#### Academic Libraries Overview

Reason	The significant reduction in reported expenditures, in comparison to 2021 ACRL/IPEDS report, is under assessment. There was a change in the 'financial data steward', it is believed that the difference is attributed to the scope of data retrieved from the financial database, contrary to the instructions (e.g. inclusions and exclusions).
