

COLLEGE PLANNING CHECKLIST

SENIOR YEAR

GRADE 12

FALL

- Meet with your high school counselor.
- Keep track of application dates and deadlines, scholarships and housing.
- Gather application materials. Include transcripts, test scores and letters of recommendation.
- Submit your Universities of Wisconsin Admission Application. Go to apply.wisconsin.edu to apply.
- Apply for financial aid using the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).

WINTER

- Decide which UW you will attend next fall.
- Pay enrollment deposit (if required).
- Complete your housing application.
- Watch your email for campus updates.
- Making a housing decision.

SPRING

- Make the last semester of high school count.
- Register for placement tests as directed by your UW.
- Take placement tests.
- Review financial aid offer from your future UW.
- Send final grades and an official transcript from your senior year to the UW you are attending.

SUMMER

- Sign up and attend student orientation at your future UW.
- Prepare for your first year of college.
