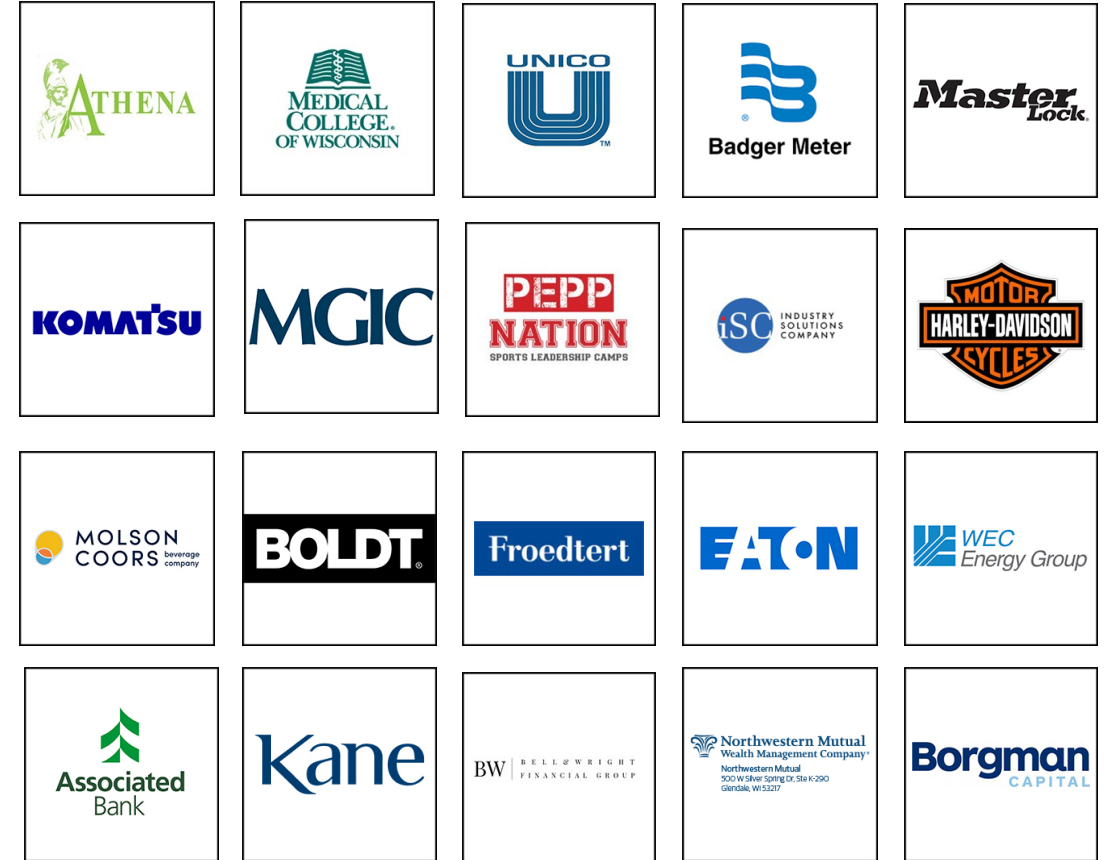

Student Success and Talent Pipeline Initiative (SSTPI)

GOAL -- Place 100 students in paid internships or in internship readiness program

- Received 140 applicants (83% BIPOC students), placed 57 in internships in first 9 months, with 23 in internship readiness program.

- Panel discussion on Internships for Social Science and Humanities students

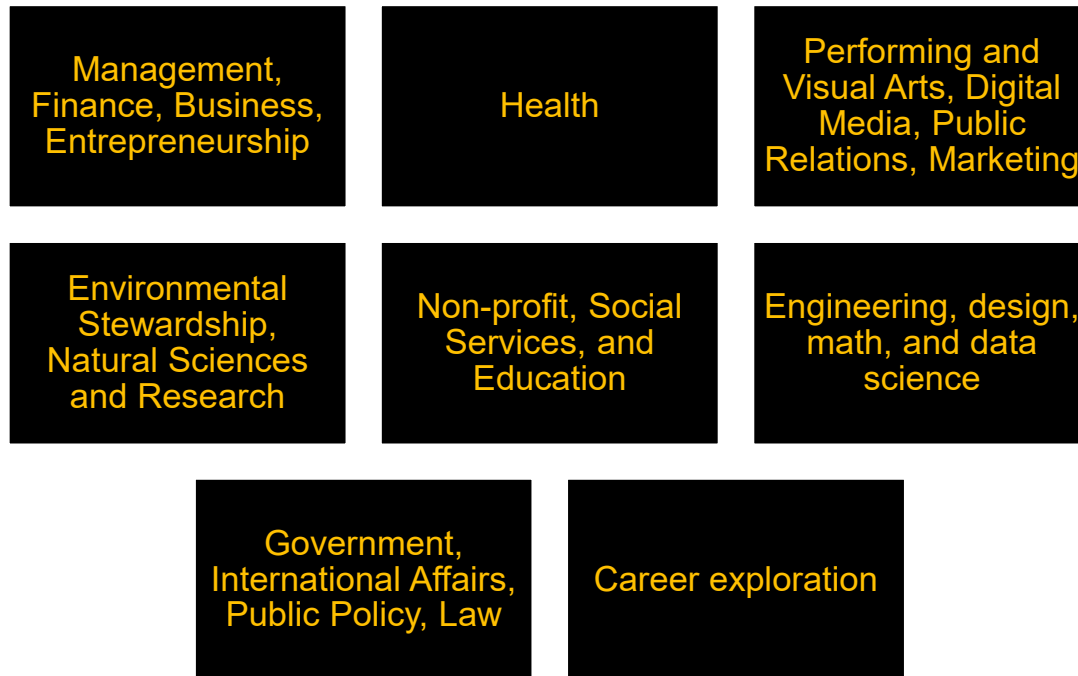
Goals around Internship
