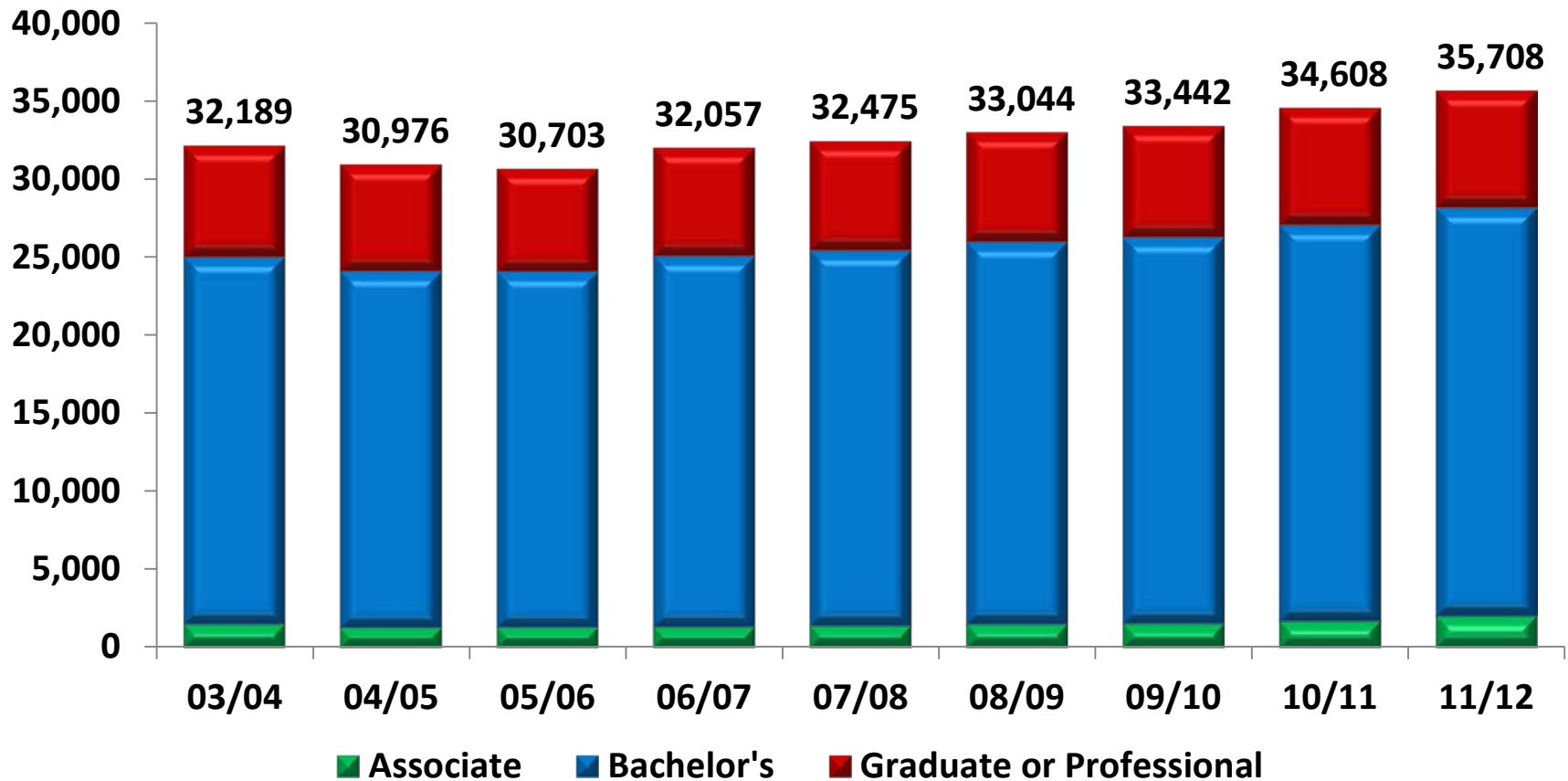

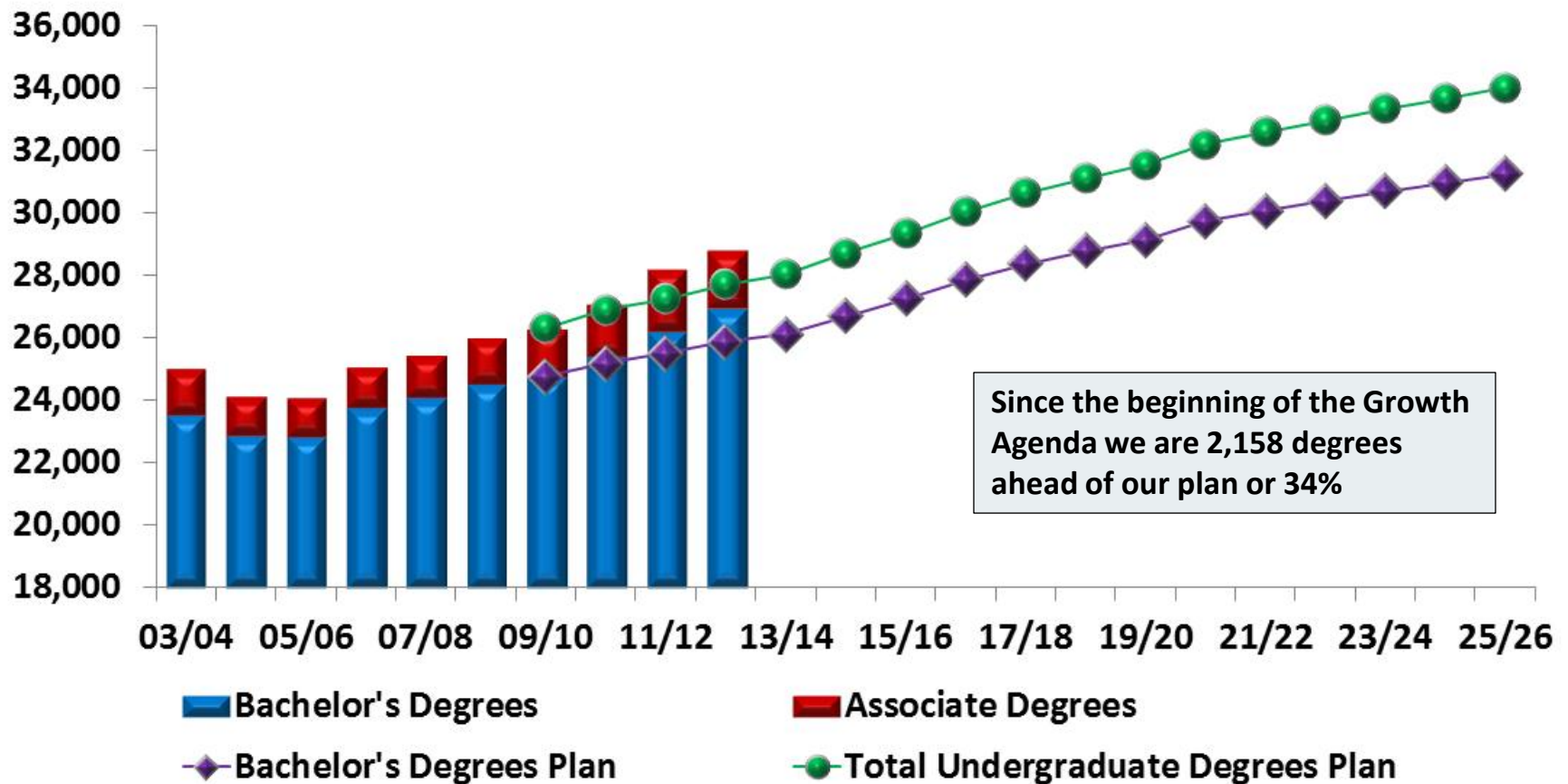

