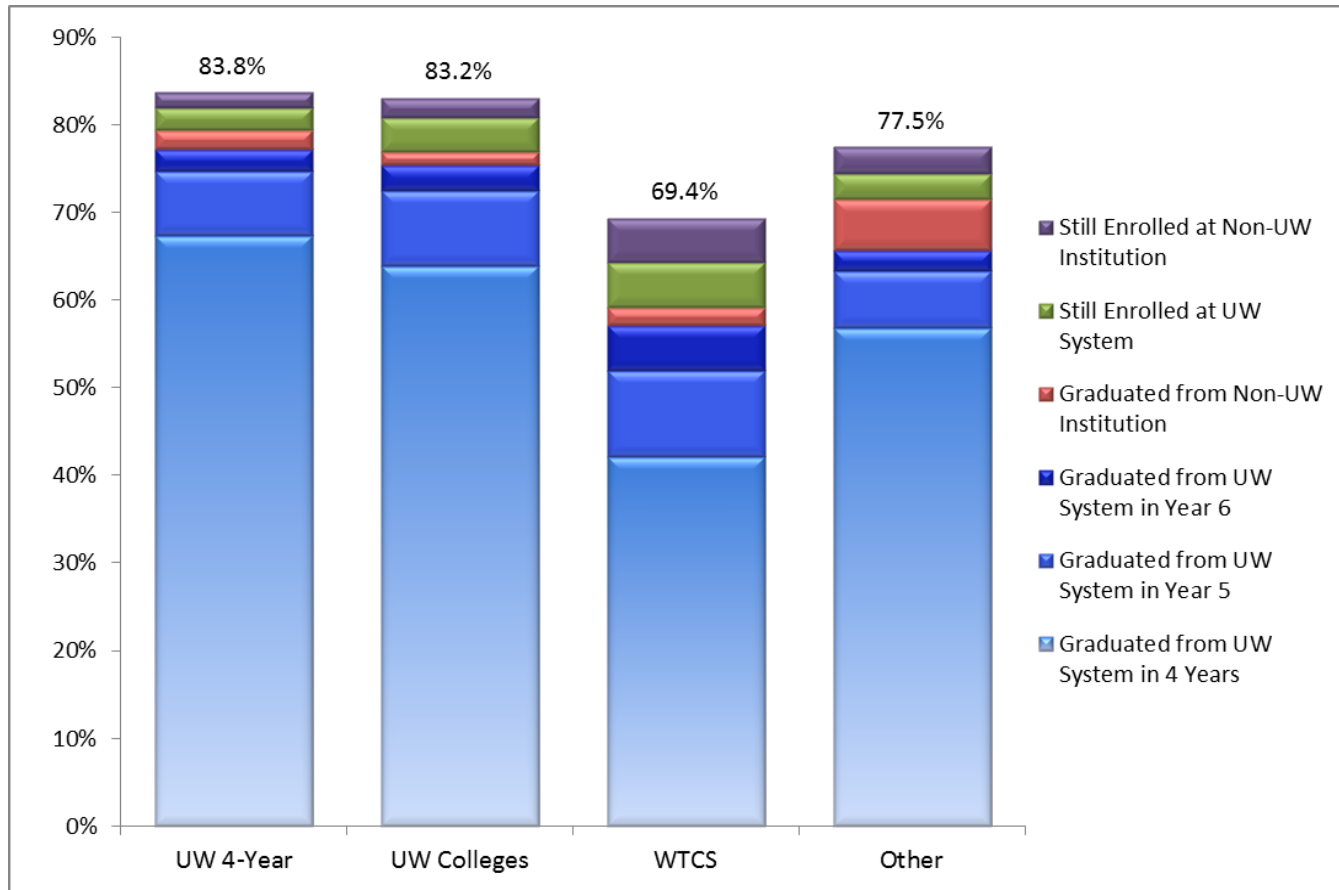

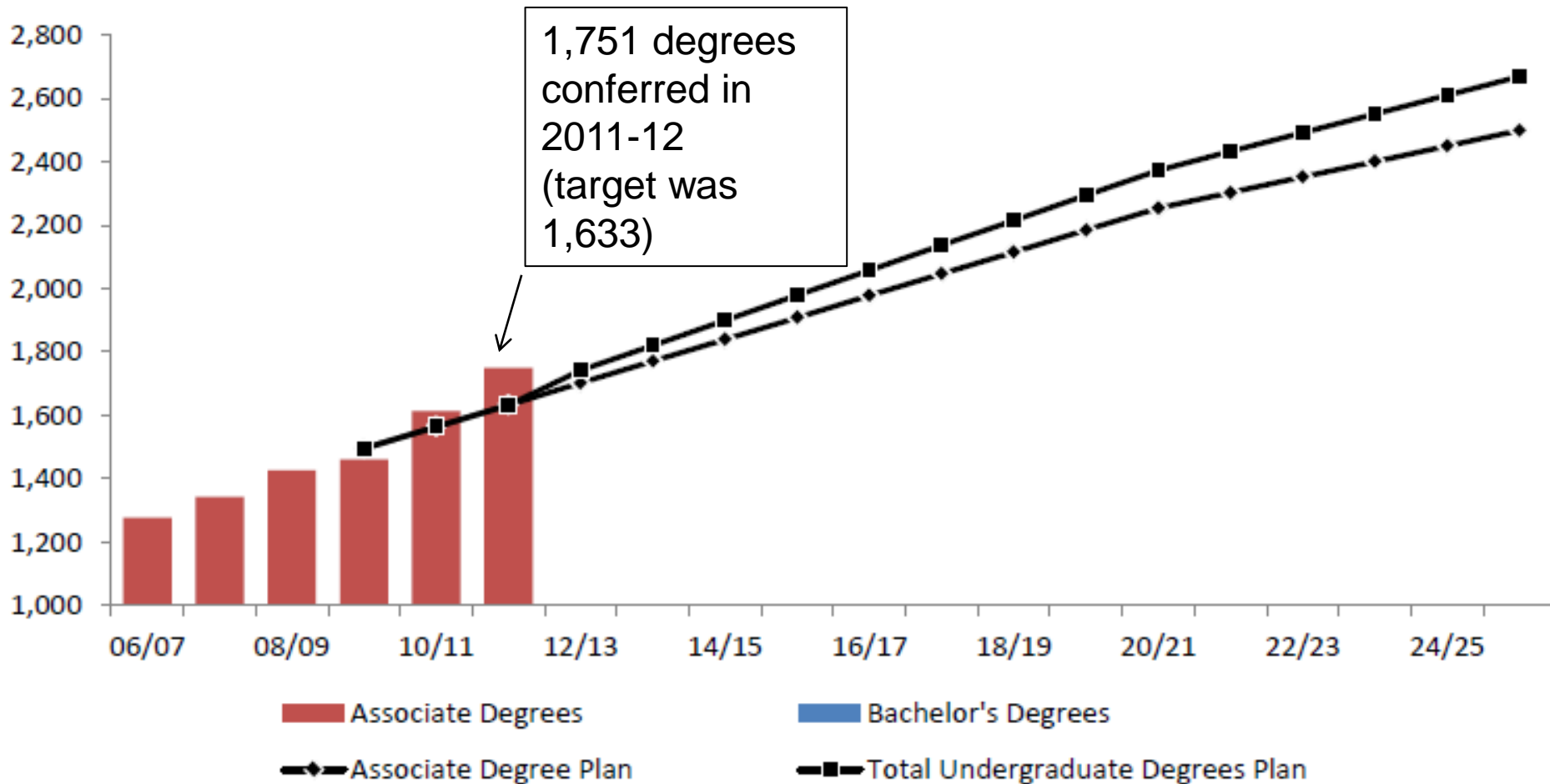

