Screen Entry	The number entered (7,228,006) is outside the expected range of between 1,313,714 and 2,439,752 compared to the prior year value. Please correct your data or explain. (Error #15015)	Explanation	Yes						
Reason	"When reviewing the FY20 usage data, we noticed extremely large decreases in usage compared to the IPEDS data reported for FY19, particularly for major ebook publishers, such as Elsevier, Springer, ProQuest Ebook Central, and Wiley. In investigating these discrepancies, we found that the usage data for calendar year 2018, and for many resources for calendar year 2019, erroneously included, the COUNTER 4 reports for "Successful Section Reports," in addition to or in place of the regular "Book Report" reports (BR1 and BR2) that show usage for individual ebook titles. We are not using the "Successful Section Reports" for the FY20 usage data and they should not have been used in prior years This makes an enormous difference to the numbers and has caused ebook usage totals to drop dramatically. In addition, we are still dealing with the change in metrics and what is being counted between COUNTER 4 and COUNTER 5, which is affecting the totals (some vendors still have not switched to COUNTER 5)."