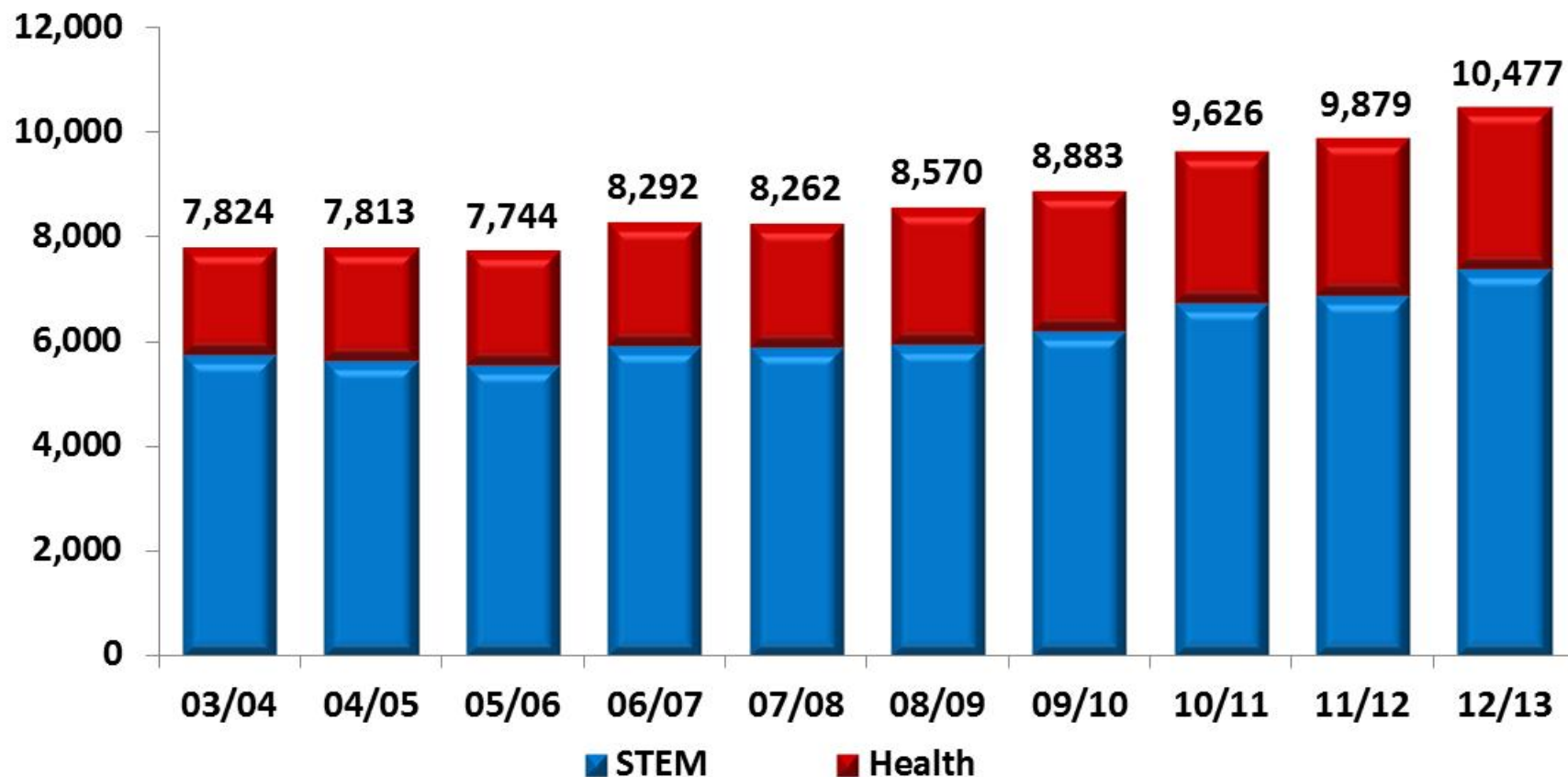
Undergraduate Degrees Conferred vs. Plan