Transfer Student Success and Progress Rates by Transfer Source (2006)

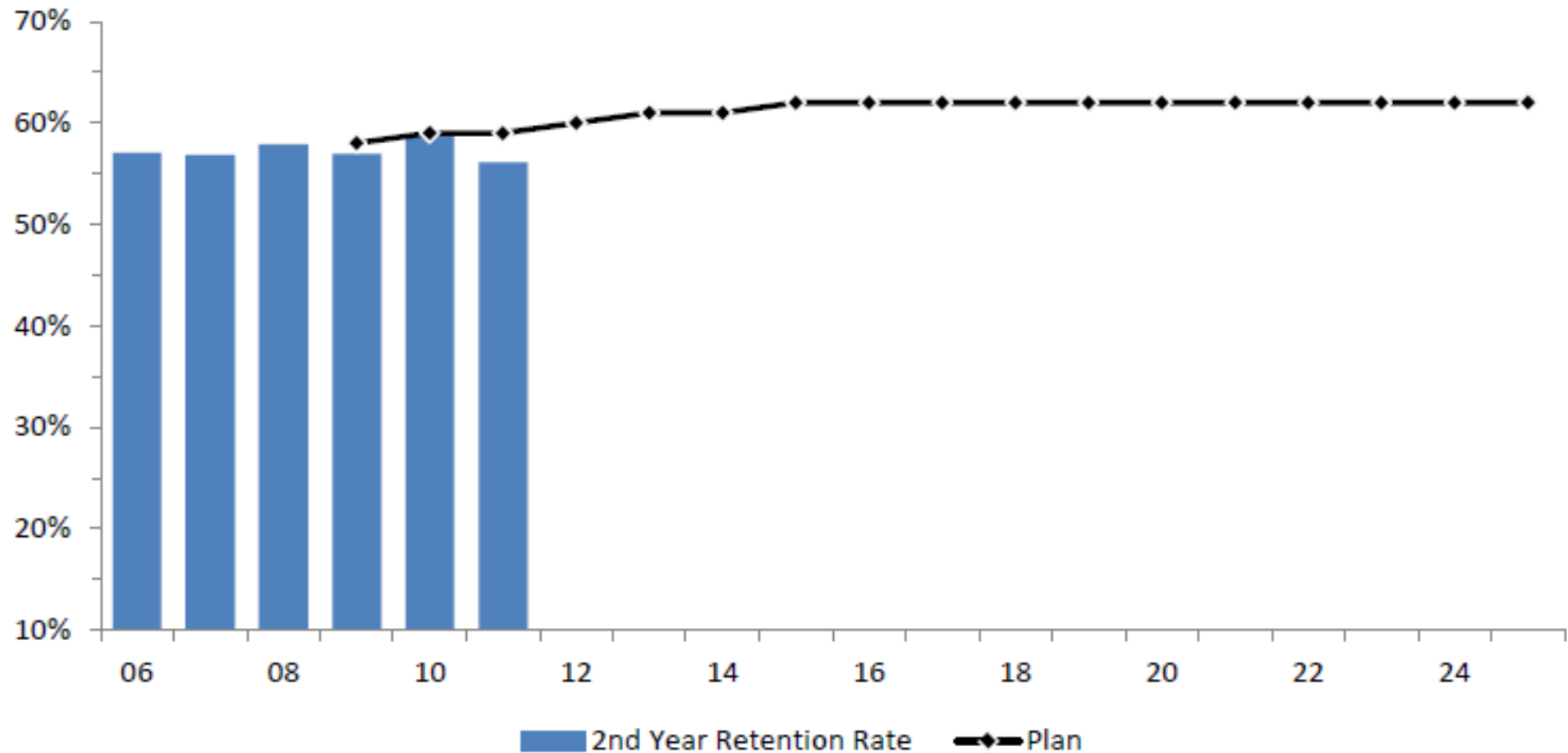

Undergraduate Degrees Conferred vs. Plan

