The University of Wisconsin-Extension will hold a public hearing on its Mission Change. UW-Extension is asking for authority from the Board of Regents to offer degrees aimed at the large segment of adult nontraditional students who seek high-quality, professionally oriented degrees in alternative formats. These degrees will be offered in the competency-based format, and will be offered collaboratively with other UW institutions, using similar partnership arrangements as its current successful collaborative degrees.

Appearances at the Hearing and Submittal of Written Comments

Regent Drew Petersen will preside over the public hearing, to provide interested persons with the opportunity to make an oral presentation on the proposed rules. Each individual who registers to speak will be given up to three minutes to give an oral presentation. Only those who are registered will be able to provide a statement regarding the proposed mission statement. You will be able to register the day of the public hearing, but we encourage you to register ahead of time, by November 4th.