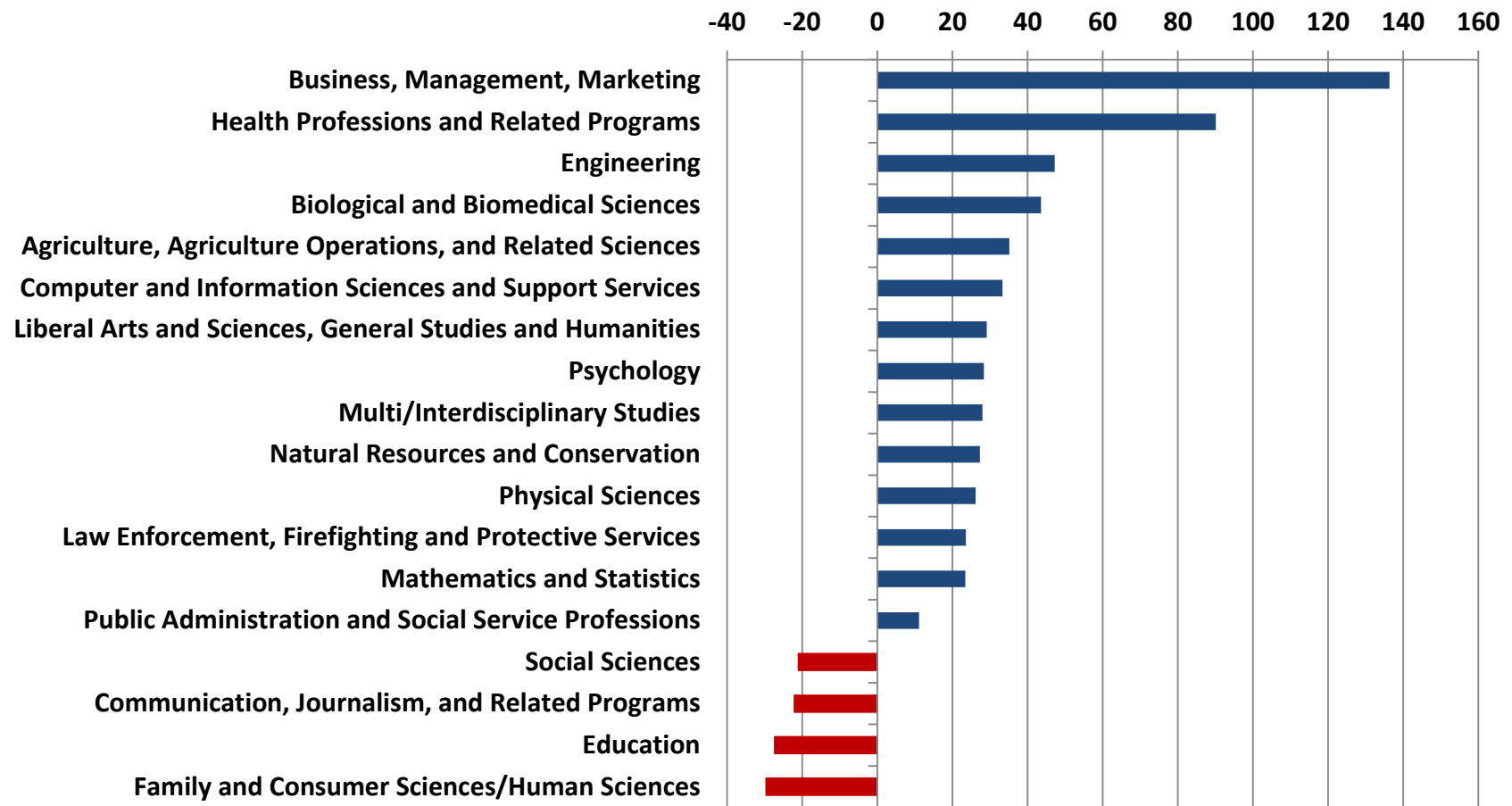
Degrees Conferred in STEM and Health Fields