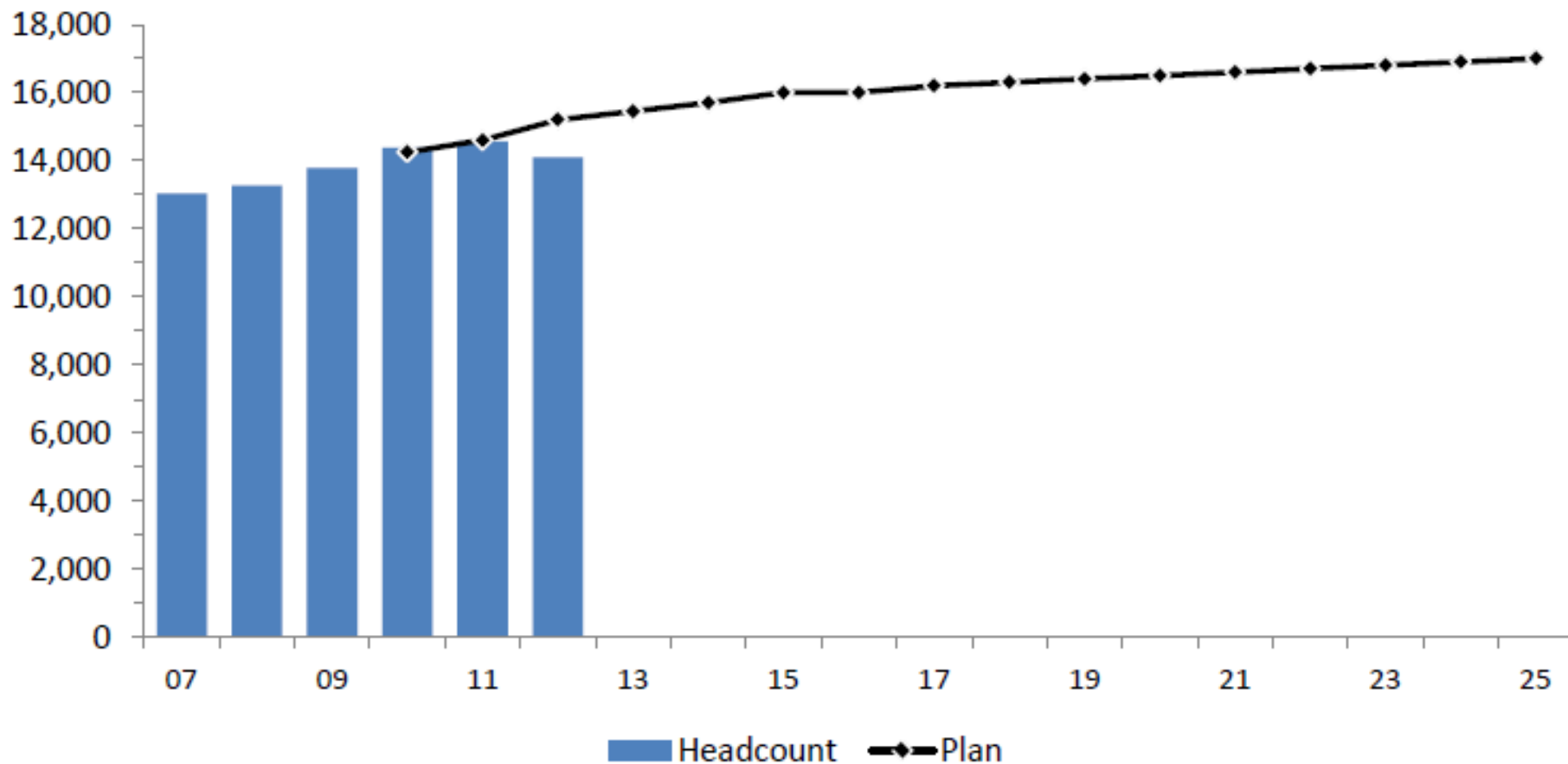


UW Colleges Second Year Retention Rates vs. Plan (New