ADVISING/TRAINING SCENARIOS

I. FINDING THE TRANSFER EQUIVALENCY FOR A SINGLE COURSE

A student wants to know how the UW Colleges' course HIS 213 will transfer either to a nearby UW or to your campus. Check the specific transfer course details such as Credits, Level, and Gen Ed Category and Special Conditions, if any are listed.

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II. FINDING THE TRANSFER EQUIVALENCIES FOR COURSES IN A
DEPARTMENT

The chair of the Art department at your institution wants to know how all courses in her department transfer to UW-Milwaukee. Generate a TIS report with this information.

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III. FINDING COURSES THAT WILL TRANSFER AS REQUIRED COURSES AT A
"TO" INSTITUTION (Reverse Lookup)

A student wants to know what courses he can take at your campus that will transfer into UW-Madison's (or UW-Milwaukee's) Psychology department.

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IV. FINDING COURSES THAT, WHEN TRANSFERRED, CAN BE USED TO
SATISFY GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS AT A "TO"
INSTITUTION (Gen Ed Wizard)

A student plans to attend your campus for a year and then transfer to UW-Eau Claire to complete a degree. She wants to know what courses at your campus may be used to satisfy the UW-Eau Claire General Education Requirement in Natural Science.

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VI. TRANSFER RESOURCES & INFORMATION

A student at your campus is thinking about transferring to a UW campus in your region (your choice). Use the following steps to help the student retrieve basic information about the chosen campus.

Start at your campus home page.

- (A) Find a link from your campus website to TIS.
- (B) Link to the chosen campus via TIS and find information about admission requirements for transfer students.

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V. TRANSFER GUIDES AND AGREEMENTS

- A. Check out the UW Colleges Transfer Guides for your campus or for a local "4-year" UW campus. Compare the majors listed and the format of the guides to other UW's.
- B. Check out the WTCS transfer agreements for your campus or for a local "4-year" UW campus. Compare to the agreements listed and format of the agreements for other UW's.