Average Annual Change in Number of Baccalaureate Degrees Conferred per Year

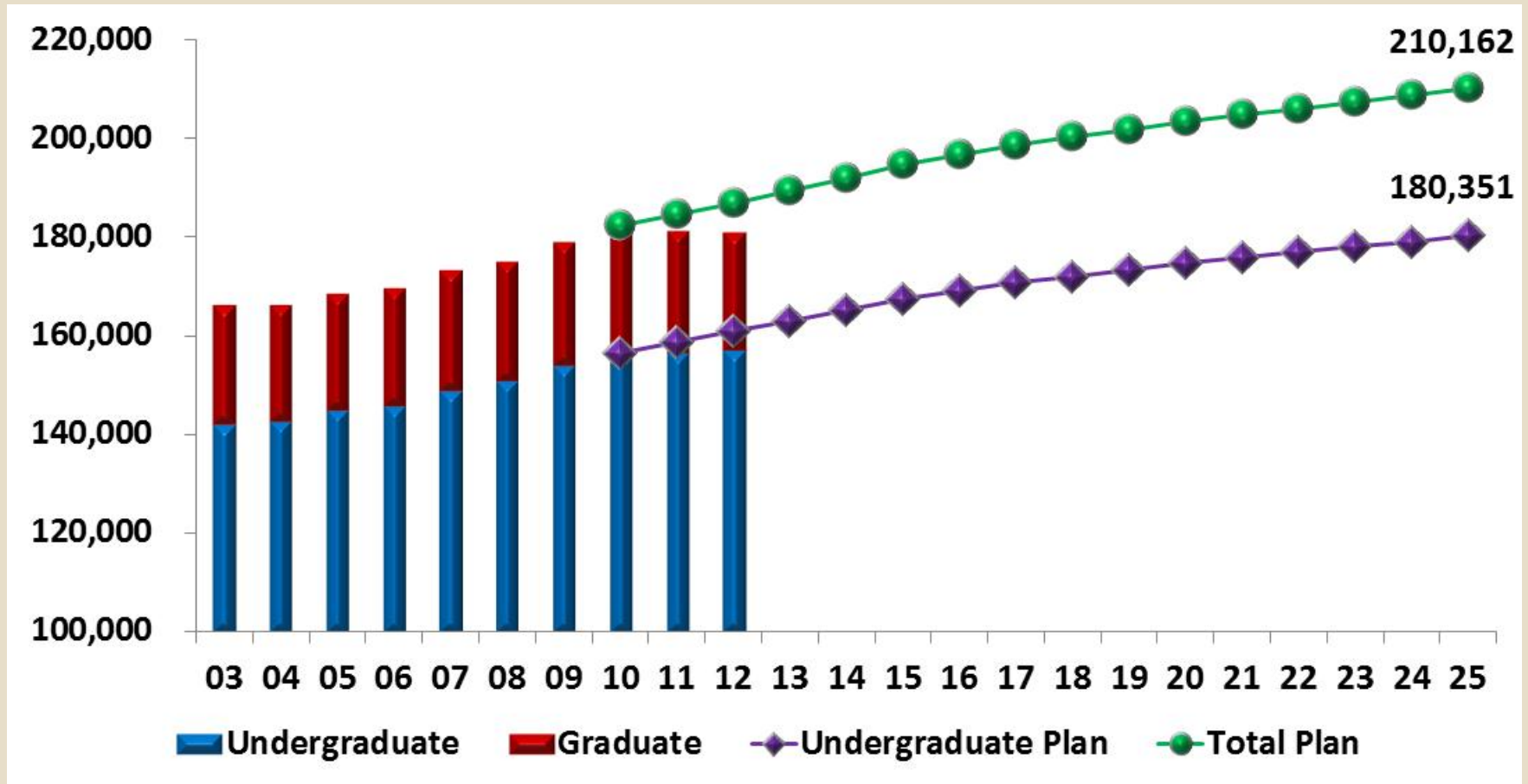

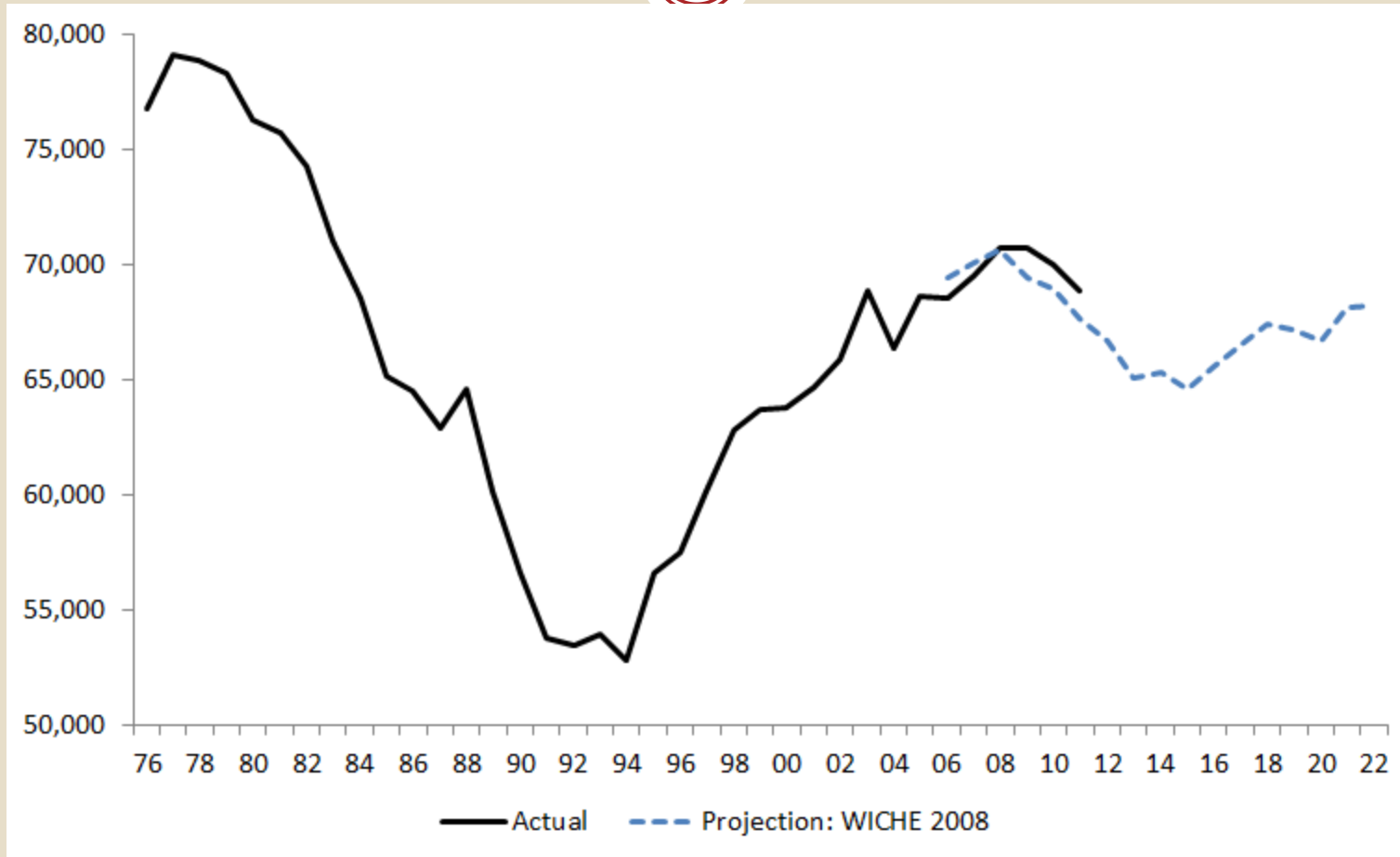
Total Headcount Enrollment vs. Plan Fall 2003 to Fall 2025

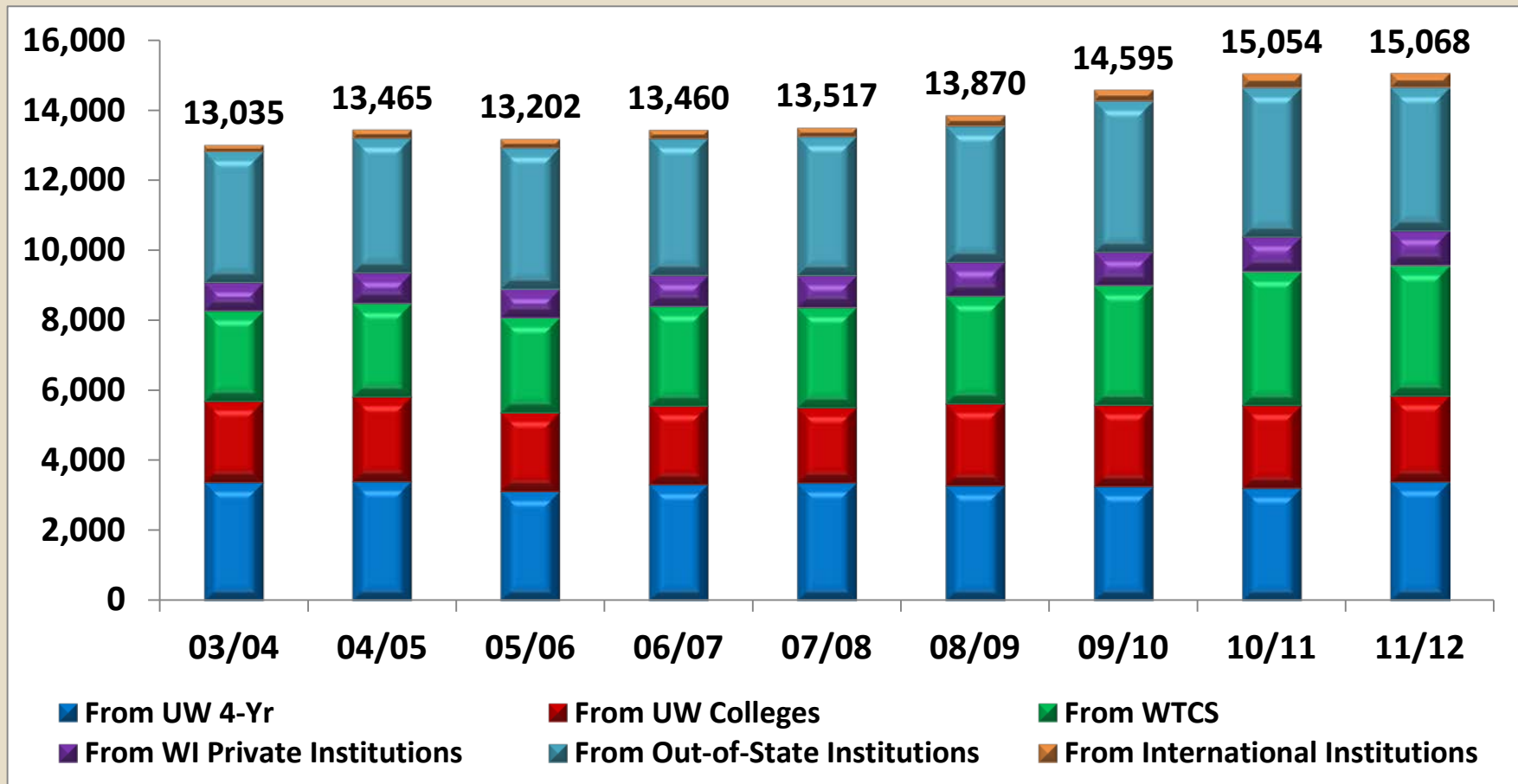
Wisconsin High School Graduates Projection 2022

