Seven Goals of Plan 2008


- Goal #1 Increase the number of Wisconsin HS graduates of color who enroll.



Wisconsin Population of Color






Percent ACT-Tested



UW System M/D Precollege Enrollments









Students of Color as a Percent of All Students







Numbers of Students of Color by UW Institution





Second Year Retention Rates





Six-Year Graduation Rates







Undergraduates with Financial Need by Race/Ethnicity




Average Loan Debt by Race/Ethnicity






Employees of Color by Race/Ethnicity
