DIRECT ADMIT WISCONSIN

Direct Admit Wisconsin provides eligible students at participating Wisconsin high schools with proactive admission offers to 10 UW universities based on their based high school coursework and cumulative GPA.

Direct Admit Wisconsin does not require a traditional admission application. There are no required essays, letters of recommendation, or application fees. Students who receive a direct admission offer simply complete a Direct Admit Form to accept their offer.

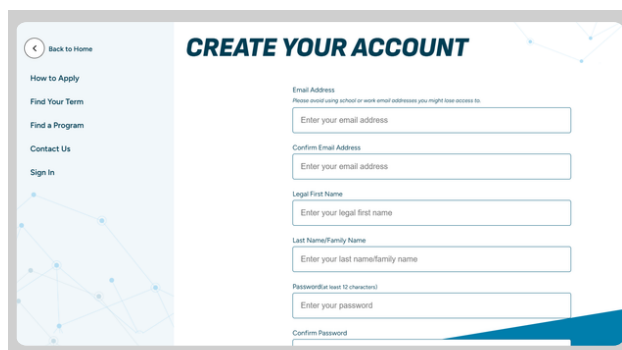
GETTING STARTED: CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT

1) CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT

- Navigate to the Universities of Wisconsin Admission Pathway Portal (apply.wisconsin.edu). From the top navigation, click on “Direct Admit Wisconsin” (apply.wisconsin.edu/direct-admit)
- Click on “Create Your Account.”
 - If you already have an account, skip to page 4.
- Enter in your high school email address and personal email address.
- Complete all other fields.



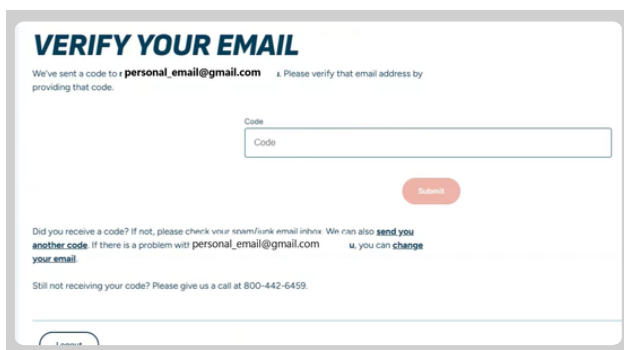
Example: Direct Admit Form landing page



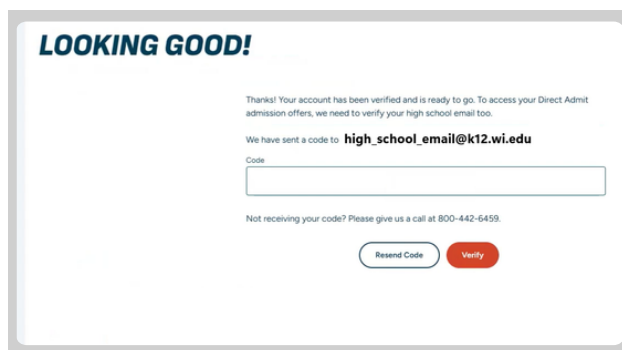
Example: Creating a new account

2) VERIFY YOUR EMAIL ADDRESSES

- Verify both your high school email address and your personal email address.
- A verification code will be sent to your high school and personal email addresses.
- If you do not receive the verification code within 5 minutes, check your junk/spam folder or contact Go Wisconsin for assistance.



Example: Landing page sign-in button

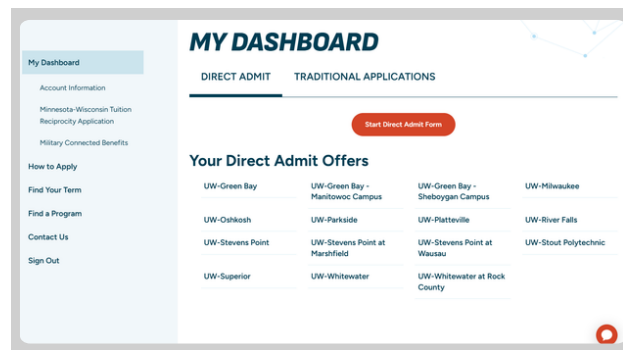

3) YOU ARE NOW LOGGED IN!

