III. REPORT OF ACTION TAKEN (MEMOS OF AGREEMENT):

A. A Contributor Agreement with G. Heileman Brewing Company, Inc. for the 1992 Crazylegs Five Mile Fun Run was signed between G. Heileman Brewing Company, Inc. and the University of Wisconsin-Madison. It provides for cash and in-kind contributions for the 1992 Crazylegs Five Mile Fun Run. This agreement is in the same format as that used for contributions to the annual event in previous years.

B. Lee E. Grugel, Chancellor, University of Wisconsin Centers, has reported that, on April 21, 1992, the Barron County Board named the UW Center Barron County Administration Building in memory of John F. Meggers, who passed away in August 1991. Dr. Meggers served as the campus' first Dean from 1966 until his retirement in 1988. A native of the Sheboygan area, he also served as Acting Chancellor of the UW Centers during the 1973-74 academic year. His wife, Donna, continues to reside in the Rice Lake area and his two daughters have remained in the Midwest. In forwarding this request that the information be shared with the Board, Chancellor Grugel said: "We would like the Regents, and John's many friends in the UW System, to know of the honor which the community of Rice Lake has bestowed on their former colleague."

IV. AGREEMENTS OVER \$200,000:

A. An affiliation agreement between the University of Wisconsin-Madison and the Psychiatric Company of Dane County, Inc. (Parkway Hospital) is being finalized.

Under the terms of this agreement, psychiatric faculty, fellows, and residents will provide certain clinical and administrative services at Parkway Hospital in Madison. In turn, the UW Medical School and its Department of Psychiatry will receive additional office and laboratory space, laboratory facilities, equipment and supplies, additional patient population, and financial support of medical education and research.

Parkway Hospital will:

- provide approximately 2,600 net square feet of laboratory and office space and will assume construction and improvement costs up to \$100,000;
- commit up to \$200,000 for the purchase of laboratory equipment, supplies and furnishings for the Psychiatry Department's use;
- provide \$60,000 annually to purchase equipment and supplies to support the teaching and research activities of the Psychiatry Department;
- provide \$200,000 annually to the Medical School as a contribution to the advancement of medical education in recognition of the services of program directors, faculty and staff; and
- operate two specialty psychiatric programs for patients with affective disorders and eating disorders.
