

There is an upcoming change to the bidder registration process you need to be aware of and take proactive action.

As an agency of the State of Wisconsin, the UW Madison uses the Vendornet system to alert registered vendors of certain Requests for Bid (RFB) solicitations, Requests for Proposals (RFP) solicitations, contract renewals, or new contract opportunities. There are changes coming to this system in the fall of 2017. If you are actively engaged in transacting business with any UW System campus or state agency, you will need to take proactive action in order to continue to receive notifications of newly posted procurement solicitations or notices.

If you are currently, registered on Vendornet you should have received a message from the State of Wisconsin Bureau of Procurement (SBOP) describing an upcoming change to the Vendornet system, and requesting that you take proactive action so you can continue to receive the applicable alerts for which you have registered. The requested action in the letter is that you log onto the Vendornet tool to update your company profile, contact information, and to review or update your NIGP code selections associated with the goods or services you provide for which you'd like to receive new solicitation notifications. If you do not log in and take action, SBOP will assume that your profile is no longer active and they will not migrate your profile to their new platform, which will effectively end any bid alerts you are currently receiving.
