
University of Wisconsin Course Management System Study

- Funded by Educause








Pedagogical Reasons for Using a Course Management System



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
Effect of the Use of Course Management Systems on the Time Students Spend Engaged with Course Materials.



■ Yes, Students Spend More Time ■ No, Students Spend less Time □ No difference

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
Effect of the Use of a Course Management Systemon Contact Between the Instructor and Students

Had No Effect


Capability of Course Management System to Enable Faculty to Include More Interactivity in Their Classes



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
■ Yes, More Interactivity ■ No, Less Interactivity ■ No difference

Faculty Confidence in the Capacity of the Course Management System to Accommodate Diverse Learning Styles






Changes in Faculty Levels of Use Since Starting to Use a Course Management System
