

UW-Rock County Master Planning Process (cont'd)

Purpose of the Master Plan update:

- 1. Reflect large enrollment increases and campus strategic plan outcomes
- 2. Develop a series of options to address building capacity and infrastructure issues
- 3. Prepare project cost estimates for each option
