What Is a Student Success Management System (SSMS)?

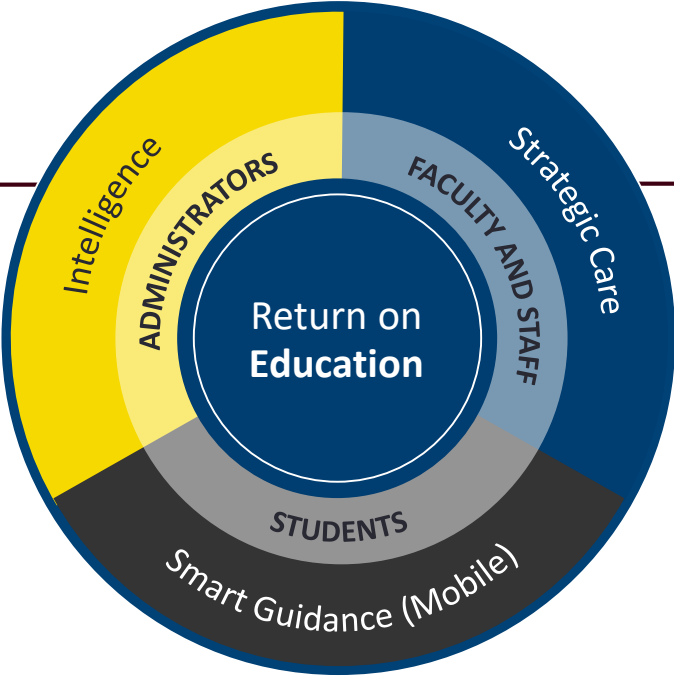
