TIS TRANSFER INFORMATION SYSTEM

The Transfer Information System (TIS) is a statewide initiative to improve transfer for Wisconsin students, and includes tools like the Credit Transfer Wizards, Transfer Guides, Articulation Agreements, and Transfer Plans.

Transfer Wisconsin, a website maintained by the University of Wisconsin System, is the result of a collaborative effort by UW System (UW) and Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) to help students transfer between all public, post-secondary institutions in Wisconsin.

# TRANSFER PLANNING

#### **UW COLLEGES GUARANTEED TRANSFER**

By participating in the UW Colleges Guaranteed Transfer Program, students can begin their education as a freshman at a UW Colleges campus and, after fulfilling certain requirements, be guaranteed admission to another UW System institution. #### **UW COLLEGES PLANNING GUIDES**

The Transfer Planning Guides are valuable resources as you prepare to transfer and complete your Bachelor's Degree at another UW institution. You can use these guides to:

- Determine specific courses you should take while attending a UW Colleges campus so you can remain on track to complete a particular major
- Find a list of courses required in each major
- Find requirements for admission to a major, such as a specific GPA, number of credits completed, and/or an application procedure in addition to general admission requirements

#### **UW ASSOCIATE DEGREE TRANSFER**

Completion of a UW Associate Degree at one UW System institution, prior to transfer to another UW institution, will satisfy your university-wide general education/breadth requirements at the "receiving" UW System institution.

## **CREDIT TRANSFER WIZARDS**

The Credit Transfer Wizards are designed to help you see how courses you are taking – and even courses you plan to take – will transfer to any UW or WTCS campus.

#### **COURSE WIZARDS**

Use the Course Wizard to learn how a single course, or courses within an entire academic department, will transfer to another UW or WTCS campus.

#### **REVERSE LOOK-UP WIZARD**

Heading home over the summer or winter break? Use the Reverse Look-Up Wizard to find what courses at another campus will fulfill specific course requirements at your current school.

#### **GENERAL EDUCATION WIZARD**

Use the General Education Wizard to learn what courses you can take at your current campus to fulfill general education or breadth requirements (e.g., written communication, social sciences) at your intended transfer campus.

## **TRANSFER DEGREE PLANS**

Transfer degree plans provide an unofficial evaluation of how courses will apply toward the requirements of a specific major.

Transfer degree plans are available for a limited number of UW System institutions. For additional information, click on the Transfer Tools—Transfer Plans tab.



# ARTICULATION & TRANSFER AGREEMENTS

#### **ARTICULATION AGREEMENTS**

WTCS students can take advantage of more than 500 transfer agreements between UW and WTCS campuses. These agreements permit courses in specific WTCS programs to transfer and satisfy requirements for specific UW majors and academic programs.

Click the Transfer Tools tab to search the array of transfer agreements by campus, or by program area.

The Liberal Arts Transfer Program is available at five WTCS campuses—Madison Area, Milwaukee Area, Nicolet Area, Chippewa Valley, and Western Technical Colleges. The program allows students to transfer up to 72 credits to a UW System baccalaureate-granting campus.

#### UNIVERSAL CREDIT TRANSFER AGREEMENT

The Universal Credit Transfer Agreement (UCTA) is an agreement between the University of Wisconsin System and the Wisconsin Technical College System. The agreement includes a set of courses within eleven subject areas that are transferable to all UW and WTCS campuses.
