MULTIPLE APPLICATIONS AND ADMISSIONS DATA (MAAD)

Overview


Multiple Applications and Admissions Data (MAAD) includes data that identify and describe students who have applied for undergraduate enrollment at one of the University of Wisconsin System institutions. It records data, on a monthly basis, about the applicants and the admission action taken on each application.

The monthly MAAD submissions are cumulative from the time an application for the reporting year/term is initially recorded until the final MAAD submission of the cycle. Thus, records of applicants who withdraw or cancel their application remain on each MAAD submission for the cycle. The monthly MAAD submissions should include records for all new, transfer, and re-entry degree-seeking undergraduate applicants who are applying for the upcoming summer or fall terms. The cycle culminates with the "end of cycle" submission in September. In addition, there is a single "end of cycle" March submission for spring and winter term applicants.

Each MAAD record identifies and describes a unique student application. Uniqueness is established by a combination of data elements: Student Social Security Number, Unit (and Division for UW Colleges Receiving Institutions), Desired Term of Enrollment, and the reporting Month. These elements comprise the entity key.

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MAAD data can be grouped into four types as illustrated in the diagram on the following page. Many of the MAAD elements are the same or similar to those collected in the CDR Student Data area. Type I (Personal) descriptors provide basic identifying and demographic information about the applicant. The Type II (Pre-University) descriptors contain information about the educational institution previously attended by the student and information related to the student's application and admission status. Type III (University) descriptors include student information specific to the desired UW campus and term of enrollment. Type IV (Other) provides information on late applications that were received after admissions were closed and for which individual applicant records were not submitted.
