The large discrepancy from FY2022 to FY2023 was due to an inaccurate count from last year (FY2022). In FY2022 we double-counted our Rapid ILL transactions in the overall numbers. FY2022 number should be 1,828. So FY2023's number should only show a slight decline from FY2022.
