Overview

Fall Enrollment Overview

The Fall Enrollment component collects student enrollment counts by level of student, enrollment status, gender and race/ethnicity. In addition, first-time students' fall-tofall retention rates and the student-to-faculty ratio are collected. Enrollment by age is required in odd-numbered years, and enrollment by residence of first-time undergraduates is required in even-numbered years.

 gender (Men/Women) categories provided. Institutions should still allocate those students to the Men/Women categories in other screens of the survey

- References to summer term were changed to summer session.
- FAQ #8 on consistent reporting of EF, E12, and OM has been updated for clarification.
