

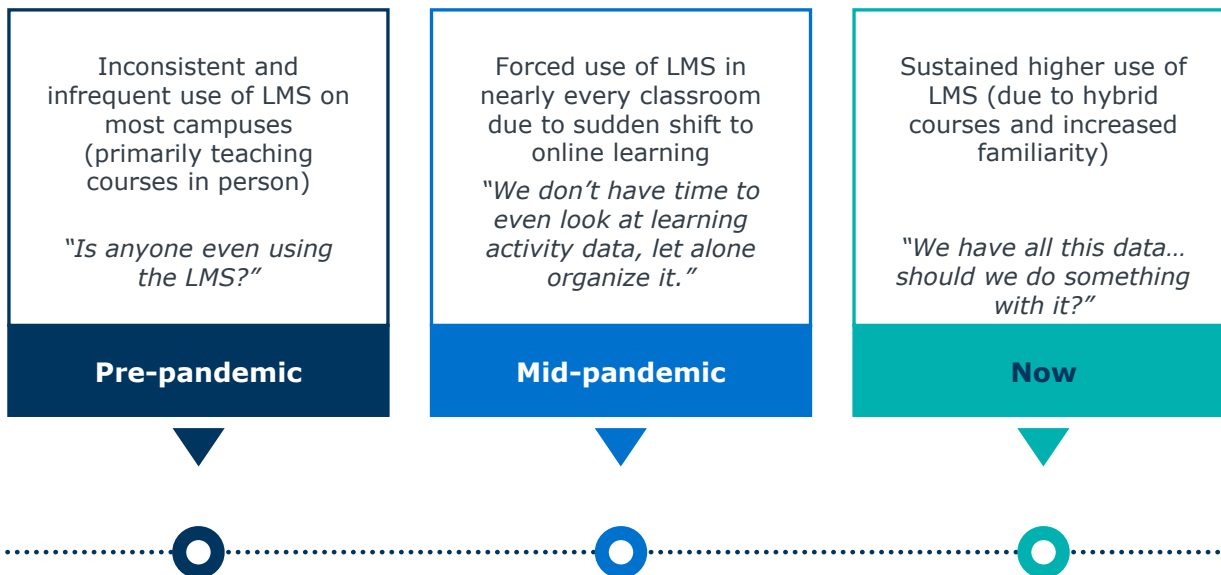

What Prevents Us from Using This Data?

Lingering Roadblocks to Applying Learning Activity Data

HISTORICAL PROBLEM

Lack of faculty and student trust in technology-based learning formats ❌

Faculty sensitivity to pedagogical scrutiny and oversight ❌

Unstandardized practices across departments, courses, and sections ❌

CURRENT STATUS

✔ Far less of a factor after several years of adjustment to hybrid learning

❌ Less of a factor with faculty used to digital oversight, but still relevant

❌ Still a major problem – need a way to make this data useful

Solutions:

- Unite and standardize data to create a single, trusted source of truth
- Analyze this data to discover and share best practices (at department and faculty levels)
- Build trust (in data and the overall initiative) with faculty over time