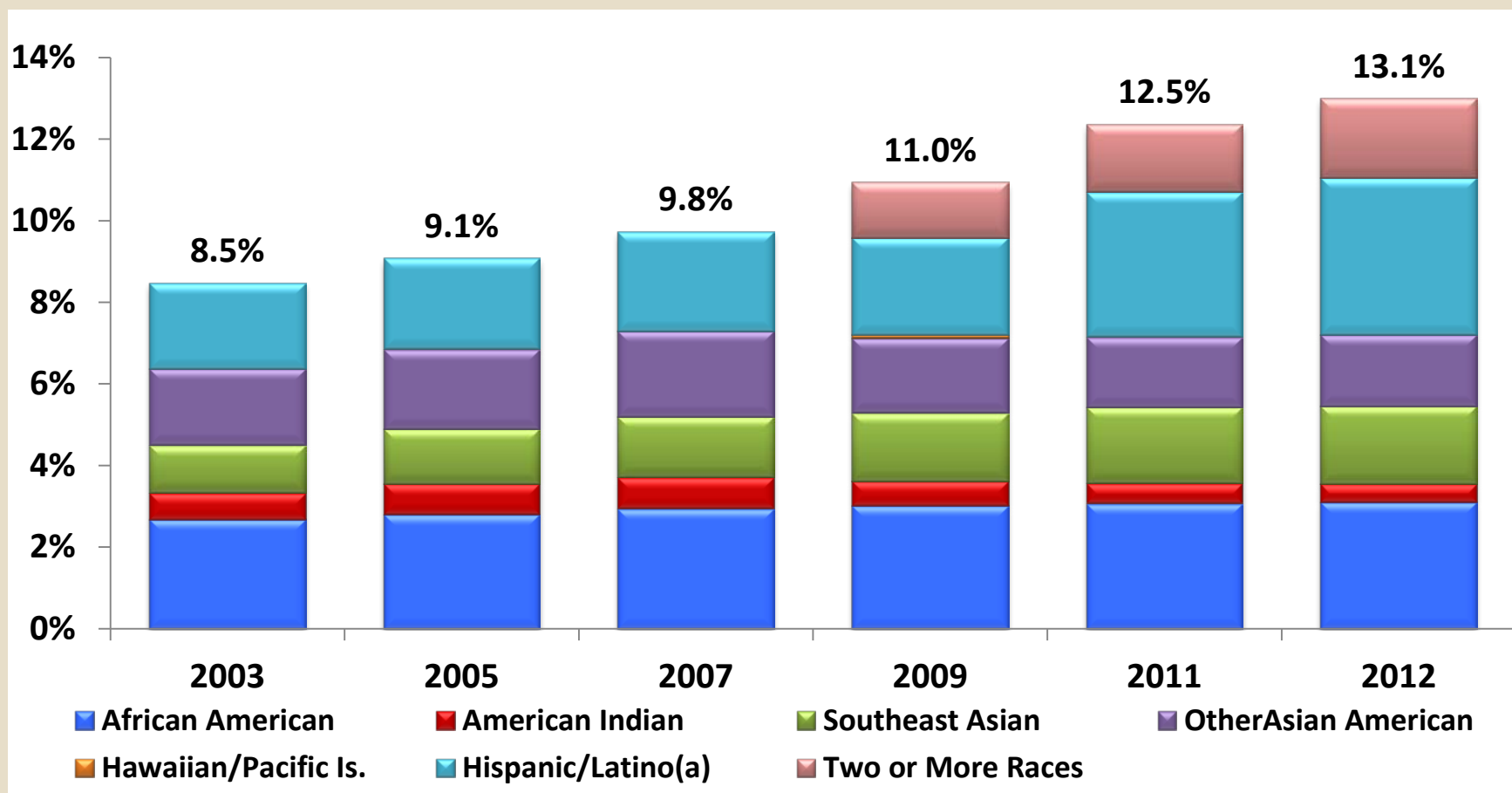

Race/Ethnic Make-up of UW System Enrollment

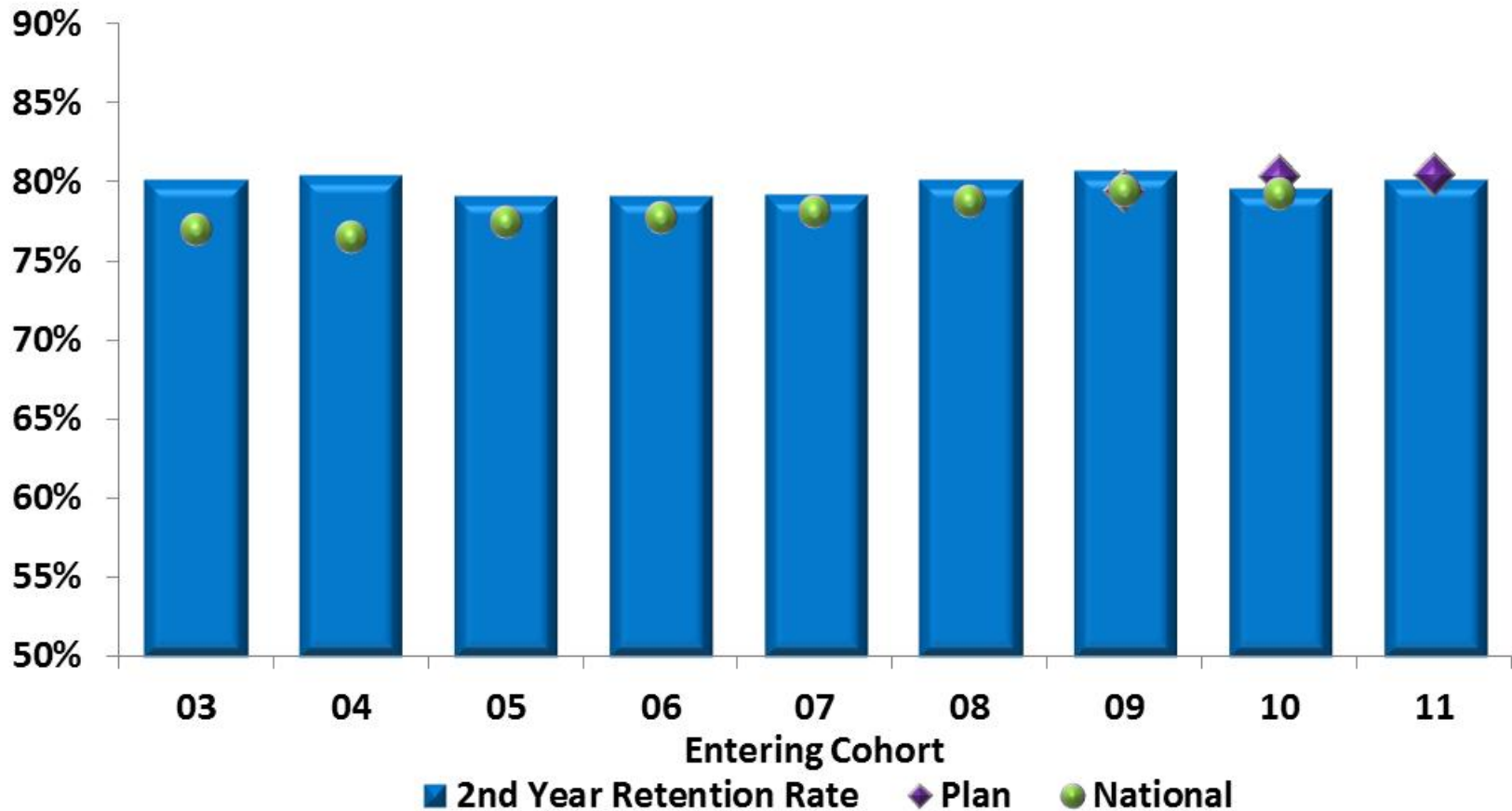

