

Total Headcount Enrollment











Race/Ethnic Make-up of UW System Enrollment








Second Year Retention Rates New Freshmen Entering Full-Time in Fall





Closing Equity Gaps URM / Non-URM Retention to the Second Year








Six-Year Graduation Rates for UW Full-Time New Freshmen













Race/Ethnic Make-up of UW System Baccalaureate Degree Recipients

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

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










Degrees Conferred in STEM and Health Fields
