







Percentage Growth in Mean Family Income by Quintile











Distribution of Total Undergraduate Debt by Sector and Type of Degree or Certificate, 2007-08




Median Earnings of Full-Time Year-Round Workers Ages 25–34, by Gender and Education Level, 1971–2008 (in Constant 2008 Dollars)