Freshmen Entering Fulltime in Fall)



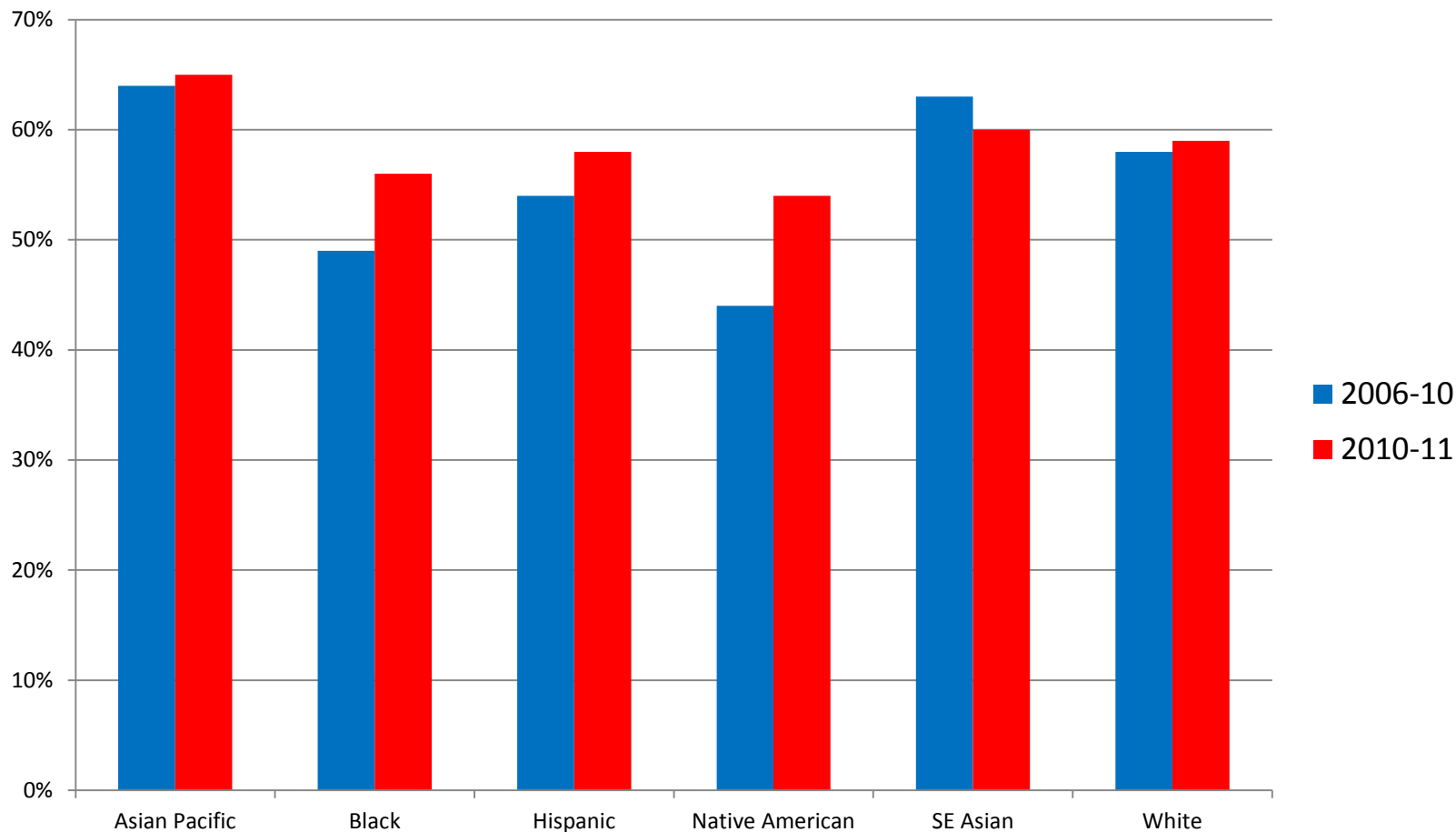