GETTING STARTED: LINK AN EXISTING ACCOUNT

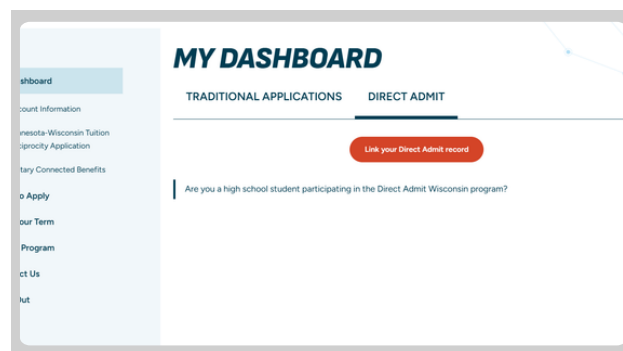
1) LOG INTO YOUR ACCOUNT

- If you have an existing account and would like to use that account to accept your Direct Admit offers, log into your account with your personal email by clicking on “Sign In.”
 - You can sign in from either **apply.wisconsin.edu** or **apply.wisconsin.edu/direct-admit**

Note: You may already have an account if you previously applied to take a dual enrollment class as a high school non-degree/special student at a UW university.

2) LINK YOUR DIRECT ADMIT RECORD

- Once logged in, from the account dashboard, click on the “DIRECT ADMIT” tab.
- Click on the “Link Your Direct Admit Record” button.

3) VERIFY YOUR HIGH SCHOOL EMAIL ADDRESS

- Enter your high school email address. Verify your high school email address.
- A verification code will be sent to your high school email address. Check your junk/spam inbox if you do not receive the code within 5 minutes.
- If you do not receive the verification code within 5 minutes, check your junk/spam folder or contact Go Wisconsin for assistance.

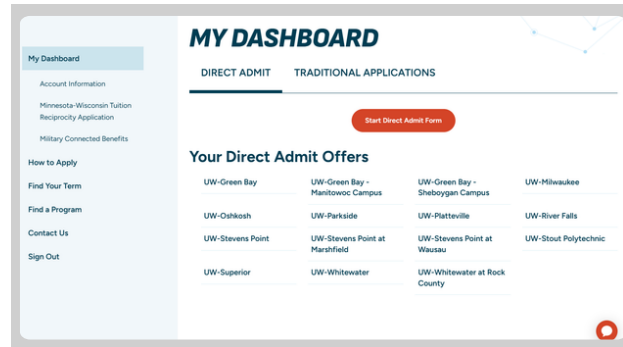
4) YOU ARE NOW LOGGED IN!

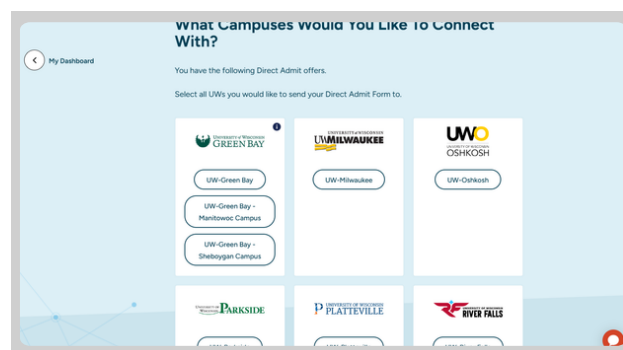

- Complete the form as soon as possible to receive important information, including housing deadlines, university-specific scholarships, orientation dates, and other important next steps.

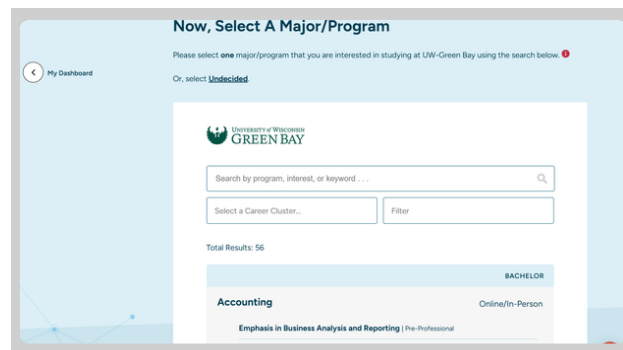


Example: Direct Admit Form - Select your UW

3) CHOOSE A MAJOR/PROGRAM

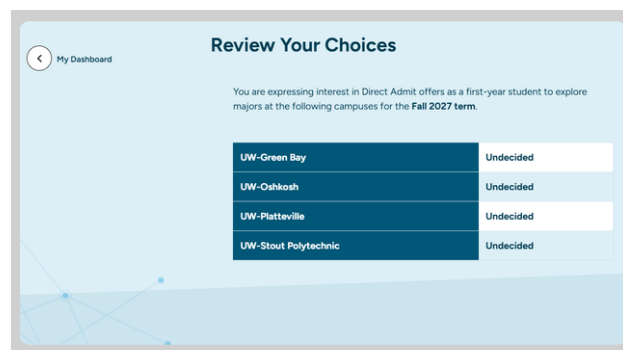
- Choose a major/program you are interested in for each UW you selected.
- Selecting a major/program does not guarantee admission into that major/program or require you to pursue that major/program.
- If you select a selective major/program, you may be asked to choose a backup major.

