D2L site visit (Lorna): due diligence 5 representatives, 3 attended remotely; list of objectives --- update on company's organization, future plans, "pain points" from technical and user POV, share survey results; company is growing (400 employees, 600-800), re-aligned leadership, provided road map within 1 year and long-term, working on mobile technology, learning analytics development, integrating Web 2.0 technologies such as FB, Twitter, Flickr, purchased lecture capture product, Kaltura back end solution by September; discussion of SAIP/Shibboleth, not happy with technical support for application so technical acct manager will complement sales manager; more online demos, expanded training and documentation (at cost per FTE)