New Freshmen Retention by Race/Ethnicity

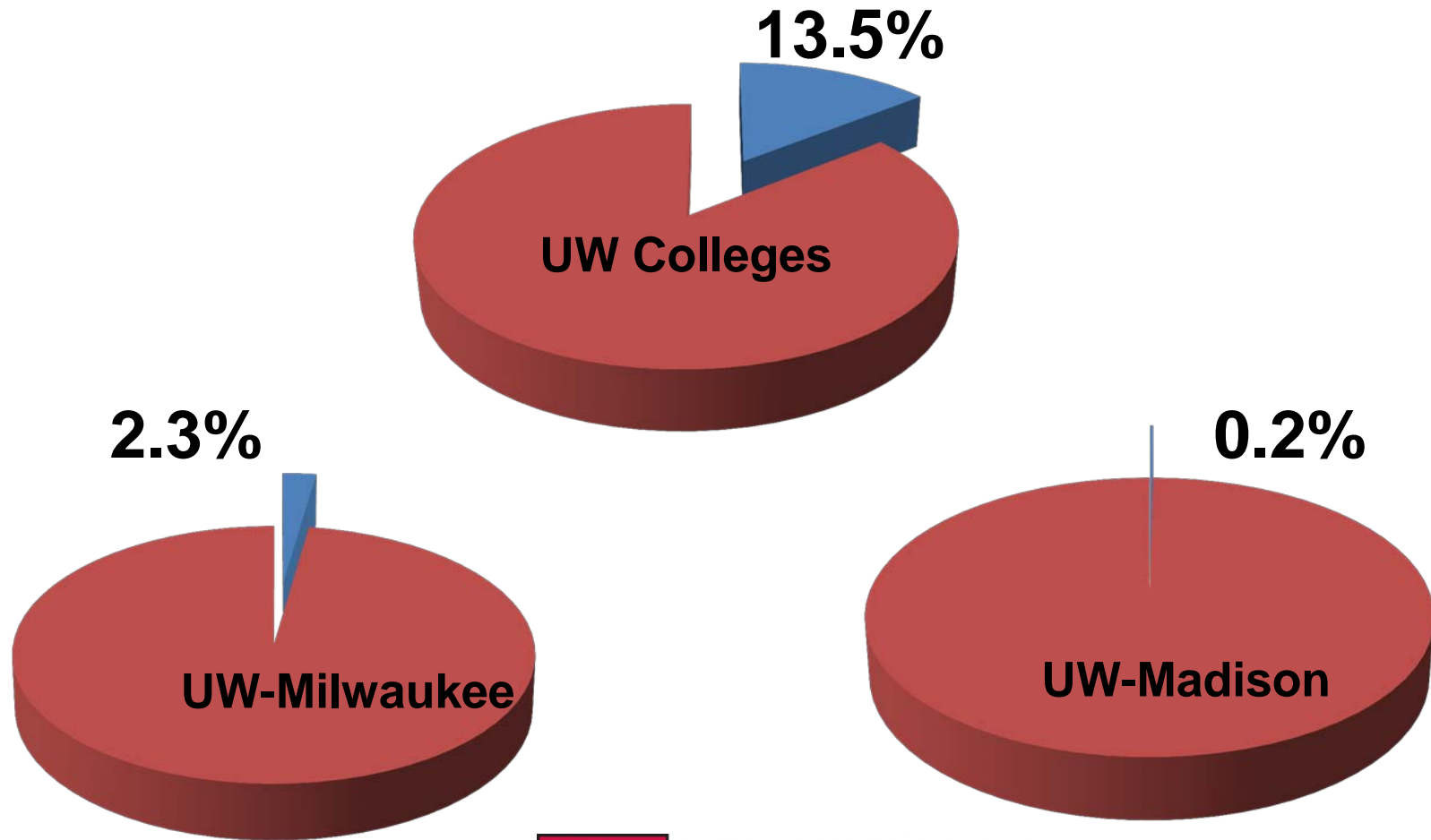