4) REVIEW YOUR CHOICES

- After your selections, you will get a chance to review.
- If you are happy with these selections, click "Next."



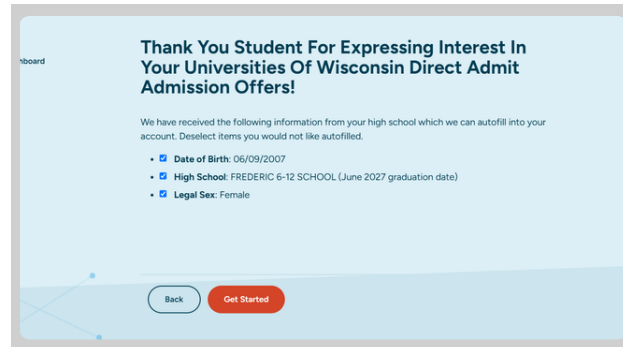

5) REVIEW YOUR INFORMATION

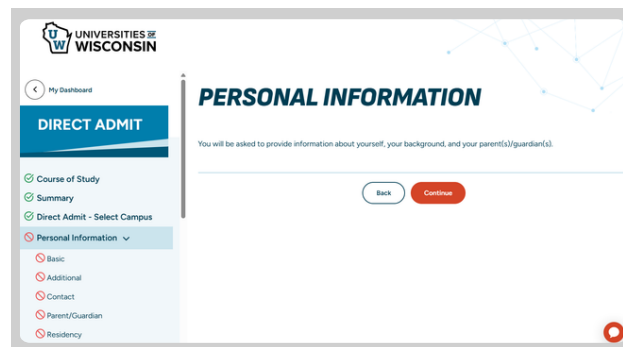
- After confirming your UW(s) and interested major(s)/program(s), the form will display the following information: Date of Birth, High School Name, and Legal Sex.
- Deselect any items you would like to change. Then, click “Get Started.”

6) DIRECT ADMIT FORM

- The Direct Admit Form will start with the “Personal Information” section. Click “Continue” to get started.
- Complete each section listed in the left-hand menu.
- Carefully review each section and fill in all required fields. Be careful of auto-filled fields! The Direct Admit Form automatically saves.
- Click on “My Dashboard” if you need to leave the form and come back at a later time.

- If you are ready to submit your form(s), click on “I Agree” and type in your first and last name in the “Signature” field.
- Click “Submit.”

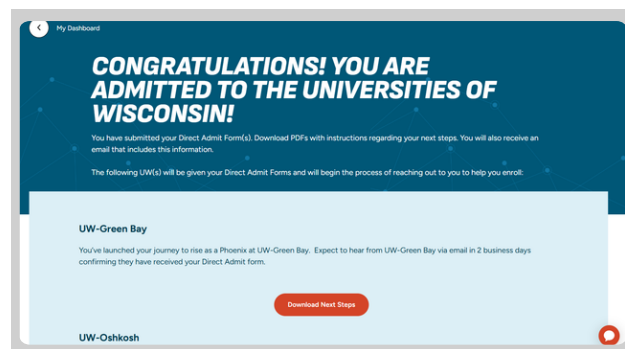
SUBMITTING YOUR DIRECT ADMIT FORM!

THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND

- Students have until May 1 to express interest in the UW universities that have offered them direct admission. Complete the Direct Admit Form early to receive important information about housing deadlines, university-specific scholarships, orientation dates, and next steps.
- The Direct Admit admission offer is to the UW university and not into a specific major/academic program. Direct entry to specific major/academic programs may require a secondary admission process. Contact the UW university or academic program for more information.
- Students must complete a traditional application for UW universities that do not participate in Direct Admit Wisconsin (such as UW-Eau Claire, UW-La Crosse, and UW-Madison) or for any UW universities where they did not receive a direct admission offer.
