Information <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Phase 2 will take time - We don't want to have policies on the books that are not implemented - We don't want policies for their own sake or just sitting on the shelf - We will review the policies in March - We need to set some kind of timeframe for "substantial" implementation, would January be too soon? - We need to get real and not just talk theoretically - We need to distribute the gap analysis spreadsheet that Elena proposed (I'll do that today.) <p>Later in the day I also met with Bob and Mike from Milwaukee. Some of the ideas that came out of that meeting that could apply to Phase 2 were:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We need to know what we all want from information security. Thus far the desires have largely been driven by audit concerns. Perhaps we need an "Infosec Summit" to discuss: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o What threats are we trying to mitigate? o What kinds of edge protection are in place already? o What are our biggest risks? o Who are our adversarices? o Setting a firm baseline is not our biggest risk. If you set out to protect everything, you protect nothing. o What is the role of UW System security versus campus security? o Do we want to (just) follow policy or do we want to do what is best with limited resources?