Second Year Retention Rates

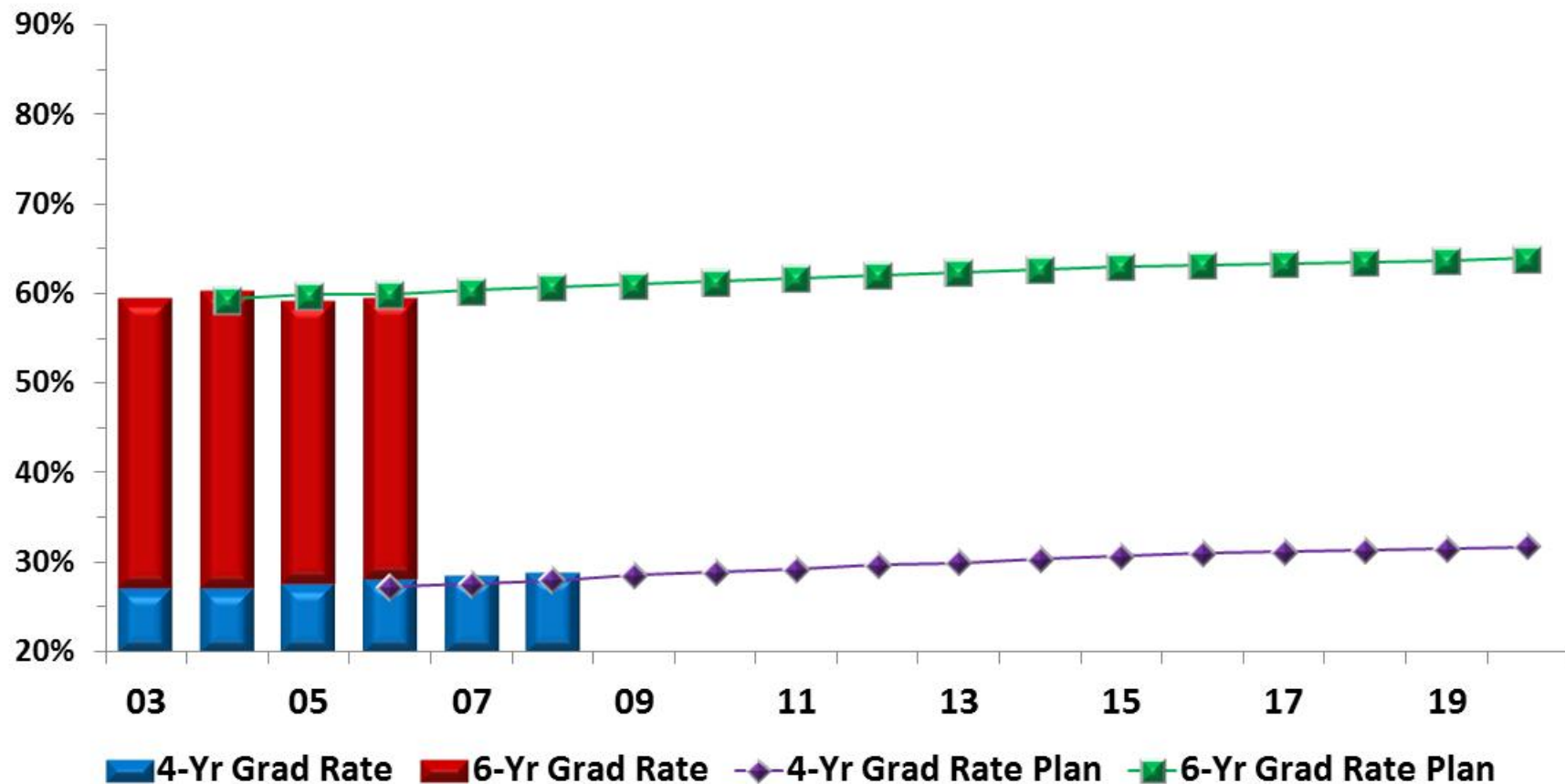
New Freshmen Entering Full-Time in Fall