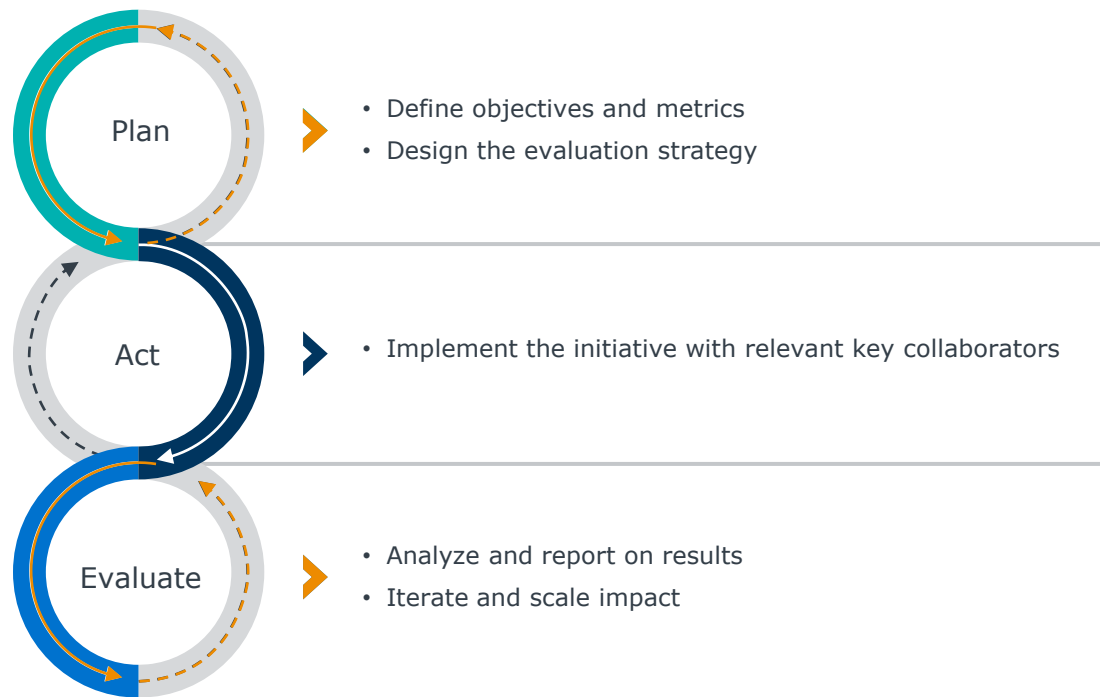

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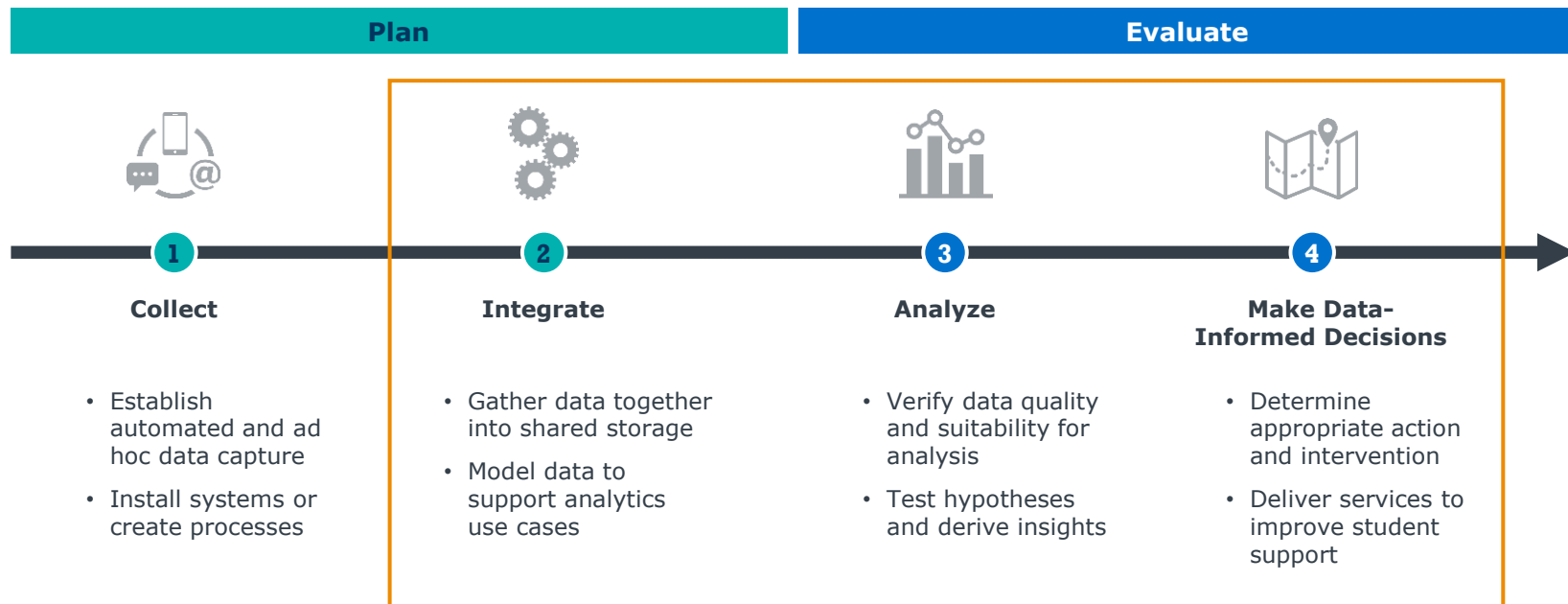

Explore and Share Data Visuals and Metrics

Edify Analytics

Allows users to:

- Build workspaces using your governed Build data around a functional area to drive strategic decision-making
- Perform ad hoc analyses without going through the hassle of connecting to external BI or visualization tools or exporting data in Excel
- Permission data by role

Empowering Users with Data

▶ Drag and Drop Analytics Explorer

Change data visuals, add metrics, perform actions on metrics (e.g., sum, average), rename metrics, and create edits in a drag-and-drop space.

