



What to do When a User is Taken to the Oracle Sign on Sheet

This Quick Help document is designed to walk the nVision user through the process of ending a remote app session for nvision client. This can be a useful self-help when a user unexpectedly gets an Oracle Sign on after clicking "Enable Editing".

1. The issue begins when you **click** the "Enable Editing" button in the top yellow bar.




2. After **clicking** "Enable Editing" if your screen goes to the below Oracle Sign in page, you need to **remove** the 'Protected View' from your Excel settings.

- 3. With Excel open, go to File> Options> Trust Center> Trust Center Settings> Protected View
- 4. Make sure all boxes are not checked.
- 5. Click OK.
