Wisconsin Partnership Program Collaborations



\$1,410,488

Community-Academic Partnership Fund

- 7 grants to community health organizations
- \$25,000-\$450,000 per grant
- Address public health needs and eliminate health disparities
- Representative Projects:
 - Improving birth outcomes in minority populations
 - Providing social support and case management for women at risk for partner violence
 - Promoting healthy and safe neighborhoods

City of Milwaukee Health Department


- Promote the Milwaukee Health Department as a flagship education and training site

 - MPH Student Field Placements
- Address critical public health issues
 - Serving the needs of African Americans with cancer

- Coordinate training and education and create public health workforce pipeline






- Survey of the Health of Wisconsin (SHOW), long-range study of the health status of Wisconsin residents
- Wisconsin Health Research Network (WiNHR), research network of statewide healthcare organizations
- Focus on health disparities, health status, access to care, and health promotion in underserved populations



- Salary support for new UW-Milwaukee faculty and staff affiliated with the Center for Urban Population Health
- Establish the Regional Partnership Network with UW-Milwaukee and CUPH to reduce disparities in cancer care



- Special initiative to address the health of Milwaukee public school children and to remove health related barriers to learning
- Collaborative effort of the Center for Urban Population Health, UW-Milwaukee, and Milwaukee Public Schools



- The Healthy Wisconsin Leadership Institute, a statewide public health leadership training program
- Jointly supported by the UW School of Medicine and Public Health and the Medical College of Wisconsin
- Created five community teams; one in Milwaukee to reduce risky sexual behavior among adolescents





United Community Center

- Comprehensive human service organization serving Hispanics in Milwaukee
- Support the development of clinical and research programs for Hispanics with Alzheimer's Disease
- Educate physicians on treatment and diagnosis of Alzheimer's Disease in the Hispanic population



 Support for feasibility study to explore the creation of a school of public health at UW-Milwaukee



- Essential element of the School's commitment to clinical learning experiences with urban underserved patients
- Guided by the recently implemented affiliation agreement between the University and Aurora reaffirming the commitment

\$380,000 annually Center for Urban Population Health

- A partnership with Aurora Health Care, UW-Milwaukee, and the UW School of Medicine and Public Health
- Focus on improving the health of urban communities through health services research, education and training, and health promotion

\$2,000,000 annually

UW Center for Tobacco Research and Intervention

- Established an active outreach and research presence at Aurora Sinai for underserved populations
- Expanded smoking cessation services to other Milwaukee clinics serving minority communities
- Collaborated with a network of minority populations on tobacco control programs



- Support clinical and population health research infrastructure at Aurora Sinai
- Critical component of the School's application for a NIH Clinical and Translational Science Award