▶ Dashboard Building and Sharing

Create new dashboards by building new insights or using saved insights from the Analytic Explorer, adding filters, and editing descriptions, and then name and share the dashboard.

▶ Email Scheduling

Select the email frequency and recipients for dashboard delivery via PDF or Excel documents.

▶ Automated Data Refreshes

Schedule data to be refreshed so that it is always up to date.

What Is an Edify Accelerator?

Edify Accelerator: A templated workspace containing dashboards with *flexible multisource analytics* focused on answering specific business questions. Edify partners can leverage their Professional Services hours to customize Accelerators for their unique institutional needs.

Data Sources

Data can be pulled from several sources and loaded into Edify.

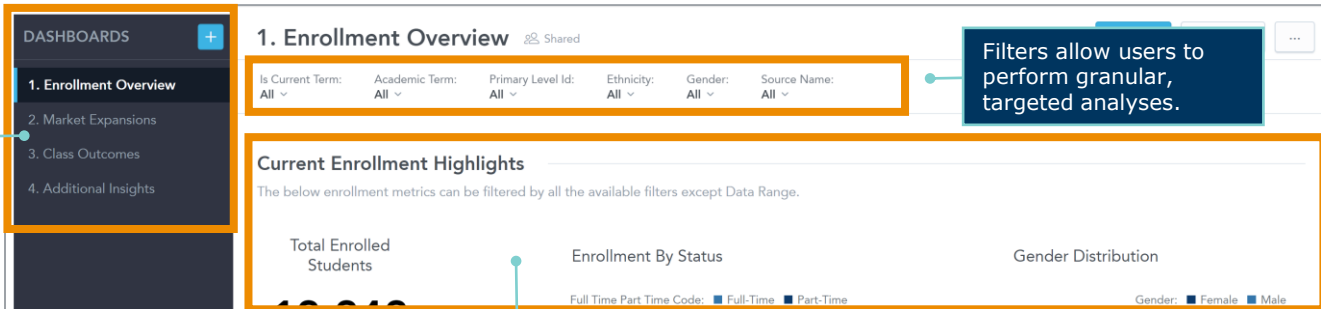
Custom Dashboards

The data is displayed in customizable dashboards.

Users

Dashboards are permissioned and are web browser-accessible.

Dashboards in the workspace can be easily accessed on one screen.



Data visuals, such as charts and tables, provide users with digestible data points that they can hover over or click on to drill down into.

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Upgrade Student Support Efforts with Real-Time Data and Historical Trend Analysis

Purpose

- Unite and standardize LMS Data in an accessible dashboard
- View utilization trends over time (year-to-year and term-to-term)
- Compare current use against previous points in time; drill down to the department, section, and instructor levels

Customized Analytics



Designed for Various Stakeholders



Course Section Analysis

- Compare course sections and their utilization profiles
- Understand which courses, sections, and instructors best utilize the LMS to gather best practices to teach campus-wide



Drill-Down Profiles

- Drill down to departments, sections, instructors, and student profiles to gain insight into engagement
- Identify students at risk of stopping out based on low LMS usage or unsubmitted assignments






Student Outcomes

- Discern how LMS usage can help prescribe interventions for student success
- Examine persistence trends as influenced by factors such as LMS discussions, assignment performance, and more

Equip Your Teams to Answer Urgent Questions

Questions	Potential Actions
Does LMS utilization impact student retention?	 Develop intervention campaigns around LMS utilization and/or assignment completion.
Is assignment completion an early indicator of GPA? Which courses and sections have low assignment completions?	 Partner with instructors to better support students struggling to complete assignments.
How do assignment completion rates compare across programs?	 Create data visibility across programs in the same department.

