



#### Undergraduate Degrees Conferred vs. Plan









### **Degrees Conferred in STEM and Health Fields**









# Average Annual Change in Number of Baccalaureate Degrees Conferred per Year








## Total Headcount Enrollment vs. Plan Fall 2003 to Fall 2025






## Wisconsin High School Graduates Projection 2022









#### Race/Ethnic Make-up of UW System Enrollment








# Second Year Retention Rates New Freshmen Entering Full-Time in Fall




# Freshman Six-Year Graduation Rates at Same UW








# Wisconsin Personal Income per Capita as a Percent of the U.S. Average