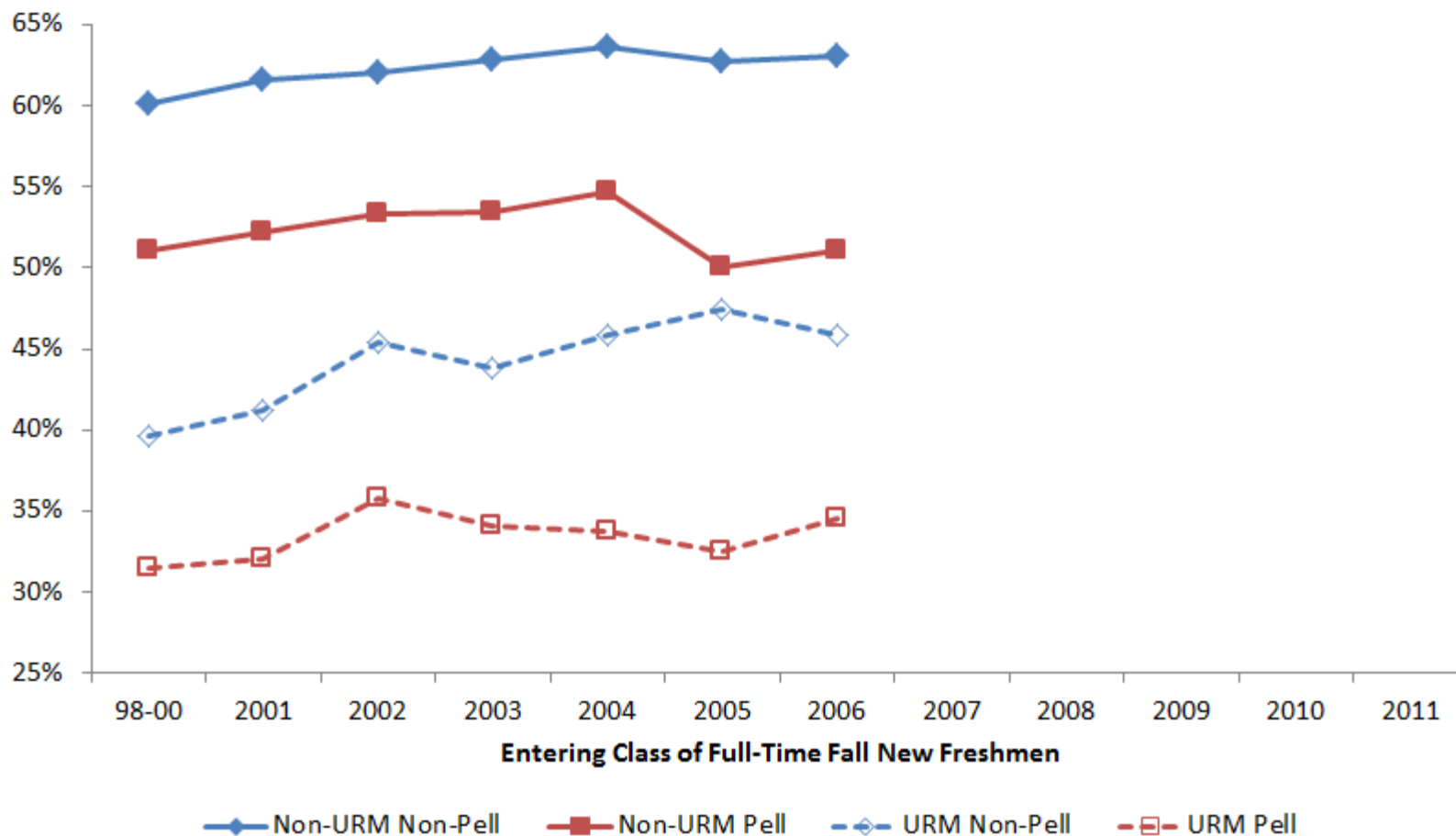

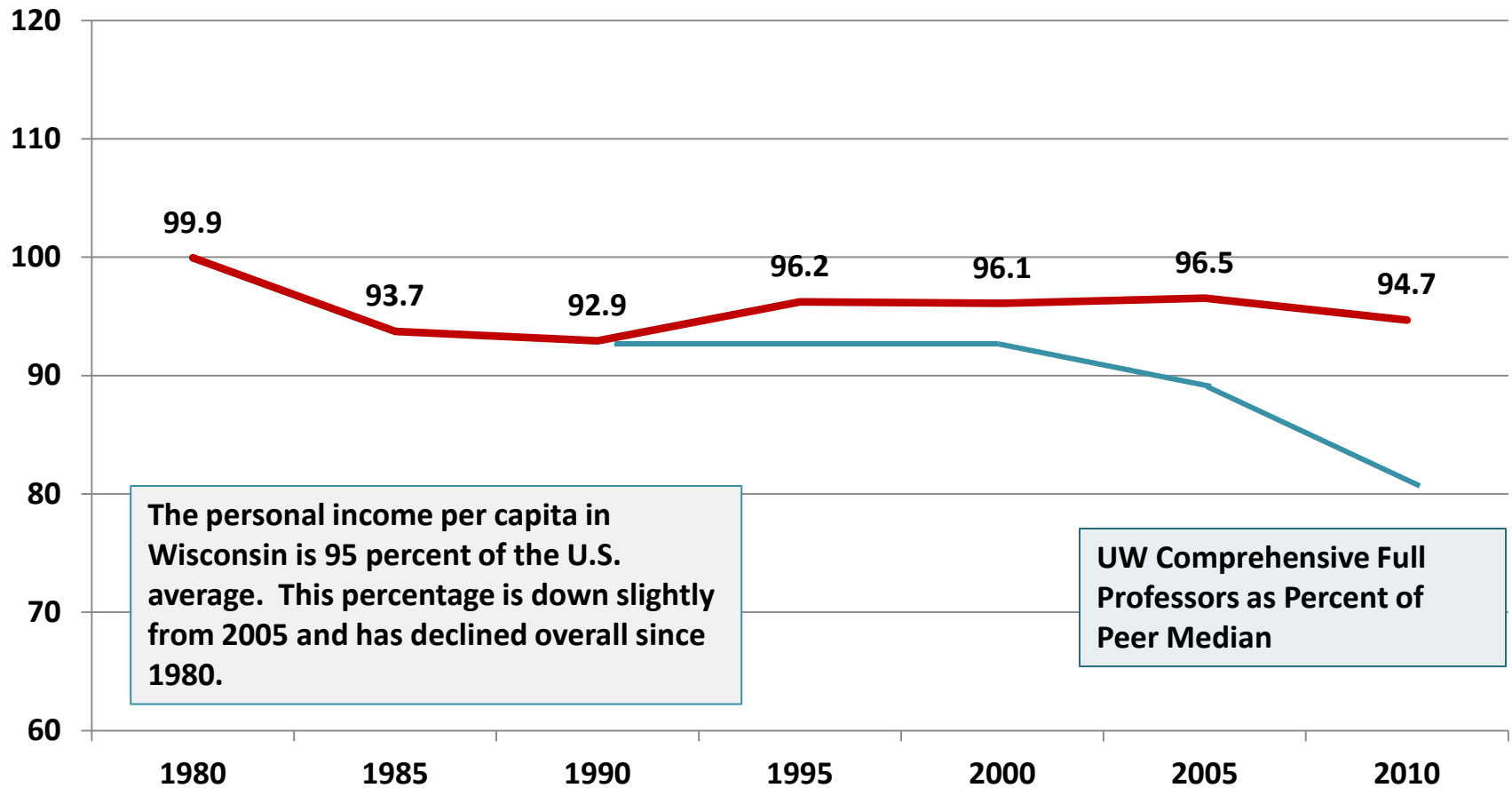
Freshman Six-Year Graduation Rates at Same UW