Threats or Challenges

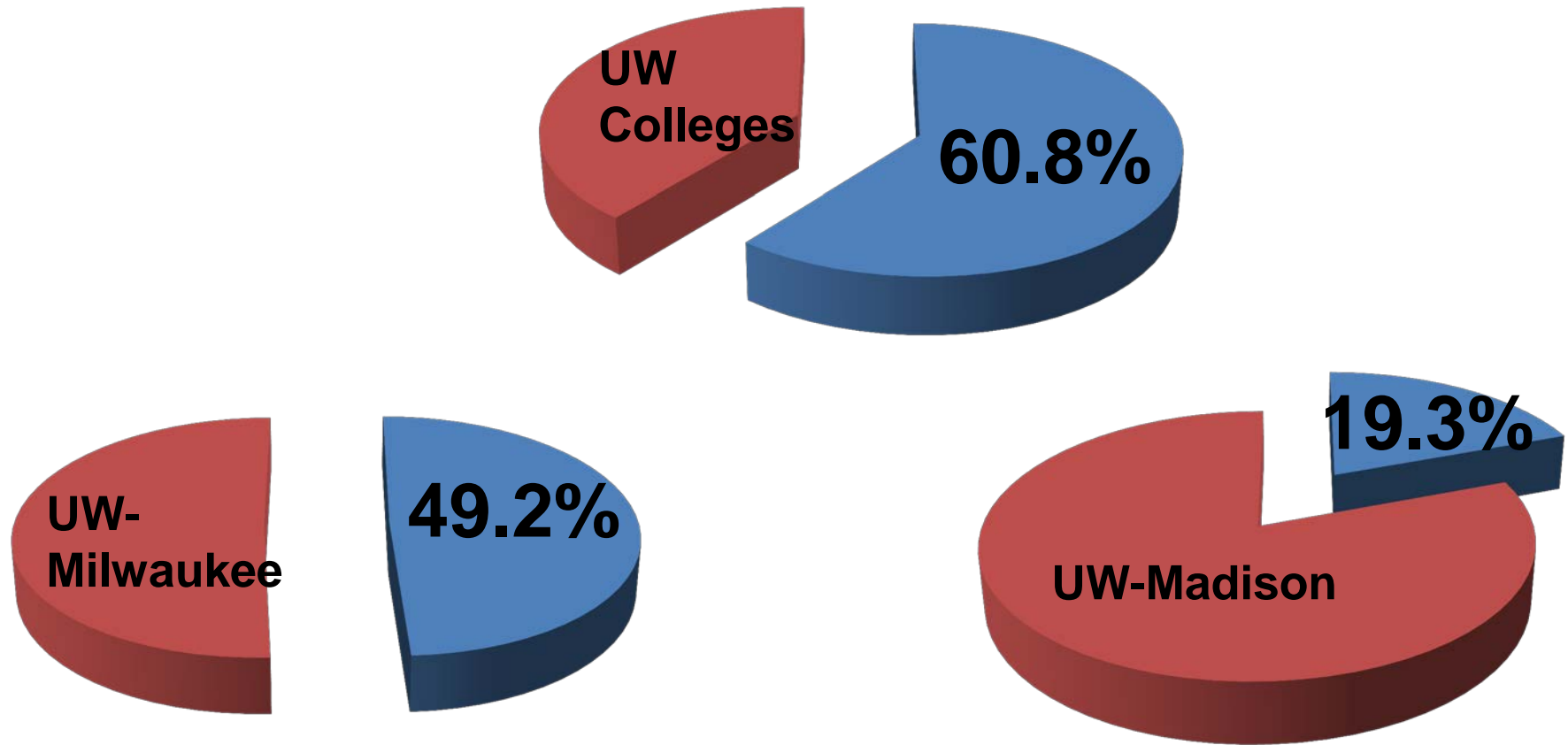
- Increasing student costs