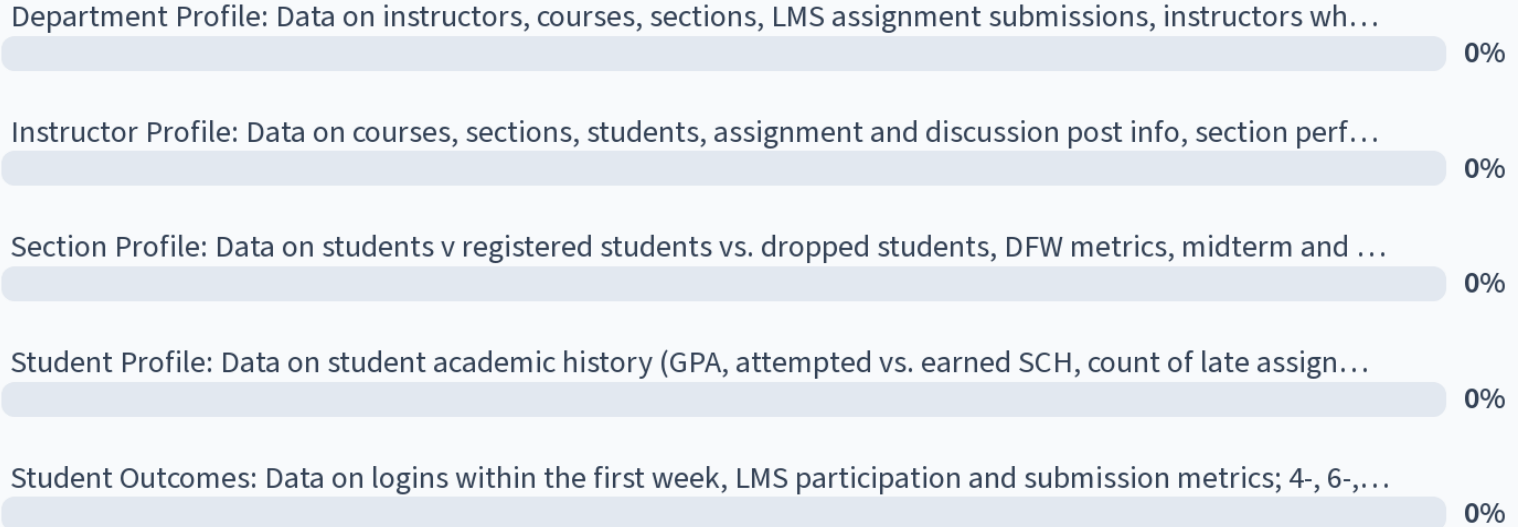

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Turning LMS Data into Analysis and Action

Crafting Strategies with LMS and Learning Activity Data

Laying the Groundwork for Success with LMS Data



Assuage Concerns About an Overly Technical Approach

Limit concerns by emphasizing that activity data will not be considered a direct proxy for student learning engagement.



Consider Interventions Before Beginning Analysis

Determine current advisor levers to support low-activity students to ensure that analyses will lead to action.



Review Data Availability to Inform Project Scope

Contact LMS admins to understand what data your LMS collects and makes available. Speak with your Navigate360 or Starfish Strategic Leader to discuss LMS integration.



Pilot New Strategies with Faculty Champions

Find curious faculty with courses that see high LMS utilization to pilot smaller-scope analytics.



LMS UTILIZATION

With the increase of hybrid and digital-first interactions, institutions have had to rely heavily on online learning technologies, such as Learning Management Systems (LMS). Without advanced analytics that incorporate multiple data sources as part of these tools, our partners were encountering challenges in how to track effective utilization and related student outcomes. Edify's LMS Utilization workspace was created for IT and LMS Admins, Institutional Research, and department leads. The workspace includes seven dashboards with both high-level KPIs and drill-down tables designed to help decision-makers use the data to improve student success outcomes and remove barriers to successful LMS usage.



Paint the big picture

In one workspace, illustrate how students and faculty are utilizing your LMS and compare trends across departments and courses.

Keep student success at the forefront of your analysis

Beyond just understanding utilization, see how LMS usage correlates to student outcomes to drive interventions and teach your faculty what works.

Narrow in on trends

Drill-down into college-, department-, section-level analyses that let you compare outcomes and glean best practices.

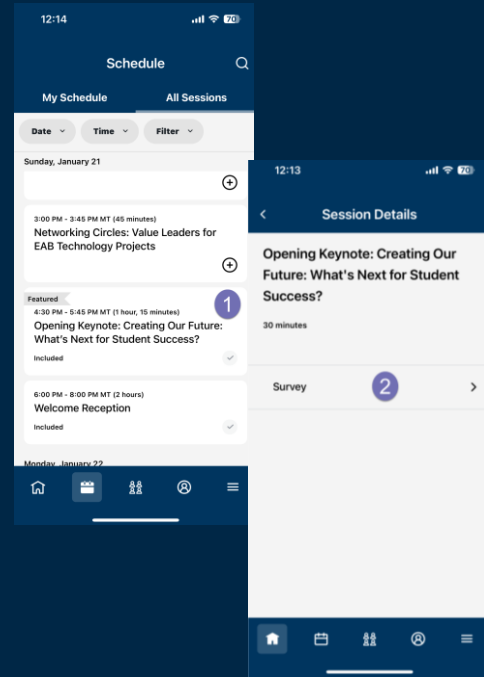