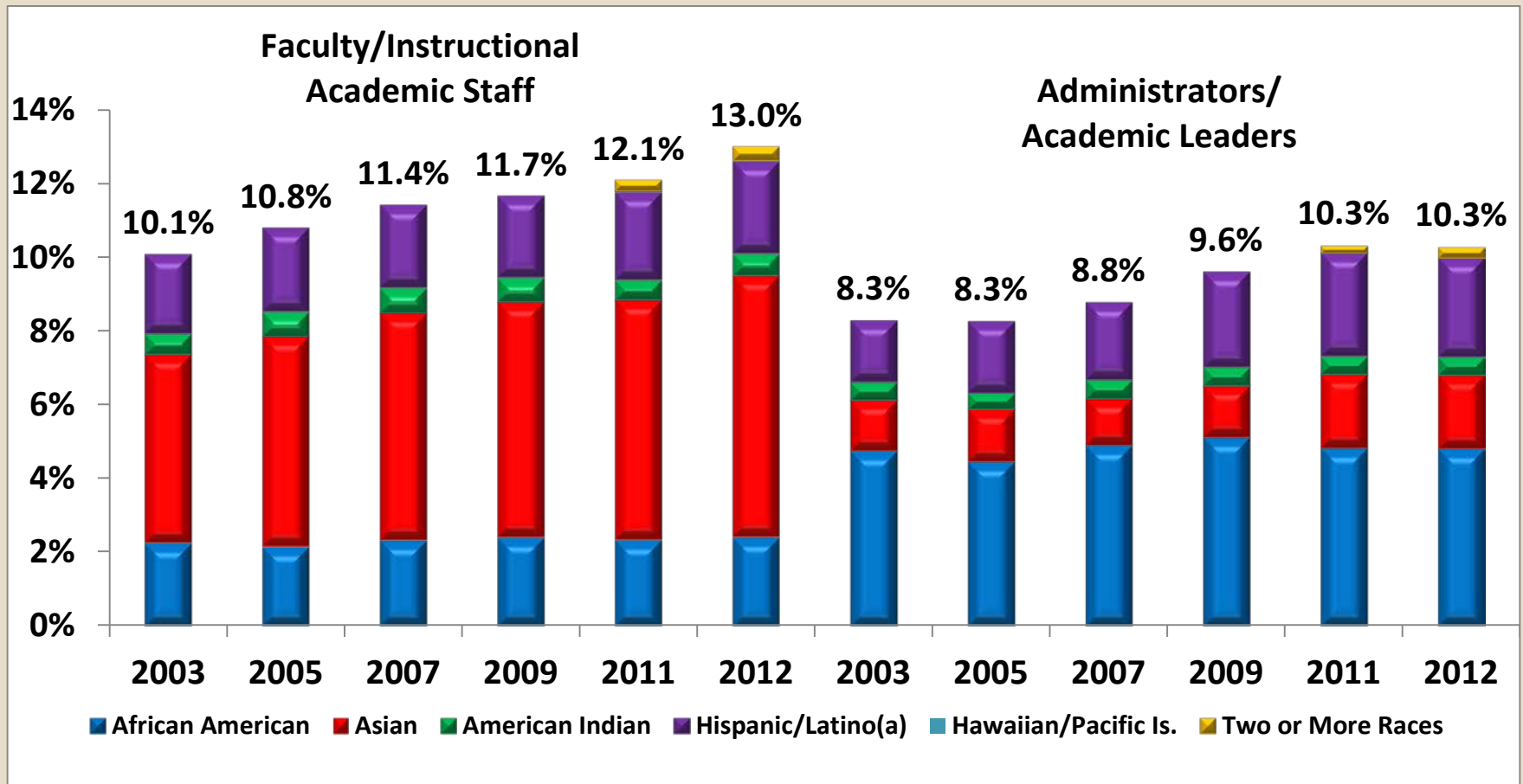
The personal income per capita in Wisconsin is 95 percent of the U.S. average. This percentage is down slightly from 2005 and has declined overall since 1980.

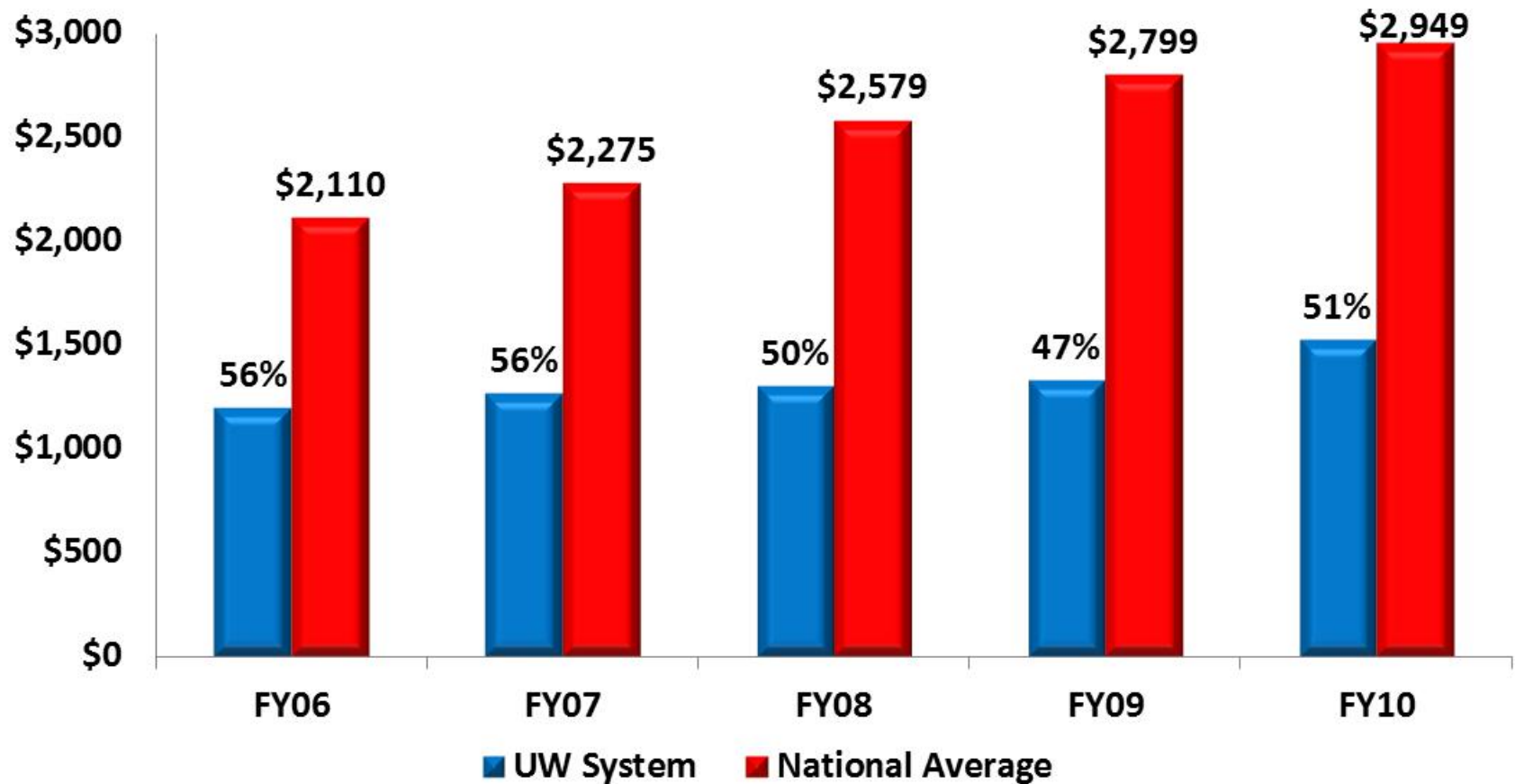
