As such, nearly all enrollments are part-time by standard definitions (i.e., under 15 credits per term). A more representative divisor for an institution reported FTE was determined by all UW institutions with Flexible Option programs. The divisor was determined to be 18, which has a rubric behind it, establishing its logic.
