

Four Phases of IE Planning



Four Phases: Developing IE Strategic Plans – Year 1

Phase I: Laying the Foundation

- Create Core IE Campus Leadership Teams
- Identify data, inquiry process and analytic tools
- Establish a culture of evidence
- Create institutional awareness, cultivate buy-in

Phase II: Develop Plans & Strategies

- Define overall scope for the 1st 3 years
- Define IE goals and objectives
- Develop capacity building programs
- Define clear lines of authority

Four Phases: Developing IE Strategic Plans, Year 2 & 3

Phase III: Implementation

Common Elements for Each Plan:

- Rationale for diversity, equity and inclusion
- Indicators of Success
- Campus Climate
- Marketing & Communications
- Rewards

Phase IV: Evaluation & Assessment

Recurring, Continuous Evaluation & Assessment

- Evaluate, measure and monitor
- Realign procedures if lack of progress
- Implement new strategies
- Identify success and areas where more work is needed
