a sophomore or higher class standing (22.9%).

The proportion of UW System new freshmen who enrolled with a sophomore or higher class standing has been increasing since 2004 (Table 22). In fall 2004, 1.6 percent of UW System new freshmen entered with a sophomore or higher class standing while this proportion was 6.3 percent in fall 2014.

Remediation

Table 23 shows the proportion of fall 2014 new freshmen who were placed into math or English remediation. In fall 2014, 18.8 percent of UW new freshmen were placed into math remediation and 8.4 percent were placed into English remediation. UW-Oshkosh had the highest proportion of its new freshmen requiring math remediation (47.4%) while UW-Milwaukee had the highest proportion of its new freshmen requiring English remediation (24.4%).

The proportion of UW new freshmen placed into math remediation increased rapidly from 14.9 percent in 2004 to 21.6 percent in 2008 (Table 24). In the last six years, this proportion has declined every year to 18.8 percent in 2014. The proportion of UW new freshmen placed into English remediation in fall 2014 decreased 0.8 percentage points from fall 2013.
